Sir.

I am to refer to the correspondence resting with Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality's letter no. 117/CSS/EN dated 16.01.09 on the above subject (copy enclosed for ready reference). A statement of existing Hospital machineries and a statement of various operations undertaken during the month of April to July, 2009 are also enclosed for your kind perusal.

It is to be stated that Christiya Seva Sadan is a Taken-over Hospital of Health & Family Welfare Department Govt. of West Bengal and has been handed over to Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality to run the Christiya Seva Sadan in Hospital Service on behalf of the Govt. on Pay-Clinic Model against collection of users' charges.

Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj gives prime importance on maternity cases and has been implementing Ayushmati Scheme of Govt. successfully in the district. In addition to serving as such verious surgical & orthopaedic cases are undertaken by the CSS. and are successfully operated by reputed General & Orthopaedic surgeons on visiting basis through an well maintained O.T. of the CSS. The endeavour taken by the CSS has undoubtedly reduced the pressure of the District & Sub-divisional Hospitals and curbed the naked commercial motives of the Nursing Homes of the District to some extent.

The Governing Body of the CSS. headed by the District Magistrate, Murshidabad as hon'ble Chairman CMOH, Murshidabad and others as hon'ble members in its meeting dated 06.01.09 recommended unanimously the necessity of the Hospital machineries as per statement to improve the O.T. Set up of the CSS. considerably.

Unfortunately the matter has not been considered favourably so far. As fulfilment of entire requirement of machineries detailed in the list involves a considerable sum, I would request you to consider the fulfilment of requirement in phases according to priority. The CSS, as such attaches prime importance for purchase of the following hospital machineries as per norms against an approximate cost mentioned against each and request the favour of granting fund thereof.

Respected Sir,

I am to refer to your letter No. SUDA/Health/63-ULBS/08/149 dated 18/07/08 on the above subject and to forward herewith attested copies of resolution dated 31.3.07 of the Governing body, Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj and contract agreement while handing over the mangement of the Christiya Seva Sadan to the Municipality for your kind perusal.

In this conection, I am say that Christiya Seva Sadan Jiaganj popularly known as London Mission Hospital remained defunct for more than a decade due to prolonged financial sickness and Administrative turmoil on the part of erstwhile Missionary organisation. The Hospital Machineries belonging to Seva Sadan under Missionary Mangement were removed or turned to condemned ones for hospital use. In fact, Government took over the establishment absolutely in ruined state and the same was handed over to Murshidabad Zilla Parishad for running Hospital services. The Zilla parishad made major renovation to the main building only and started Outdoor Clinic in the bare minimum scale. That arrangement also remained suspended from Sept'2000 - after devastating flood in the District. Ultimately the establishment was surrendered by the Zilla Parishad to the Government in 2003 and the CSS remained collapsed thereafter.

The present Board of the Municipality came in position in 2005 and ventured to start hospital services in the Christiya Seva Sadan with due seriousness obviously with the expectation that all-out support both in funding for day to day recurring expenses and stregnthening of hospital inputs (machineries etc.) adequate to maintain the competitive edge for running the hospital services of Christiya Seva Sadan in 'Pay Clinic Model'. The position was discussed in the last meeting of the Governing body on 31st March 2007 and Governing body realised the position and recorded it in the resolution. (vide portion X of page-3 of the resolution).

Incidentally, it may be mentioned that owing to last panchayet election etc. further meeting of the Governing Body could not be held after 31.3.07 though the hon'ble Chairman and other Hon'ble members were kept informed as to functioning of the CSS regularly through verbal discussion. The meeting of the Governing Body scheduled to be held on 9th Sept'08 could not be held for unforeseen and unavoidable official occupation of the Hon'ble Chairman of the Governing Body (D.M., Murshidabad)

In view of the circumstances, I would request your hon'ble self kindly to sanction estimated fund with suitable guidelines of its use towards the purchase of the Hospital machineries as per list already submitted to you on top priority basis.

With due submission I am to state that running of a hospital in ideal manner for which the Municipal Authority is sincerely committed, would surely add to the development of old and dull Municipal town, minimise the pressure of Subdivisional, and District Hospital and curb the undue commercial motives of the surrounding Nursing Homes. More over, the strengthening of the Government taken over stablishment will raise the asset value of the stablishment (already raised appreciably in the meantime) more and more as well as fulfil the long standing expectation of the people of the surrounding localities towards receiving ideal Health Care Services from the Christiya Seva Sadan popularly known as London Mission Hospital, Jiaganj. Proceedings of the meeting of the Governing Body, Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj held on 6.1.09 at 4 PM at the Christiya Seva Sadan Hospital Building.

