



It is noticed in the said notification that all the Health projects in the urban area of this state have not been included, namely, (a) DFID assisted Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs and (b) Community Based Primary Health Care Services in 63 Non-KMA ULBs.

It is to mention here that DFID assisted Honorary Health Worker Scheme has been launched with effect from February, 2004 with the approval of Dept. of Health & Family Welfare. Enhancement of honorarium to the grass root level functionaries of this scheme is an issue which has not yet been addressed, inspite of repeated efforts taken by the Health Wing, SUDA to appraise the appropriate Authority in this regard for addressal. This issue had also been discussed in the meeting of MIC, MA & UD and MIC, Health & FW held at Swasthya Bhawan on 26.10.2006. Pursuant to that a note sheet has been initiated and submitted to Director, SUDA on 27.10.2006, where approval for enhancement of honorarium to the grass root level workers of DFID assisted Honorary Health Worker Scheme has been sought with effect from 01.07.2005 and the cost implication has also been mentioned (copy of note sheet is enclosed). The additional amount towards enhancement of honorarium can be met up from the estimated budget amount already placed for the FY 2006-07.

The existing dissimilarity in the honorarium of grass root level health workers has badly affected their morale. As the type of works are similar in nature in all the Health projects of the urban area of West Bengal, the dissimilarity in the honorarium needs to be removed immediately. The issue of enhancement of their honorarium at par with other Community Based Health Programme i.e. CUDP III, IPP-VIII etc. may be considered sympathetically and the issue be settled at the earliest.

With regard to Community Based Primary Health Care Services in 63 Non-KMA ULBs, this is also necessary to enhance the honorarium of the grass root level workers at par with the other projects like CUDP III, CSIP, IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII (Extn.) and RCH Sub-Project, Asansol.

You may be aware that DFID assisted Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs has been launched in February, 2004 and it is continuing. The honorarium for the grass root level functionaries was estimated at the then existing rates of honorarium at par with other community based health programmes i.e. CUDP III, IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII (Extn.) & RCH Sub-Project, Asansol which have been increased at a flat rate of Rs. 250/- per head per month with effect from 1st October, 2004 by the Deptt. of Municipal Affairs vide no. 1093/MA/N/C-10/1G-7/2002 * dt. 18 October, 2004. The category of manpower under the grass root level health functionaries has also been clarified by the Deptt, vide no. 1184/MA/N/C-10/1G-7/2002 * dt. 16 November, 2004.

As the HHW scheme is being funded by the Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare, the issue of enhancement of honorarium was not included in the above mentioned Govt. orders. This was mentioned in the agenda notes and submitted to the then Programme Director, SIP & HSDI for his meeting with DFID at New Delhi on 18.11.2004. Shri Dube in his letter no. HF/SPSRC/HSDI/HHW/101/2004/235 * dt. 

It has been brought to our notice that vide Order No. 1093/MA/N/C-10/1G-7/2002 dated October 18, 2004 (copy enclosed) of Municipal Affairs Department, honorarium for the grass root level functionaries under different community based health programmes, has been enhanced by your Department @ Rs 250/- per head per month. This rate has been made effective from October 1, 2004.

In view of this, Honorary Health Workers of DFID funded Pilot Scheme are getting lesser honorarium than other community based workers. We feel that a parity should be maintained about rate of honorarium for all Honorary Health Workers.
