





Sanction is hereby accorded to the payment of Ad-hoc Bonus to the employees of KMDA & KMW&SA who are not covered by any of the productivity Linked Bonus Schemes and whose actual emoluments did not exceed Rs. 8,300/- per month as on 31st March, 2001 for the accounting year 2000-2001. The maximum amount of Ad-hoc Bonus calculated on the basis of such actual emoluments will however be restricted to Rs. 2,000/- only. The upper eligibility ceiling of Rs. 8,300/- per month as on 31st March, 2001 will be applicable irrespective of whether the emoluments are drawn in the pre-revised or revised scale of pay.

2. The Muslim employees who are entitled to get ad-hoc bonus under this office order may, at their discretion, draw the same either before the Durga Puja Festival or before the Id-Ul-Fitre Festival, which will be celebrated in the month of December, 2001.

3. The benefit will be admissible subject to the following terms and conditions.

1) The ad-hoc bonus admissible under this order will be worked out on the basis of emoluments as admissible on 31.03.2001. For the employees drawing pay and allowances in terms of KMDA/KMW&SA (Revision of pay & allowances) Order, 1998 the terms 'emoluments' in this Order will mean and include basic pay, personal pay, special pay, under rule 5(33) of WBSR Part-I, Dearness Allowance, Deputation (Duty) Allowance but will not include specialist pay and other allowances such as House Rent Allowance, Medical Allowance, Compensatory Allowance etc.

For those who are drawing pay and allowance in the unrevised scale, the term 'emoluments' will mean and include basic pay, special pay, fixed pay, dearness pay if any, Dearness Allowance, Additional Dearness Allowance, Deputation (Duty) Allowance but will not include specialist pay and allowances such as House Rent Allowance, Medical Allowance, Compensatory Allowance. In no case the interim relief sanctioned by this Authority with effect from 01.12.95 and 01.04.97 will be included in the term 'emoluments.'

ii) The employees whose emoluments on 31.3.2001 exceeded Rs. 8,300/- per month but during the year 2000-2001 this emoluments at least for six months were less than Rs. 8,300/- per month, i.e., the said emoluments exceeded the eligibility ceiling of Rs. 8300/- per month on account of promotion drawal of increments, implementation of Career Advancement Scheme, enhancement of Dearness Allowance etc. after remaining less than Rs. 8300/- for at least 6 months, will be entitled to ad-hoc bonus of the maximum amount of Rs. 2,000/- under this order.

iii) The employees who were in service on 31.3.2001 and rendered at least 6 (six) months continuous service during the year 2000-2001 will be eligible for payment of ad-hoc bonus under this order. Pro-rata payment will be admissible in such cases to the eligible employees for the periods of continuous service during the year ranging from six months to full year, eligibility period being taken in terms of number of months of service (rounded off to the nearest number of months). A fraction of 15 days or more should be counted as one month.

iv) The amount of ad-hoc bonus on pro-rata payments as admissible under para 3(iii) above will have to be calculated according to the following formula :-

With reference to Finance Department Memo No. 8770-F dated the 18th September, 2001, the Governor is pleased to decide that the Urban Local Bodies under the Municipal Affairs Department except Calcutta Municipal Corporation, Howrah Municipal Corporation, Chander-nagore Municipal Corporation, Asansol Municipal Corporation, Siliguri Municipal Corporation and Durgapur Municipal Corporation may grant their employees who are not covered by the provision of the Bonus Act, ad-hoc bonus for the accounting year 2000-2001.

2. The ad-hoc bonus for the year 2000-2001 as mentioned above, will be admissible to those employees drawing actual emoluments not exceeding Rs. 8300/- per month as on 31st March, 2001 at the rate of Rs.2000/- only per head. The upper eligibility ceiling of Rs. 8300/- per month on 31st March, 2001, will be applicable irrespective of whether the emoluments are drawn in the pre-revised or revised scale of pay.

3. The muslim employees of the Urban Local Bodies who are entitled to get ad-hoc bonus under this order may, at their discretion, draw the same either before the Durga Puja Festival or before the Ud-Ul-Fitre Festival which will be celebrated in the month of December, 2001.