The 4th meeting of the Governing Body. Christiya Seva Sadan was called by the Medical-in-charge Christiya Seva Sadan and Member-Convenor of the Governing Body and was attended by the following dignitaries belonging to the Governing Body.

- 1. Ex. Engineer PWD (CB), Murshidabad and ACMOH, Lalbagh the other hon ble members and SDO, Lalbagh as an Invitee could not make it convenient to attend the meeting. Mr. Abul Hasnath, Executive Officer, JAM and Mr. B. Pradhan, Liaison Officer, CSS and Mr. Tapan Choudhury. Head Clerk-in-charge, J. A. Municipality attended the meeting to assist, the Chairman JAM as per his desire.
- 2. Chairman, JAM initiated the discussion after giving thanks to the Chair and other hon'ble members. He also submitted a written statement stating the difficulties in running the Hospital Services of Christiya Seva Sadan as a 'Pay-clinic Model' against collection of users' charges. The location of the Seva Sadan being 9 kms away from Lalbagh and 20 Kms away from Berhampore has put the Seva Sadan in a difficult situation in getting specialised physicians 'on call' according to necessity of the Hospital Services of Seva Sadan. The Seva Sadan Obstretics and two Childrens' Physician and one General Physician on full time basis and one Pathologist and one Radiologist on part-time basis. In addition to the services of said Medical Personnel, the Services of 14 nurses, 8 Technicians (including two OT technicians) are also hired through the agency aganist a payment of Rs. 2,50,000/- per month on an average. Apart from the payment of consolidated pay to the Resident Physicians through Agency, Christiya Seva Sadan has to offer incentives against surgical cases and other hospitalised cases requiring intensive care. The Seva Sadan has, however, been able to arrange services one Anaesthestic Physician on its own to facilitate surgical delivery at any point of time. The Municipal management always shows keen interest and pays attention so that CSS may offer ideal Hospital Services against moderate charges and attract a considerable number of people.

- 3. The arrangement of doctors and other non-medical technical personnels in the above manner eats up almost enter amount of users' charges amounting to Rs. 3.5 Lakhs per months on an average leaving a deficit of Rs. 5 Lakhs per months on an average to meet up other requirements of Hospital Services.
- 4. The Municipal Authority as such has put a submission to the Health & FW Deptt. to sanction Rs. 50 Lakhs on an adhoc basic for the year 2007-08 which is still under consideration of the Govt. The Governing Body agrees to the justification of requirement of grant sought for by the Municipality.
- 5. Municipal Authority was already favoured with grants of Rs. 40 lakhs each for the years 2005-06 and 2006-07 respectively. The initial amount of grant of Rs. 40 lakhs received for 2005-06 was spent for preparatory works involving construction works of Hospital Buildings, OT complexes etc. and purchase of Hospital Machinaries. The utilisation certificate of the grant with details of expenditure issued by one reputed Audit Farm (Anindya Biswas and company, Chartered Accountants, Berhampore) has already been submitted to the Government.
- 6. The Audit report of the grant of Rs. 40 lakhs for the year 2006-07 issued by the said Audit firm was already placed before the meeting of the Governing Body held on 6.1.09. The Governing Body accepted the Audit report unanimously. The aforesaid amount of grant was fully utilised by 31st May, 08 and statement of receipts and expenditure from June 08 to Dec. 08 was also placed before the Governing Body for its perusal.
- 7. Narrating the financial position in details, Chairman, J.A.M. made an appeal to the C.M.O.H to provide services of two Gynaecologists, two Childrens' Physicians and one General Physician on Govt. cost which in turn will reduce the requirement of Govt. grant substantially. Hon'ble CMOH expressed his difficulty in giving any commitment in the matter.
- 8. Chairman, J.A. Municipality then requested CMOH to consider supply of some essential medicine as per requirement of Hospital Services of Christiya Seva Sadan so that the financial burden of the Municipality in this respect is reduced to some extent. CMOH agreed to consider the matter within his authority and asked the Chairman, J.A.M. to submit a list of medicine keeping the requirement within the bare necessities.
- Chairman, JAM. also requested CMOH kindly to see that adequate number of blood collection bags are supplied
 to the CSS to meet the emergent situation of Hospital Services. CMOH stated that MO Blood Bank is the
 concerned official in this regard. CMOH would, however, recommend such proposal on its receipt from the
 CSS.
- 10. Chairman, JAM requested CMOH to entrust CSS with implementation of some other benevolent schemes of the Govt. in addition to 'Ayushmati' Scheme which is being implemented sincerely in the CSS. He mentioned that CSS is ready to undertake Ligation operation, IOL transplantation programme and DOTs programmes free of cost with financial support of Govt. as admissible as per rules.
- 11. Chairman, JAM also mentioned that the reimbursment of claim admissible against deliveries under 'Ayushmati' Scheme is due to the CSS from July, 08. A substantial amount of Rs. 3,16,800/- as 'Referral Transport Cost' and cost of payment made to JSY mothers for institutional deliveries have also remained due. CMOH agreed to allot fund subject to availability from Govt.
- 12. Chairman, JAM requested CMOH kindly to see that no differential treatment is made to C.S.S in respect of implementation of 'Ayushmati' Scheme with the Primary Health Centres. At present mothers under Ayushmati Scheme are allowed 'hyperthermia prevention kits' in PHCs free of cost whereas such benefit has not been extended in case of CSS. CMOH has assured to look into the matter favourably.
- 13. Chairman, JAM stated that the management of CSS, Jiaganj has been handed over to JA Municipality on behalf of the State Govt. (Deptt. of Health & F.W.) on approval of the Municipal Affairs Deptt. Govt. of West Bengal. Since possession of a Hospital under Municipal management enrich the Municipality in delivering better health care services to its people, JAM made a submission to Municipal Affairs Deptt. to extend monetary support for restoration of damaged buildings that were used in Hospital Services in the earlier days of Missionary management and submitted a total estimate of Rs. 50 lakh 56 thousands only duly vetted by the concernd Executive

