WI am directed to state that a pilot project with DFID support to extend the Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Municipalities outside MMDA area has been approved by the Government of India vide their letter no.L-19012/46/02 dated 2.12.2003. The project will basically involve selection/Training and deployment of Honorary Health Worker @ one per 200 B.P.L. households for providing mother child care on IPP pattern. It has been decided to set up at a Central Coordinating Cell at SUDA and a Municipal Management Cell at each of the 11 Municipalities to coordinate and implement the project. The entire funding for the project will be provided by DFID for one year, likely to be extended for five

- After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has now been pleased to accord the administrative approval to the DFID funded pilot project to extend Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Municipalities viz. Cooch Behar, Jangipore, Berhampere, Suri, Bolpur, Purulia, Bankura, Bishnupore, Kalna, Krishnanagar and West Midnapore and to create a Central Coordinating Cell at SUDA and a Municipal Management Cell in each of the aforesaid Municipalities as per Annexure-'A' and Annexure-'B' for one year for the present with effect from 1.2.2004. The engagement of personnel in the Municipal Management Cell will be made in accordance with the manner prescribed in the booklet in Bengali circulated to them.
- 3. The Honorarium liabilities against all the posts of the Central Coordinating Cells at SUDA as well as the Municipal Management Cells will be borne out of the project fund to be provided by DFID.







Displays of the key data should be available ward wise- and disaggregated by gender and for the three categories of population served as well as for specific sub-groups of beneficiary and vulnerable subgroups.

To facilitate data entry and analysis - A rugged, almost unbreakable, 7000 rupees simputer suitable for this purpose is now available. It could have software designed for the specific purpose. This could be made available for each sub-center along with a smart card for each HHW. Thus the HHW could enter the data in within minutes and such data analysis could become readily available. If one wants to save on costs one could keep one such simputer at the HAU level with a weekly visit by the HHW to the HAU for data entry. This gets fed into the muncipal level computer with an instant display of the data as required.

Data entry time may be reduced to two hours per week – at all levels. The extraordinary amount of time HHWs and especially FTS currently attribute register and report writing is not merited by the data that is available for inspection or in use at the level of KMDA and health planning.

The utility and design of the family health card already in use in 6 ULBs needs to be studied further. There are three possible outcomes from such a card-

- a. Family has a better understanding of their healh situation and better access of services; the family health card design has far too much data requirements that are not relevant to this purpose. And does not have essential data which is relevant to this purpose.
- b. The HHW is able to consolidate this to understand each familys health needs and gaps and use this for health planning at the block level and to reach out to families better. But there is no attempt at health planning at the block level and there is data that is not relevant to this purpose as also not having data relevant to it.
- c. The health system and ULB gets a good quality data on health status, utilisation of various health services and their determinants. : Comment This requires high quality consolidation and monitoring and interpretation. Even is this becomes available it is not useful for epidemiological profiling. As a project adminstration tool it is far too much work in data gathering and analysis which would tell on its quality. Such data needs are best served by good sample surveyh and Participatory assessments. The workload increase would be out of proportion to the benefits.

This is not to reject the family health card. The suggestion is to keep only such data as is useful to the family with the family in the form of a family card. A much less data item register/ smart card would be able to store the more relevant information relevant to the HHW for focusing more attention on more vulnerable families.

The HHW training Programme:

Training for HHWs must be a continuing process. About 12 days per year in a training camp environment. The one day meetings which are used for training purposes do not count against these 12days. The 12 day training is in addition to all in-service training measures.

The regular 12 day training is to see that the competencies needed to carry out her work definition are built up in the HHW and her supervisors.

Session by session curriculum development, training material that covers all training information needs, and an in built training evaluation are key steps necessary for more effective training.

The training programme should be based on printed training modules developed for the same. These materials get systematically transacted during the training session – ensuring minimum quality and commonality in the training programme. Lectures /presentations by medical officers untrained as trainers are welcome but as additionalities to the core training process.

