

Proceedings of the meeting held in the chamber of the Minister of State,
Municipal Affairs Department and Vice-Chairperson, Kolkata
Metropolitan Development Authority on Urban Health
set up on 28th March, 2003 at 12.00 noon

The meeting was chaired by Smt. Anju Kar, Minister of State, Municipal Affairs Department and attended by Secretary, Municipal Affairs Department, Director, SUDA and Special Secretary, Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority.

In the meeting Secretary, M.A. Department informed the Government of India's decision to extend RCH project till 2nd half of 03-04 (letter dated 10.12.02 of Secretary, Ministry of Health). In view of this it was decided that the cell at SUDA as shown in Annexure-I will continue to work till September, 03. Expenditure for the cell will be borne out of RCH fund. Dr. Shibani Goswami will take over as Project Officer. The staff of M & S Cell at ULB level as well as grass root functionaries be also retained upto 30.9.03 for the present.

IPP VIII work will continue to be looked after by the cell at KMDA as shown in Annexure-II, wherein the strength has been reduced from 23 to 19.

The services of Dr. B. Bhattacharyya & Dr. N.G. Gangopadhyay will be utilised, as and when required, both in the Apex Committee and also as Advisors on payment of sitting fee @ Rs.250/- per day.

From October all the components of Urban Health Improvement Programme (UHIP) will be looked after by a single cell at KMDA. KMDA will please suggest a suitable structure for the cell and attempts will be made to obtain experienced personnel on deputation including Doctors from Health & F.W. Department/Social Welfare Department or from open market.

A few meetings will be arranged in April with the project functionaries at different levels to review the performance of IPP VIII including Extension project & RCH project.

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Apropos M.A. Deptt. order no 1153-S/03 dt. March 31, 2003, the tenure of engagement of the following staff has been extended w.e.f. 01.04.2003 for six months i.e. 30.09.2003, to look after RCH-Sub Project Asansol as also IPP-VIII (Extn) – O & M.

In the M & S cell SUDA, there were three Medical Professionals namely Dr. N. G. Gangopadhyay, Adviser (Health), SUDA, Dr. R.N. Kar – Project Officer, RCH-Sub Project Asansol and Dr. Shibani Goswami – Project Officer, IPP-VIII (Extn). This composite M & S cell Health Professionals — used to look after both the projects combinedly and cohesively. Now, with the release of Dr. R. N. Kar and Dr. N. G. Gangopadhyay, Adviser (Health), SUDA, pursuant to above mentioned orders w.e.f. 01.04.2003 there is only one Health Professional to look after O & M, IPP-VIII (Extn) and RCH-Sub Project Asansol.

Both the Projects – RCH, Asansol & IPP-VIII (Extn) – O & M are Health Projects, which need expertise in the particular field. For effective functioning of M & S cell, SUDA with regard to planning, monitoring and supervision of 11 ULBs under the projects demand more than one Health Professional with quality, capability & wide experience in the related field. Under the present situation, there is none to share responsibility on Medico – Technical Issues.

Since inception of the project upto 31.03.2003, daily interaction was made with Adviser, Health, SUDA and quick / immediate actions were taken up without lapse of time resulting in target achievement within a short span of time. It will not be out of context to mention that ICR (Implementation Completion Report) of IPP-VIII (Extn) was highly appreciated by World Bank / GOI. Though the ULBs under IPP-VIII (Extn) are in non-KMA, all the targets could be achieved because of having very efficient, field oriented and experienced medical experts in the M & S cell at SUDA as well as the close touch with the Adviser in each phase of work which helped in speedy disposal of issues.

A. Only few months are left to close the project, RCH- Asansol - the critical period for the project for smooth closing and stepping into O & M phase where valuable advice of Adviser will be highly required in the following areas as summarised below:

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- 2 -

- 1. Close assessment of the activities in a more active & practical ways.
- 2. As the construction of MHs have been completed, requires vigorous monitoring and supervision for its operationalisation within the next six months of extension of the project granted by GOI.
- 3. Guidance to overcome the hurdles in procurement of equipment etc.
- 4. During the extended period of the project, procurement plan for drugs have already been submitted to GOI for approval. Regular follow up with GOI is necessary. On receipt of approval, the said procurement is to be completed according to World Bank norms within a short time including testing of drug, payment to parties and submission of SOE to GOI/World Bank.
- 5. Advice for strengthening software component of project activities like I.E.C.
- 6. New innovative programmes i.e. School Health Programme prepared by the ULB require valuable technical advice for proper implementation and evaluation.
- 7. End line survey of RCH Asansol is to be conducted deploying independent agency by the Health Wing, SUDA. Day to day work with regard to development of questionnaire, sampling methodology, field testing, data collection, collation, compilation & preparation of report etc. will require expertise advice.
 - 8. Guidance for preparation of Implementation Complementation
 Report (ICR) of RCH-Sub Project Asansol.
- 9. Advice for preparation of SOE & changing in allocation of fund in different components based on performance.
 - 10. Regular & frequent monitoring and interaction with the Chairperson of the ULB to solve the problems faced by them.
 - 11. Necessary guidance for drawing of action plan for remaining period of the RCH-Sub Project Asansol based on performance.
 - Drawing of action plan for O & M phase of RCH-Sub Project Asansol.
 - 13. Preparation and submission of budget for O & M phase of RCH-Sub Project Asansol.
 - 14. Augmentation of raising of Health Fund towards self-sustenance.
 - 15. Strengthening of re-orientation / exchange sharing session in different tiers of grass-root level functionaries.
 - 16. Keeping active liaison with SFWO of State Health Department Which is the Mother Institute of RCH programme in West Bengal.

17. To prepare staffing pattern of RCH-Sub Project Asansol for O & M period keeping parity with those of IPP-VIII (Extn) and IPP-VIII.

In addition to those spelled out above, areas of common issues are:

- 18. Some of the ten ULBs implementing IPP-VIII (Extn) could not yet be made M.H. functional. Regular guidance to the ULBs is required to activate the programmes through valuable advice of Adviser.
- 19. To facilitate meetings / visit by World Bank / GOI.
- 20. Adviser to attend meetings of MOS and M.A. Secretary for reporting progress of the project and interaction.
- 21. Advice on technical issues raised by ULBs.

I (Extn) through

22. Routine evaluation and assessment of performance reports of IPPVIII (Extn) - O & M and also running project of RCH- Asansol for necessary guidance and re-setting of targets on different health parameters.

For the reasons mentioned above, daily interaction with the Adviser on all the working days is very essential for effective implementation of the Projects.

In this context, it is to state that there is one post for Adviser, Health in RCH-Sub Project Asansol, which is lying vacant at present and to mention proceeding of the meeting held in the chamber of MOS dt. 28.03.2003. Expenditure with regard to fees to Adviser will be met out of RCH-Sub Project Asansol fund where enough provision exist. There will be no exchequer burden on State Government.

With the present manpower structure keeping the Adviser at Helm facilitated smooth and successful implementation of so many critical Projects without much hurdles up till now, so the structure needs to be maintained. To keep the system running, it is always better to have the person who is thoroughly conversant and expert with all the related Projects and helped in successfully completing them. Dr. N. G. Gangopadhyay is the person who is referred above.