Eng eer of the Municipal Engineering Directorate. Chairman, J. A. M. placed the estimates before the Governing Body for its approval in the matter. Governing Body agreed to the necessity of such works and recommended for sanction of Govt. fund thereof.

- 14. The Municipal Authority also put a submission to the Municipal Affairs Deptt, with the request to provide fund for purchase of Hospital Machineries and submitted a list of such Machineries in the interest of better Hospital Services from the CSS. The list of such Machineries involving an approximate cost of Rs. 52,84,700 (Fifty two lake eighty four thousand seven hundred) only was placed before the Governing Body. Hon'ble CMOH of the District and hon'ble BMOH, Jiaganj Rural Hospital examined the list and confirmed the necessity of such Hospital Machineries for the cause of Hospital Services of CSS.
- 15. Chairman, JAM stated that CSS, was once famous for treatment of mothers and children. He also stated that Orthopaedic cases are increasing owing to rising trend of accidents. Moreover, Murshidabad District is famous for maximum number of building construction workers (masons and helpers) scattered throughout the country. They are prone to accidents. Chairman proposed to the Governing Body to consider if CSS could be elevated to a referral Hospital in the treatment of mothers and children and orthopaedic cases. He also urged for combined effort of the Zilla Parishad, MPs, MLAs concerned and the District administration in this regard. Governing Body discussed the possibility only but did not find any way to proceed with at this stage.
- 16. Chairman stated that Shree B. Pradhan, a retired Govt. Officer is functioning in the CSS, on contractual consolidated amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) only per month as Liaison Officer to look after the administrative job of CSS, and to maintain liaison with the Municipality and Govt. officials. He stated that Shree Pradhan's services are valuable and essentially required for the cause of Hospital services of CSS, under management of Municipality. He proposed to the Governing Body to approve his engagement for one year from 1/1/09. Governing Body acceeded to the proposal in consideration of the fact stated and owing to fact that the engagement is purely on contractual basis and not on reemployment.
- 17. Chairman, J.A. Municipality expressed his gratitude to the hon'ble Chairman and other hon'ble members of the Governing Body for sparing their valuable time for the cause of CSS under management of Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.

Proceedings of the meeting of the Governing Body, Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj on 31.03.2007 at 10 a.m at the D.M Murshidabad's Bungalow at Berhampore.

The Meeting stated above was called by Medical-In-Charge of the Seva Sadan, as Convenor and the following members attended the meeting under Chairmanship of the D.M. Murshidabad:

C.M.O.H, Murshidabad, A.C.M.O.H Lalbagh, and B.M.O.H Jiaganj Rural Hospital were occupied with another official meeting of the Health & F.W Deptt. M.L.A, Nabagram A.C, was also away from Murshidabad and could not attend the meeting. S.D.O, Lalbagh, whose name had already been sent to the Health & F.W Deptt. for inclusion as an hon'ble member of the Governing Body was also invited. But he could not attend the meeting presumably for closing of the financial year and responsibilities thereof.

