HF/O/PHP/658/O-23/98 dated October 25, 2002 of Health and Family Welfare Department (Copy enclosed), whereby Municipal level Health and Family Welfare Committees for every Municipality / Corporation except Kolkata Municipal Corporation were constituted to ensure integration of all health activities in the Municipalities / Corporations through proper coordination between Urban Local Bodies and the Department of Health and Family Welfare. The aforesaid Committees, of which Assistant Chief Medical Officer of Health (ACMOH) of the concerned Sub-Division is one of the members, are to function under the supervision of District Health and Family Welfare Samity.

During a meeting of the Apex Advisory Committee on Urban Health Improvement Programme under the Chairmanship of Minister in Charge, Municipal Affairs and Urban Development Department, Government of West Bengal, held on September 2, 2004, the issue of non-participation of many ACMOHs in such Committee meetings convened by the Municipalities / Corporations was raised. It was considered that non-participation of ACMOH in the Committee meetings would frustrate the main objective behind constitution of such Committees. The matter has been taken note of and viewed seriously by this Department as well as Department of Municipal Affairs and Urban Development.

Considering the importance of the aforesaid Committees, it is desired by this Department that ACMOHs must ensure active participation in the Committee meetings. In case of their failure to personally attend any of such meetings, ACMOH should intimate the President well in advance and send a suitable official to represent him in the meeting. All ACMOHs of your District should be advised accordingly.



- 1. Eye camp including IOL implantation in collaboration with Lion's Club of Asansol to be held on 14th & 15th of March, 2004 at ESOPD/MH, Ward No. 9. Screening of more than 100 patients has been made on 29th February, 2004 at the same venue. 70 patients have been registered for operation on the above mentioned date.
- 2. Laparoscopic Ligation camps:-
 - (a) On 15th March, 2004 at ESOPD/MH, Ward no,28. 2.55 (b) On 17th March, 2004 at ESOPD/MH, Ward no,9.

These camps will be conducted in association with the State Health Department, Dr. Samanta Roy Laparoscopic surgeon of Kalla Hospital under ECL will render professional service at these camps .Till date 100 beneficiaries have registered their names for operation.

Placed below is the copy of communication bearing memo no. 95/R.C.H./AMC dt. 22.03.2004 from the Health Officer, Asansol Municipal Corporation on the above subject,

One USG machine has been provided to the Asansol Municipal Corporation for use under R.C.II. Sub-Project, Asansol where instant photography mechanism is not available. As a result, USG done by the Doctor requires assistance of Radio technician for developing and fixing the plates for obtaining the photographs during time hours of 12 noon to 4 p.m. (working time of Radio technician). The total cost for the purpose per USG plate comes around Rs. 175/-. Charge for USG has been fixed at Rs. 150/- in case of BPL population. There is a deficit of Rs. 25/- per case.

If the Thermal printer could be attached to the USG machine, it can run anytime of the day by the Doctor without any Radio technician as well as developer and fixture, where the automatic print out of the photographs will come out. The cost per plate in this case will be Rs. 90/- with a savings of Rs. 60/- per case. Though initial cost involvement for the Thermal printer is Rs. 70000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand) only, this will be cost effective in the long run, as also less burden to the State Govt. exchequer.

There is adequate fund provision. If approved, the procurement will be done by Asansol Municipal Corporation and will keep provision by drawing in advance the said amount and treating them as committed expenditure.
