Sub. : Selection & engagement of manpower under Health component of CMU, KUSP.

The activities under Health component of KUSP have been extended not only to 40 KMA ULBs but also to 22 Non-KMA ULBs where Honorary Health Worker (HHW) scheme are already in existing. The objective of Health component is to strengthen existing primary health care services through training, IEC, refurbishment of Sub-Centres, re-designed HMIS and the like. The training at all levels of health manpower i.e. HHW, FTS, STS, PTMO, Sanitary Inspector, Health Officer and Asstt. Health Officer are to be conducted to strength their capacity at various fields of health issues.