B. Pradhan, Ex. Officer Jiaganj Azimganj Municipality & Tapan Choudhury Astt. Head Clerk; attended the meeting as desired by the Chairman, Jiaganj Azimganj Municipality. As most of the absentee members were contacted by the Chairman J.A. Municipality over Phone before commencement of the meeting and all of them wanted to get the meeting continued in the interest of Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj, and decisions of the meeting communicated to them afterwards, the meeting was continued.

The first item of the agenda relates to extension of term of management of the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj in favour of J.A.Municipality. Health & F.W Deptt. Govt. of West Bengal handed over Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj, to the J.A. Municipality for running Hospital services under municipal management on trial basis for one year with effect from 16th February, 2006. The agreement of transfer of the management was signed by C.M.O.H.Murshidabad on behalf of Health & F.W Deptt. and Chairman J.A.Municipality. on behalf of the Municipality on 16.02.2006.

Cuar Marketonia

On expiry of the term of management from 16.02.07 the same need be extended for a further period from 16.02.07. The Municipal Authority has already started Hospital services with Indoor patients' Deptt. having 20 - bed capacity, Outdoor Deptt. participated by specialised physicians on different branches of medicine and Diagnostic Investigations comprising of pathological tests unit, X-Ray & E.C.G unit & U.S.G unit. The inauguration of Indoor Patient Deptt. has been made by Dr.S.K.Mishra Hon'ble M.I.C for Health & F.W & Panchayat & R.D Deptts. on 31.01.07. The Health & F.W Deptt has been moved earlier in the matter and their positive response is yet to be received. The Governing body in its meeting expressed the need of extension of term of management of the Seva Sadan in favour J.A.Municipality from the end of Health & F.W Deptt.

As regards ratification of engagement of Medirina Diagnostic services for providing services of Medical Officers, Nurses, Technicians and others and acceptance of agreement between the Municipality and the Organisation, Chairman J.A, Municipality stated that the Municipality did not get any response from the Doctors. Only insignifacant responses were received from Nurses & Technicians in response to the Advertisement given by the Municipality in the Daily Newspaper. The matter was discussed in the meeting of the Governing Body on 09.12.2006. It was decided in the said meeting of the Governing Body that the Municipal Management would go for N.G.Os / Health Care Units for providing services of Medical Officers, Non - Medical Technical Personnels such as Nurses, Technicians etc. for running Hospital services smoothly.

Three applications were received in such attempt, two from N.G.Os of the District and the third one from a Diagnostic unit located at Berhampore. The terms of the NGOs were not acceptable to the Municipality as both the NGOs sought for a lumpsum amount of advance and atleast two months 's time to start work from the date of payment of advance as their pre-conditions. Moreover the NGOs were never engaged in providing services of Medical Personnels and Non-Medical Technical personnels and quite amateur in the field.

Medirina Diagnostic services has been running a Diagnostic unit at Berhampore with reputation for a long period. The concern is a partnership farm with two partners - one being Dr. Samiran Choudhury a senior Radiologist and a well known name to the Medical Community. The other is Debasis Choudhury - B.Sc (Hons) M.B.A having specialisation in Hospital Management. The concern in its role as an agency has asked for Rs. 3,76,000 per month for providing services of specialised Doctors in Gyanae, Pediatric, Surgery, Pathology, Anaesthesia for running Outdoor & Indoor treatment of Seva Sadan and services of Thirteen Nurses including four O.T Nurses and Technicians for running the Investigation units of the Seva Sadan. The agency will arrange alternative hands as and

when required for uninterrupted flow of Hispital services. Since the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj, is 20 (twenty) K.Ms away from Berhampore and 9 (nine) K.Ms away from Lalbag, the Municipal Authority hasfailed in its own capacity to attract Medical Officers belonging to WBHS who have necessary permission in private practices, for offering their services in the Seva Sadan on part time basis. In the circumstances, the Board of Councillors had no alternative than to engage Medirina Diagnostic services as 'agency' for running Hospital services of the Seva sadan almost in totality. In the circumstances, the engagement of the agency has been approved by the Governing Body on trial basis. The agreement between the agency and the Municipality drafted giving due priority to the interest of the Seva Sadan has also been approved. A copy of agreement, a list of specialist Doctors and other NMTPs are attached herewith for information of the members of the Governing Body.

The item no. 4 of the agenda relating to sanction of fund for running the Seva Sadan on behalf of the Government is most vital.

