

I am directed to refer to your letter No.SUDA/120/96 (ET-IV)/122 dated 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2003 submitting therewith component wise progress report of the sub project along with Action Plan for the period April-September, 2003 and to inform you that the sub project implementation period has been extended up to 31st March, 2004. You are therefore requested to kindly furnish Action Plan for the entire financial year i.e. April, 2003 to March, 2004 keeping in view the following observations:

(i) Only those approved activities are to be undertaken during the extended period where sufficient saving is available.

(ii) In cases where additional funds are required for completing approved activities by diverting funds from other components under the sub project, detailed justification may kindly be furnished.

(iii) It is seen from the Action Plan that out of the proposed budget of Rs.112.12 lakhs, approximately Rs.96.00 lakhs is for salaries TA/DA and operating cost and a little amount of approximately Rs.16.00 lakhs is for other sub project activities. You are requested to kindly furnish detailed justification for proposing Rs.44.77 lakhs for salaries, TA/DA and honorarium and Rs.51.18 lakhs for operating cost in only 6 months period i.e. April to Sept., 2003.