Training may be for the first year outsourced to agencies who have the ability to provide training using participatory training approach. In parallel the skills of trainers – FTS and STS is built up through training of trainers programmes.

Failure to use regular HHW training linked with a distance education opportunity – national open school system or IGNOU or a state level system to get those HHWs who opt for it formally qualified over these ten years is a missed opportunity. Even now, if HHW's who are eligible and interested could get qualified/certified as a community health worker under the NIOS or get a diploma in women and child care etc. such an option should be open and subsidised by the programme

Other possibilities of training – allowed optionally- to enhance their skills and seek better career prospects should be encouraged. Also a part of the workforce absorbed into ICDS schemes would give further space to restructure the force. There are many areas where HHW is not needed and other areas that it is needed. The reluctance to abruptly drop women who have worked well for over ten years is understandable. But alternatives could and should have been worked out by now.

The Referral Centers:

Quality of care in referral centers:

The quality of care in referral services is in most dimensions admirable:

There is however urgent need to examine the need for more guidelines in some dimensions. The high C-section rates is one important example of the failure to develop quality standards. Again the way forward is through standard treatment guidelines and protocols along with an internal monitroing structure for ensuring adherence to it.

In addition with a hospital consultancy agency one could develop minimum standards for all key activites that constitute the hospital or service. We note that in the development of the RDC such quality control procedues have been built in. They are equally useful for other services.

As desired by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of Urban Employment & Poverty Alleviation, GOI, you are requested to help spread the message against the Practice of Sex Selection and Female Foeticide in whatever manner is feasible, particularly through the health programmes being implementing in your ULB and take further necessary action to stop the menance.

This issue may also be highlighted during group discussion conducted at various level under IEC Programme towards dissemination of message.

A feed back in this regard may kindly be granted.

Brief Note on Prenatal Sex Determination and Female Foeticide

The era of technology for prenatal sex determination (SDT) is traced back to 1970. But the initial method gave way to relatively safer non-invasive technique i.e. Ultrasonography. Very soon Ultrasound Clinics mushroomed all over India particularly in North India, leading to female foeticide in great number. Eventually, there was public outcry against the deplorable practice for female feticide. 1991 census showed further decline in female: male ratio i.e. 927 females to 1000 males. Govt. of India enacted PNDT (Prenatal Diagnostic Techniques – Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act. 1994. This Act provided for regulation of the use of Prenatal Diagnostic Techniques for the purpose of detecting genetic disorder and for prevention of misuse of such technique for the purpose of Prenatal Sex Determination leading to Female Feticide.

Ban on sex determination technique could not pull the rein on occurrence of female foeticide as would be seen in the results of 2001 census which revealed a sex ratio of 933 females: 1000 Males, which indicated failure to improve much above the previous census data of 1991 in this respect. The situation in North India was the worst where the ratio was 727: 1000. To control the situation strict enforcement of PNDT Act. was contemplated by the State Govts. in North India with numerous raids on Ultrasound Clinics and cancellation of registration of many such clinics.

A study on Sex Determination Test and Practice of Female Foeticide was conducted in North India during 2002 – 2003. Overall 1162 women aged between 15 years – 29 years were screened in 11 villages having a population of 16475. The salient findings of the study are as under:

- 200 women (17.2%) were enlisted as pregnant. Of them 59% were aged 21 25 years. 13% were aged less than 20 years.
- Literacy rate was 73%.
- Living in joint family 74%.
- Caste-wise, 1/4th were Hindu high caste, 65% were Hindu-backward or low caste.
- 134 cases (67%) reported test done during pregnancy. 45 cases had Ultrasound test done.
- 23 cases (13%) confessed test done for sex determination.
- 95% had knowledge of Ultrasound test is being done for sex determination.
- 83% opined Sex Determination Test (SDT) practice is not good.
- Two cases of female foeticide was done out of three cases where sex of foetus was declared as female.

Some observations on response about status of daughter in the family:

- Problems of parents for going out at night leaving behind the daughter at home.
- Daughters need more careful rearing lest they go astray.