Chairman, Jiaganj - Azimganj Municipality, explained in details that it would not be possible for the Municipality to run the Seva Sadan if adequate fund is not placed at the disposal of the Municipality immediately on top priority. He explained that Rs.40,00,000 (Forty lakhs) received by the Municipality as Govt. Grant has been fully utilised for the cause of commencement of Hospital services in Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj.

Purchase of Hospital machineries and instruments such as X-Ray, USG, ECG machines, O.T. Lights, O.T. Tables, etc. worth Rs. 25lakh has been made from the grant through a purchase committee in participation of Medical Officers deputed by A.C.M.O.H, Lalbagh.

Another Rs. 25 lakhs has been spent on major civil construction works and electrical works of the old and grossly damaged buildings for Hospital uses.

Nearly Rs.17 lakh has been spent on payment of allownces of Doctors for running Outdoor from July, 06, for manning in Hospital services for clerical jobs, menial jobs like sweeping and cleaning, gardening, guarding etc. Except on payment of allowances to the Doctors, the others expenditure have been kept at the barest minimum.

As the Municipal authority has to spend more or less Rs. 27lakhs in excess of the grant absolutely for commencement of the full fledged Hospital services with Indoor treatment, there is a liability of Rs. 27 lakhs on the shoulder of the Municipality so far. Apart from this, there is a running cost of Rs. 6 lakhs per month on Medical & non-medical part for running the Hospital saervices of the Sava Sadan without any interruption.

Chairman Municipality

Explaining the situation, the Chairman J.A.Municipality requested Chairman, Governody to extend his helping hand as the administrative head of the District. Chairman, Governing Body assured to do his best in the matter and advised Chairman J.A.Municipality to send a note to him detailing the functioning of the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj, and problems thereof. Chairman J.A.Municipality assured to comply with the D.M's advice urgently.

As regards item no. 5 of the agenda regarding approval of the charges of the Diagnostic services - the Chairman J.A.Municipality explained that the charges have been fixed at the lower rate considering all the factors there of that is quality, authenticity, and rates prevailing elsewhere in the District.

A list showing rates of charges for Diagnostic saervices is annexed for information of the members. The rates will, however, be subject to revision on considering the reaction of the people and views of the Physicians attached to the Seva Sadan As the rates have already been made effective, the Governing body has approved the same to be continued until the situation calls for further revision.

The item no 6 in the agenda relates to inclusion of the Seva Sadan under 'Aayusmati Scheme' . The proposal for inclusion of the Seva Sadan under 'Aayusmati Scheme'has already been submitted for under consideration of the Govt. Chairman J.A.Municipality requested the D.M.Murshidabad kindly to see that the proposal is sanctioned without any further loss of time.

On Miscellaneous issues as noted in item no. 7 of the agenda, the Chairman J.A.Municipality pointed out that an Ambulance van is essentially required for Hospital services of the Seva Sadan . Proposal has already been submitted to the District Authority therefor. He also pointed out for providing necessary support for opening a blood storing centre in Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj. He also mentioned that number of beds in Indoor department has been proposed to be raised to 50 (Fifty) from 20 (Twenty) at present. This will help optimum utilisation of the infrastructure of the Seva Sadan. Pollution clearence for 50 (Fifty) beds has alredy been obtained. Incidentally, the raising of number of beds to 50 (fifty) will be necessery for processing proposal for setting up of Nursing traning Institute as per expectation of the local citizens He requested the D.M as Chairman of the Governing Body kindly to see the propasal are considered favourably at the earliest.

The D.M Murshidabad as Chairman of the Governing Body Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj, came to know that the tenure of sevice of Shree B.Pradhan as Ex - Officer J.A.Municipality would be over on 31st. March 07, (Afternoon). As services of Shree Pradhan was considered very useful for running the Seva Sadan, D.Mas Chairman of the Governing Body Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj advised Chairman J.A.Municipality to consider Shree Pradhan's retention in service in the interest of Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj under Municipal Management.

The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.

Now this agreement withnessth as follows: - A. The party of the Second Part, i.e., the Municipality has agreed to commission and run the said hospital with the Grants-in-aid from the Government in addition to their own finances.

- B. The State Government has agreed to hand over the management of running the said hospital on day to day basis at the said hospital to the municipality on an experimental basis for a period of one year from the date of execution of this agreement. D. Engagement of Medical Officer and Staff :-

It is agreed that the Municipality shall arrange that the doctors and other staff are engaged on purely temporary and contract basis with a fixed remuneration with prior approval of the Department of Municipal Affairs, Government of West Bengal.