4. The benefit of ad-hoc bonus under this order will be admissible subject to the following terms and conditions :-

1) Ad-hoc bonus admissible under these orders will be worked out on the basis of emoluments as admissible on 31st March, 2001. For the employees drawing pay and allowances in terms of this Department's Resolution No. 60/MA/O/C-9/2p-19/98 dated 8.3.99 the term "emoluments" in this order will mean and include basic pay, personal pay, special pay, dearness allowance, deputation (Duty) allowance but will not include Specialist Pay, and other allowances such as house rent allowance, medical allowance, compensatory allowance etc. For those who are drawing pay and allowances in the unrevised scale, the term emoluments in these orders will mean and include basic pay, special pay, fixed pay, dearness pay, ^{if any,} dearness allowance, interim relief and deputation (duty) allowance, if any, but will not include specialist pay and other allowances such as house rent allowance, medical allowance, compensatory allowance etc. In no cases the Interim Relief sanctioned under this Deptt. Order No. 59/MA/O/C-9/1G-1/95 dated 14.2.96 and No. 103/MA/O/C-9/1G-1/95 dated 23.5.97 will be included in the term emoluments.

ii) The employees whose emoluments on 31st March, 2001 exceeded Rs.8300/- per month but during the year 2000-2001 their emoluments at least for six months were less than Rs.8300/- per month, i.e. the said emoluments exceeded the eligibility ceiling of Rs.8300/- per month on account of promotion, drawal of increment, enhancement of dearness allowance, etc. after remaining less than Rs.8300/- for at least six months will be entitled to ad-hoc bonus of the maximum amount of Rs.2000/- under this order.

iii) The employees who were in service on 31st March, 2001 and have rendered at least 6 months of continuous service during the year 2000-2001 will be eligible for payment of ad-hoc bonus under this order. Pro-rata payment will be admissible in such cases to the eligible employees for periods of continuous service during the year ranging from 6 months to a full year, the eligibility period being taken in terms of number of months of service (rounded off to the nearest number of months). A fraction of 15 days or more should be counted as one month.

iv) The amount of ad-hoc bonus on pro-rata basis as admissible under para 4(iii) above will have to be calculated according to the following formula :-

Emoluments as on 31st March, 2001 (X) Eligibility period in number of months

5. The casual labours who have put in work for at least 120 days and the employees on consolidated pay in the year 2000-2001 will also be entitled to ad-hoc bonus under this order according to the following formula :-



6. The employees of the Local Bodies who had been allowed to draw ex-gratia in the previous year may be allowed to draw either ex-gratia grant at the last year's rate or ad-hoc bonus as calculated in para (5) above, whichever is higher.

7. THE AD-HOC BONUS SANCTIONED HEREINABOVE SHALL BE DRAWN IN A SUPPLEMENTARY BILL. The Muslims employees of Urban Local Bodies who will opt for drawing the benefit of ad-hoc bonus before the Id-Ul-Fitre Festival to be celebrated in the month of December, 2001, may draw the ad-hoc bonus along with their salary bills for the month of November, 2001.
8. Such ad-hoc bonus shall not be admissible to those employees of Local Bodies who may be entitled to ad-hoc bonus or ex-gratia payment in lieu thereof being on deputation in any Government Service, Public Undertaking, Statutory Body etc.
9. The teachers of the Primary Schools may be paid such ad-hoc bonus subject to fulfilment of the above conditions and also the following conditions :-
- a) that the names of those teachers are included in the pay rolls of the local body.
 - b) that they are not paid the benefits enjoyed by Government employees in the matter of festival advance and ad-hoc bonus.
10. The local bodies shall meet the expenses on this account out of their own funds. The question as to whether the Government will pay any grant towards meeting a part of the expenses to be incurred on account of payment of ad-hoc bonus as in the last year will be considered separately and the decision of the Government will be communicated in due course.
11. All payments of ad-hoc bonus will be rounded off to the nearest rupee ignoring fraction of amount upto 49 paise and treating fractions amounting to 50 paise or more as one rupee.
12. Clarifications issued in previous years in respect of various points raised in connection with admissibility and drawal of ad-hoc bonus would continue to apply.
13. The Notified Area Authorities may also grant such ad-hoc bonus to their employees in respect of the accounting year 2000 - 2001 on the same principles and the other terms and conditions as enumerated above.
14. This order is issued with concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O.No. 2441 Group-'P' (Service) dated 5-10-01.



12. Clarifications issued in previous years in respect of various points raised in connection with admissibility and drawal of ad-hoc bonus would continue to apply.
13. The Notified Area Authorities may also grant such ad-hoc bonus to their employees in respect of the accounting year 2000 - 2001 on the same principles and the other terms and conditions as enumerated above.
