In connection with the above I would like to inform you that due to acute shortage of funds available with the Municipality over the last couple of years, it has become increasingly difficult to properly monitor the health sub - centers run under the aegis of this Municipality.

This has let to restriction of vehicle usage by the medical officers and health supervisors. Hence public service is getting hampered.

Therefore you are earnestly requested to allocated an amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs) only being Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only per month lump sum, for utilizing the same in hiring a vehicle (4 wheeler or 3 wheeler as per necessity) for adequate monitoring of health centers.

It is pertinent to mention that the said funds may be allotted, if approved, over and above the usual allotments extended to us for various purposes.

You may be aware that service activity in the SC are as under:

- ANC / PNC and Family Planning counseling clinic twice in a month.
- Immunization Clinic 2 to 4 times in a month.
- General treatment clinic by Doctor once per week.
- Growth Monitoring of U-5 children Clinic once in a month.
- Health Awareness Programme twice in a month.

It is gathered that RI sessions have never been started in the SCs, though it is a most important activity of Reproductive & Child Health Programme. This is to state that four no. of First Tier Supervisor (FTS) of your ULB were trained on RI for acting as vaccinator during 01.12.2010 to 29.12.2010 at Nursing Training School, Dept. of Health & Family Welfare. Inspite of having trained FTSs & Part-Time MOs, RI sessions could not be started at your ULB for which the very essence of reaching to the poor & vulnerable population through Health care services is not fulfilled.

Hence, you are requested to take all out efforts to initiate RI services immediately at all the SCs.





Sub.: Proposal for allotment of additional no. of HHWs under CBPHCS & HHW Scheme submitted by some of the ULBs.

Sir,

This is to inform you that some of the ULBs requested to sanction additional no. of HHWs either due to increase no. of BPL population in the ward after finalization of BPL population survey 2006 or increase no. of ward.

As per project proposal of CBPHCS, one HHW is to be allotted for a population not exceeding 1000 BPL contained in a single ward. A ward having less than 1000 BPL population will also have one HHW; a ward having BPL population between 1000 – 2000 will have 2 HHWs and so on. There will be minimum one HHW per ward regardless of whether that ward has BPL population or not. However, while calculating required no. of additional HHWs per ward, 1 (one) HHW is earmarked for 1500 BPL population in a single ward instead of 1,000. Statement showing ward-wise BPL population of the ULBs, no. of additional HHWs required is enclosed at Annexure – A. It may be seen that total 88 additional no. of HHWs will be required by 8 ULBs namely Nalhati, Chakdah, Baduria, Contai, Old Malda, Haldia, Jiaganj Azimganj and Purulia who have submitted proposal. Out of the said ULBs, Purulia is implementing HHW Scheme and the others CBPHCS.

Financial implication per year at present rate of honorarium i.e. Rs. 2,000/- per head per month will be Rs. 21.12 lakhs for those additional HHWs. We may obtain approval from DHFW for required no. of additional HHWs as the fund for both the Projects – CBPHCS & HHW Scheme are being provided by them.