The Chairman, in consultation with members of the Governing Body and the C.M.O.H., Murshidabad and upon their approval specifically obtained in writing, will select and engage M.O., Pharmacist, Nursing staff, clerk, Medical Technologist, Group

'D', Sweeper etc. Job Chart and Job distribution will be prepared by the Governing Body in consultation with the C.M.O.H., Murshidabad. There shall be no liability on the part of the State Government to absorb the persons so engaged either on regular or contract basis at any point of time.

E. Procurement of furniture and equipments:-

It is agreed that the Municipality shall purchase furniture and equipments as will be necessary observing all financial formalities with the approval of the Governing Body.

F. Procurement of medicines :-

In consultation with the approval of the Governing Body, the Municipality will supply medicines and equipments to the hospital as necessary for running its day to day activities in providing indoor and outdoor health care facilities to the people of the locality. In any emergency situation, the Governing Body may move to the Government for obtaining medicines from the Government.

The Government of West Bengal agrees to release a fixed amount of Grants-in-G. aid in consultation with the Chairman, Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality on the basis of the actual requirements to be assessed annually in respect of need to provide financial and input support for running the hospital. The Municipality may collect user's charge in different services and may spend the amount so collected for running the hospital. The details accounts shall be kept for this

Purpose. The Chairman shall maintain separate Cash Book, Register etc. for proper accounting.

Control and Supervision :-H.

It is agreed that the Municipality will have administrative control and the senior Health Officers of both B.M.O.H. Office, Lalbag and C.M.O.H. Office shall assist in technical supervision Centre.

Murshidabad.

I. Responsibility and accountability :-

It is agreed that for smooth functioning at the hospital both the Chairman, Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality and the C.M.O.H., Murshidabad shall be jointly responsible and accountable to the Government.

- J. The Chairman, Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality shall submit a quarterly performance report of the hospital along with financial position to the Director of Health Service, West Bengal through the C.M.O.H., Murshidabad regularly. A copy of such report also be furnished to the Governing Body for their critical assessment of the performance and make such opinion to the Government as they deem fit.
- K. The party of the First Part has absolute right to cancel the agreement and take over the possession if the party of the second part is unable to fulfil the entrusted responsibilities satisfactorily and in such as eventuality the party of the First Part shall not take any responsibility of the staff recruited.

Any matter pertaining to the implementation of this agreement not provided for herein shall resolve by discussion at Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.



Apropos instruction from Director, SUDA endorsed on the letter of the Jt. Secretary, MAD, bearing no. 507(2)/MA/C-10/Misc.-10/06 dt 7th, May 2008 in respect of assessment of requirement of equipments for the Seva Sadan, the undersigned requested the Chairman, Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality to forward the list of required Equipments.

In reply to that, the chairman has forwarded the said list under his memo no. 32-CSS-EN dt. 02.06.2008 which is enclosed.

On scrutiny of the said list, it is observed that the ULB requires the equipment for opening of different speciality departments like, Neo-natal care unit, strengthening of Operation Theatre (i.e Anaesthetic ventilator, Multipara monitor, Defribillator) Orthopaedics, Dental, Eye department and Diagnostic facility(like Colour Doppler and Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Total no. of item of equipments is 27 wherein only two items namely Nebuliser and Multipara Monitor already existing for which additional quantity are required. Total estimated cost is Rs.103.81 lakhs, as submitted by the ULB.

Moreover, procurement of equipment only can not initiate and sustain the service. Most important to continue the service is the availability of man-power with adequate salary for which source of fund provision should be decided beforehand. Otherwise procured equipment could not be utilized.

Now, Department may decide whether Dept. would support such type of tertiary health care services by the ULB or not.

It deserves to be elevated as a Referral Hospital to serve the large population of vast areas of the districts of Murshidabad, Nadia, Birbhum & neighbouring districts of Bihar. The strengthening of Hospital services duly equipped has, as such, been sought for from our end.

A brief note prepared earlier on functioning of the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj is enclosed for your kind information in the matter.

Note on functioning of the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj Murshidabad Popularly Known as London Mission Seva Sadan / Hospital.

Past History

Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj was established in 1894 by a Christian Missionary Organization under Governance of Barrackpore Diocese. The Hospital was once one of the best Hospital in the State specially famous for treatment of mothers & children and attracted huge number of patients from far and near. Many patients belonging to adjacent districts of Bihar also used to come.

Taking over of the Hospital by State Govt.

The Missionary Organization put under acute financial crisis in the mid-Eighties and the Hospital was closed.

The Missionary Authority handed over the Hospital with its movable and immovable properties to the State Government in 1989 with some conditions. They are -

1) The State Govt. should use the Hospital Buildings and Hospital Complex for Hospital Purpose only;

2) Should absorb the employees of the Seva Sadan in Suitable Govt. Jobs,

3) Hospital services should be started with in a stipulated period.

