The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to sanction one post of Urban Health Improvement Organiser for each town under IPP - VIII and IPP-VIII(Extension) for post project maintenance work with a monthly remuneration of N.4500/- (consolidated) which is to be equally shared between the Government and the concerned local body for the initial year and this financial support from Government will be withdrawn in a tapering scale in such a way that from the fifth year will financial responsibility for the post will vest on to the concerned urban local body.

The concerned urban local body may select a suitable person having adequate experience of community development work including administrative/financial management & engagement may be made on a year-to-year contract.

Sir/Madam,

As decided, one Urban Health Improvement Organiser is provided to each of the 10 ULBs under IPP-VIII (Extn) for post project maintenance work. The monthly remuneration will be Rs. 4500/- (Rupees Four Thousand Five Hundred) which should be shared between the Government and the local body at the rate of 50% each for the initial year and this financial support from Government will be withdrawn in a tapering scale in such a way that from the fifth year full financial responsibility for the post will vest on to the local body.

Such an officer may be selected by the concerned LCC of respective ULBs and engaged for the purpose on contractual basis. Criteria for selection may be a person having adequate experience of Community Development including administrative / financial management.

Minutes of the review meeting taken by Minister-in-Charge of M.A. & U.D. Departments on Urban Health Improvement Programmes.

100 SNOT

The review meeting which took place on the 7th October, 2002 at 11.30 AM was presided over by the MIC and was also attended by Minister of State. Secretary and Special Secretary, M.A. Department, CEO & Special Secretary, KMDA, Chief of Health, IPP VIII, Adviser (Health), SUDA and Director, SUDA were also present.

MIC observed that through the infrastructure created under the various Urban Health Improvement Programmes like CUDP-III, CSIP, IPP VIII and IPP VIII (Extension), it has been possible to extend the benefit of basic health care facilities to the urban population, particularly in urban slums, in a very efficient and cost effective manner. As such he emphasized that these services are not only to be maintained but the coverage to include other disciplines is also to be extended. Since the external funding has come to an end, the facilities will be maintained with financial support from the Government.

It was agreed in the meeting that for the post project maintenance there shall be an apex committee to guide the Urban Health Improvement Programme consisting of the following members:

8.	Chief Health Officer, KMC	Member

11.	Special Secretary, KMDA	Member-Secretary

This committee will provide necessary guidance regarding resource generation, programme policies, decentralisation of authority to the local bodies, optimum utilisation of the facilities, maintenance of building/equipments etc.

It was further decided that for the post-project maintenance for IPP VIII, the minimum requirement of staff at KMDA headquarters for UHIP and innovative component will be 99 for the present of which 23 posts would be manned by technical staff engaged on contractual basis and the rest by the regular KMDA employees. Since RCH Asansol Project will continue upto 31,3,2003, it was decided that beyond October, 2002, 7 essential staff now working under IPP VIII (Extension) will be deputed to RCH Asansol Project for looking after both RCH and IPP VIII (extension) upto 31,3,2003 at SUDA. These staff at SUDA will be paid out of RCH Project fund. After March, 2003 all the health components under SUDA and KMDA would work

under one cell at KMDA. This cell would be formed towards the end of the current financial year.

It was also decided that at the ULB level one Urban Health Improvement Organiser would be provided for the post project maintenance work with a monthly remuneration of Rs. 4500/- which should be shared between the Government and the local body at the rate of 50% each for the initial year and this financial support from Government will be withdrawn in a tapering scale in such a way that from the fifth year full financial responsibility for the post will vest on to the local body.

It has been intimated vide above quoted Memo's that M & S cell staff under IPP-VIII (Extn) will be retained only up to Oct'2002, but the project period has been extended for another one year from 01.07.02.

In this context, it is mentioned that retention of M & S cell staff is imperative keeping in view the work load of the project i.e. preparation of bill vouchers, various correspondence, maintaining records and also for performing supervisory duties on the work of nursing staff, FTS, HHWs working at 7 SHPs within 39 blocks under this Municipality and also OPD-cum-MH which has started functioning recently with the specialist Doctors of various disciplines. At this stage, discontinuing of M & S cell staff will adversely affect the functioning of the project.







Sub: Regarding continuation of IPP VIII & IPP VIII (Extension)
Programme.

You are aware that Apex Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on Family Welfare (Urban Slums) Project (IPP VIII) in its 4th meeting held on the 4th June, 1997 recommended that the Municipal Affairs Department would be responsible for maintaining the services created by the Project in the post-project period. Pursuant to this decision, an RE provision of Rs. 4 crore was kept in the budget for the year 2001-02 under the Head "2211-00-108-Selected Area Programme (including IPP Project)-NP-002-31" under Demand No. 34 and funds were also released in the last financial year from this Head in favour of KMDA for continuation of the programme, since KMDA has been supervising IPP VIII programme in 40 urban local body areas within the KMDA area. IPP VIII (Extension) programme with assistance from World Bank was also introduced under the supervision of SUDA in 10 local body areas outside KMDA for extending similar facilities and this programme came to an end on 30.6.2002. However, the World Bank has allowed an extension of time upto October 2002 for claiming reimburgement against expenditure incurred upto the 30th June this year. In terms of the decision of the aforesaid Apex Committee the Government has decided that the programme under IPP VIII as well as IPP VIII (Extension) will continue as usual for which financial assistance would be provided by the Municipal Affairs Department through KMDA/SUDA. In the budget for the current year there is a provision of Rs. 4.07 erore which is much less than the

actual requirement. In consultation with the KMDA and SUDA a realistic assessment of the fund requirement has been made and we are moving the Finance Department for augmentation of the provision.

In terms of this decision I would now request you to please inform the concerned local bodies to renew the contractual engagement of the health workers and other staff as shown in the Annexure on existing terms for another one year from 1.7.02.

It may kindly be emphasized on the local bodies that the intention of the Government is to handover these institutions to the local bodies in the long run and the latter should be able to run them on a self sufficient and sustainable basis through collection of user charges, without compromising on the quality of the vital services being provided. We have already informed the local bodies implementing IPP VIII (Extension) Programme to consider to adopt the user charges that have been fixed under IPP VIII Programme and the item-wise user charges has also been intimated to them for guidance. The Government intends to reduce the financial support in a phased manner over a period of time when it will be possible to run these centres independently.

In the matter of monitoring the programme at the headquarters, the Government intends to keep a small wing under a single agency which will look after both these two programmes. This wing will function under an advisory body to be chaired by the MOS of this Department. The formation of this advisory body as well as of the monitoring wing will be notified separately. For the present, it is ordered that the existing staff set up at the headquarters both at KMDA and SUDA will be maintained under the existing terms and conditions upto October, 2002. This circular may kindly be brought to the attention of all concerned local bodies.
