It was decided that at the ULB level one Urban Health Improvement Organiser would be provided for the post maintenance work with a monthly remuneration of Rs.4500/- (Rupees Four Thousand Five Hundred) only which should be shared between the Government and the local body at he rate of 50% each for the initial year and this financial support from Government will be withdrawn in a tapering scale in such a way that from the fifth year full financial responsibility for the post will vest on to the local body.