The state Govt. took over the Hospital after fulfilling the conditions in the year 1995.

Handing over the Management to the Zilla Parishad, Murshidabad.

Govt. in the Health & F.W. Deptt. handed over the Management of the Hospital to Murshidabad Zilla Parishad in the year 1998. Zilla Parishad undertook some major repairs to the existing main building and started outdoor treatment in the Hospital. The Hono'rable Finance Minister of the State inaugurated opening of the Hospital with a view to running it in its earlier form in 13th August, 2000. Unfortunately, immediately after inauguration, devastating flood in the District did upset all the plans and programmes of running Hospital Services by the Zilla Parishad. The Zilla Parishad ultimately surrendered the management of the Hospital to the State Govt. in 2003.

Handing over the management of the Hospital to the Jiagani Azimgani Municipality.

The present Board of the Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality came into power in the middle of 2005 and expressed their willingness to run the Hospital on Financial support from the State Govt. The Govt. considered the proposal and handed over the management of the Hospital on 16.02.06 with a grant of

s 40 Lakhs and also formed a Governing Body with D.M., Murshidabad as Chairman, Chairman iaganj Azimganj Municipality as Vice Chairman, C.M.O.H., A.C.M.O.H., B.M.O.H. Ex-Engineer '.W.D.(C.B.) Local M.L.A. as other hono'rable members. The Election embargo for 7th Assembly Election came into force from 1st march, 2006 and the Municipality was not in a position to proceed.

In the meantime, the grant was surrendered to the Govt. and was revalidated only at the end

of September 2006.

Commencement of Hospital Services

The Hospital services with the outdoor treatment only started from 1st week of July 2007, after election phase was over. First meeting of the Governing Body of the Christiya Seva Sadan was held on 13th July ,2006.

The Municipal Authority arranged specialized Doctors in different branches of medicine and provided free treatment to the BPL & poor category of patients and collected users' charges at the

nominal charge of Rs 20/- only from the affordable patients.

The Municipal Authority in the meantime took all preparatory works for opening the Indoor treatment of the Hospital with 20 bed capacity. On completion of the most of the arrangements, the opening of indoor treatment in Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj was inaugurated by Honourable MIC, Health & Family Welfare, Panchayet & RD on 31.01.2007.

Expenditure on commencing of the Hospital Services

Since the Missionary Hospital was established more than 100 years ago, most of the buildings were in dilapidated condition, the Hospital instruments were rendered unusable, most of the furniture were broken ,doors and windows were either destroyed or stolen. In the circumstances ,the Municipality had to spend on a huge amount on civil and electrical works, i.e. (I) construction of OT complexes, Investigation Centers for Pathology X-Ray and USG units, Demolition of one old building in unsafe condition major repairs and addition alteration of Nurses quarters, Electrification of all such buildings including outdoors and other civil works of major nature. The expenditure so far made on this score has been Rs 25 Lakhs

On Purchase of Hospital inputs including machineries and instruments -The Hospital instruments as per list provided by expert physician worth Rs 25 Lakhs were purchased through a committee in participation of Doctors deputed by ACMOH Lalbag. The Machineries include X-Ray Machine, USG Machine, OT Light, OT Table

Purchase of essential drugs & Hospital Requisites -Rs-1 Lakh has already been spent on such purchases as per advice of the physicians (III) attached to the Christiya Seva Sadan.

Office Expenses (IV) Rs 3 Lakhs has been spent on electric bill including arrear of Zilla Parishad Management, Printing and stationary etc.

Service cost for guarding the premises from March 2006, maintenance of Hospital (V) outdoor and other ancillary expenses amounting to Rs 5 Lakhs 27 thousand,

Payment to specialized physicians for attending outdoor from July to March 2 Lakhs (VI)

Payment made to the agency for providing service of Doctors and placement of staff (VII) nurses including OT Nurses, technicians for running the Hospital indoor & outdoor dept. and Investigation units comprising of Pathology, X-Ray, ECG & USG units from 01.02.2007 amounting to Rs 6 Lakhs,

Against expenditure of Rs 67Lakhs 84 thousand on aforesaid components of expenditure, Govt. grant amounting Rs 40Lakhs has been received and users charge amount to Rs 1Lakhs 60thousand has been collected. Maximum amount of users' charges nearly 1Lakh has been collected in the month of March 2007 only.

Outstanding liability on date has come to Rs 26Lakhs 24thousand.