- Lamp of house remains lighted if son is there.
- Son is needed to run household.
- With sons family tree grows.
- With sons one's home is run and with daughters other's home.
- All family traditions / customs / rituals are dependent on sons.
- Now a days everyone is equal.
- People don't want daughters.
- The number of females are getting lesser, then how will boys get married?

Thus, the observations revealed the cause as 'Son syndrome' which is a reflection on the low status of females in our society.

To tide over the crisis some amendments to PNDT Act. have been proposed by the Technical Committee appointed by Health & FW Ministry. The proposed amendments are as under:

- Inclusion of sex selection before conception. Prohibition of sex selection / determination,
 before or after conception.
- Mandatory registration of Ultrasound machines.
- Vesting upon the appropriate authority (which is Chief Medical Officer of the District) the same powers as are vested in Civil Court to deal with person / agent communicating sex of foetus.
- O Hiking up of punishment of both errant doctors and clients (except pregnant women) associated with sex selection. Period of suspension of doctors increased to 5 years from 2 years and registration will be suspended till disposal of case. For clients imposition of fine had been doubled upto Rs. 1.00 lakh.

Supreme Court of India in a Judgement dated 10.09.2003 in a Public Interest Litigation case on PNDT (now renamed as Preconception and Prenatal Diagnostic Techniques / Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act 1994 effective from 01.01.1996 issued directions to all the State Govt. / UT Administrations for the following:

- a) To appoint by notification fully empowered 'Appropriate Authorities' at District / Sub-District levels and also setting up of Advisory Committees to aid and advice the appropriate authority in discharging of its function.
- b) To publish a list of appropriate authority in the print and electronic media in the respective State / UT.
- c) To create public awareness against the practice of Prenatal Determination of Sex and Female Foeticide through advertisement in the print and electronic media, by hoarding and other appropriate means.

d) To ensure that all the States / UT appropriate authorities furnish quarterly returns to CSB (Central Supervisory Board) giving a report on the implementation and working of the Act.

From all above, it can be concluded that -

- i) Female / male ratio is fast declining.
- ii) If this trend persists it is likely to cause social crisis in due to imbalance in female: male ratio in the population profile.
- iii) Prenatal Sex Determination and Sex Selection is a crime punishable under law.
- iv) 'Son Syndrome' is a misconception and the idea should be discouraged and totally discarded Proper education should be given and people should be motivated for the purpose.
- v) Do not neglect female child. They are valuable assets of the society.
- vi) Now a days every one is equal. Sons and daughters have equal rights in eyes of law.
- vii) Realisation of value of daughters by their own families is the need for the hour.
- viii) Inhuman attitude and behaviour of some section of public society towards girl child should be removed and a change should be brought in through KABP exercise.
- ix) Strict enforcement of PNDT Act. 1994 should be ensured at all levels.
- x) Adequate supervision and vigilance on Ultrasound Clinics, nursing home, private institutions etc. be carried out by the competent authorities / ULBs to prevent illegal prenatal sex determination and female feticide.
- xi) Errant doctors and clients be punished as per law.
- xii) Public awareness campaign against practice on prenatal determination of sex and female foeticide be organized by ULBs through suitable advertisement in the print, leaflets, hoardings, electronic media etc.
- various IEC programmes on the subject be organized under overall supervision of HO / AHO of the ULBs under the ongoing community based health programmes at different levels like at project block level by HHWs in group meetings; at Sub-Centre level by FTSs and MOs; at different Ward levels by Ward Councillors, members of the Ward Committees and UHIOs.
- xiv) CDS of the ULBs be involved in awareness campaign.
- xv) Suitable local NGOs & CBOs be also entrusted for wide publicity in the matter.
- xvi) Chairpersons of ULBs may also organize several public meetings in groups involving both APL & BPL population for effective generation of awareness on dangerous practice of Prenatal Sex Determination and Female Foeticide keeping in view the provisions of PNDT Act. and directions of the Supreme Court.