Arrangement for running the Hospital Service without any interruption

It may be mentioned in this connection that medical part in Hospital service is very costly and fluctuating and to ensure uninterrupted flow of service of Residential Physicians and outdoor Physicians, of investigation units like -Pathology, X-Ray, ECG & USG and availability of Nurses including OT Nurses, the role of agency is unavoidable. Medirina Diagnostic Services, a renowned investigation center located at Berhampore and owned by a senior Radiologist as one of the partners, have wide connections with reputed Doctors and have experience in providing services of medical and paramedical personnel, has been engaged as an agency for providing such health care services to Christiya Seva Sadan against payment of Rs 3Lakhs 76Thousand per month. The agency charges are likely to be enhanced on raising of number of indoor beds to fifty in place of twenty at present.

The Seva Sadan management has fixed users' charges @ Rs-20/- per patient for consultation by a specialized Physician though such physicians take Rs-100/-at the minimum at their private chamber. The rate has been fixed at the minimum considering the poor patients coming from surrounding rural areas. A list of physicians attending the Christiya Seva Sadan, cost of investigation and pathological charges, cost of different types of operations are attached here with.

Status of the Municipality & Problems now being faced by the Municipal Management

Ours is a "D" category Municipality of more than 100 years' old having huge accumulated liabilities amounting to about Rs- 2Crore (Two Crore). The Municipality itself has a very peculiar geographical position wherein twin towns of Jiaganj and Azimganj are located on either side of river Bhagirathi resulting in double establishment for a single Municipality. The infrastructure of the towns –roads, drainage etc. are very old and require thorough renovation and frequent maintenance against huge expenditure. But the scope of augmentation of revenue through collection of Municipal tax is very limited as there is neither any industry nor any busy trade center in the towns. In spite of all these problems the present board is set to do its best with in the limited capacity.

The Municipality, as it is stated, is financially handicapped to pull up the huge expenditure of running the Hospital Services in Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj. The Municipal Authority is only capable of providing day to day requirement of services in clerical & maintenance jobs like sweeping & cleaning guarding, gardening etc. against the bare minimum services cost.

Proposal for sanction of further grant, placement of fund urgently on ad hoc basis for running the Christiya Seva Sadan.

In the backdrop of the circumstances stated, the Board of councilors Jiaganj Azimganj Municipality in its meeting dated 29.03.2007 unanimously resolved that the Govt. in the Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare West Bengal be moved to sanction a sum of Rs-1Crore during the financial year 2007-2008 to run the Christiya Seva Sadan, Jiaganj on behalf of the Govt. with reputation and dedication to the service of the ailing humanity. The requirement of the fund will be divided in the following manner:

1) Cost against services of specialized physician in different branches of medicine and surgery and services of paramedical personnel like-Nurses including OT Nurses Technician for Investigation units comprising of pathology, X-Ray, ECG, USG etc. @ Rs-4Lakhs per month

- 48Lakhs

2) Cost against renovation / major repair of the existing Building for use in different Hospital services and cost of fencing of unprotected premises nearly 1/3rd of the vast premises of 42 bighas of land.

-- 20Lakhs

3) Purchase of sume additional Hospital machineries & instrument for raising the number of beds to 50 in place of 20 at present.

-10Lakhs

4) Service cost and other establishment cost @ Rs-2Lakhs per month

--24Lakhs

Total Requirement comes to Rs 1Crore 2Lakhs or say 1Crore

Since the total Govt. grant of Rs 40Lakhs has been utilized in full and an excess amount of nearly Rs 27 Lakhs beyond Govt. grant has also been spent in Hospital Services so far, the Municipal Authority requires an immediate placement of Rs 50Lakhs to keep the Hospital Services continued without any interruption.

Incidentally it may be stated that the initial investment is the capital & non-recurring investment in nature, the investment in subsequent years will be restricted to operation cost only & it is hoped that a substantial part of the operation cost may be covered from the users' charges &

Hospital proceeds.

It is to be further added that what ever investments have so far been made, have been made absolutely for the cause of Hospital services in Christiya Seva Sadan and has enhanced the value of the possession several times in comparison to the amount of investment. The Missionary Organization is campaigning locally to get back the Christiya Seva Sadan for running Hospital services as before, any interruption or deterioration in the standard of Hospital services will strengthen their claim and agitation thereof.

In fine, it is to be stated that Municipal Authority will be devoted in their endeavor to run the Seva Sadan in its true spirit of Hospital Services and fund will be spent on close supervision of the Governing Body headed by the District Magistrate as chairman, CMOH, Murshidabad and others as

honorable members.
