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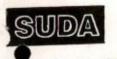

In continuation of this Department's letter No. HFW/HSDI/501/HHW-39/06 dated 27.10.2009 on the subject mentioned above I am directed to inform you that a further sum of Rs. 75.00 lakh (Rupees seventy five lakh) only is hereby released in favour of Project Officer, HHW Scheme, DFID, SUDA against the requisition for fund made by you in your letter no. SUDA-Health/DFID/08/480 dated 27.11.2009 for implanting the Honorary Health Workers Scheme in 11 non-KMA Municipalities. This amount is inclusive of non recurring expenditure in connection with equipment, furniture, IEC materials, etc.

It may be noted that the funds so released should be strictly utilized for the purpose as mentioned by you in the estimated Project budget for the year 2009-10 in your above mentioned letter. Re-appropriation of fund from one item / sub item to another may only be done after having the prior concurrence to that effect from the undersigned.

An itemwise Statement of Expenditure (SOE) and Utilization Certificate (UC) in respect of the amount released above may kindly be sent to this department in due course.

You are requested kindly to send your authorized representative to collect the cheque from the accountant, HSDI, Project Office at Swasthya Bhavan, immediately.

The SH&FWS, NRHM repeatedly engaged M/s M.B.Computers for providing achnical support and handholding to State, District & Block officials to prepare the Consolidated State FMR on Tally ERP 9 in spite of its failure to generate the desired reports in periodical intervals.

Thus, the purpose to engage M/s M.B. Computers for providing technical support and handholding support was frustrated as the desired out put could not be generated. Therefore, the total expenditure of Rs.93,42,728/- incurred for making payment to M/s M.B. Computers for technical and handholding support was infructuous.

This is brought to the notice of Government.

Efus ? Add . Ochs (Fu) programma officer Diversion of Rs. 8.34 crore from NRHM programme fund towards inadmissible purposes.

State Health & Family Welfare Samiti, NRHM, Govt. of West Bengal released fund of Rs. 30.76 Crore out of National Rural Health Mission fund during 2006-07 to 2009-10 in favour of State Rural Development Agency (SRDA) under Panchayat & Rural Development (P&RD)Department for capacity building of the members of the Panchayati Raj Institution's .

However, while submitting activity plan and requisition of fund by SRDA for 2010-11 dated 2nd August, 2010 manpower cost of Rs.10,61,48,400.00 for 483 different posts in the State, district, block and GP level was included under the activity of Management Support. Panchayat & Rural Development Department also stated that they received Rs.4,36,47,000.00 vide G.O. dated 07-08-2009 might be utilized for manpower cost as per approval of the Cabinet.

As per the scope of the activity, State Health & Family Welfare Samiti, NRHM, Govt. of West Bengal stated (01-12-2010) that releasing of

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funds for manpower cost to the tune of Rs. 10.61 crore in respect of such regular posts was inadmissible under NRHM.

Till date of Audit (March, 2012), the local Authority could not show any record regarding refund or adjustment against subsequent release for different other programmes executed by SUDA of Rs. 436.47 lakh already with the P&RD Department. Thus P&RD Department utilized Rs. 436.47 lakh without approval of State Health & Family Welfare Samiti, NRHM, Govt. of West Bengal.

(B) The Commissioner (FW) decided (12.2.09) to procure drug kits for units situated in urban areas of Districts and Municipal Corporations. A total of 2164 nos. of Kits were procured from M/s. Gluconate Health Limited at a total cost of Rs.2,35,00,174.00 (@ Rs.10859.00 per kit including packaging, transport & Vat charges). Initially the payment was made from "Supply of IFA, Deworming, Vit A etc. to AWCs" under the Flexi pool Fund of RCH-II. Latter, a fund of Rs. 8,08,76,000/- and Rs. 8,40,56,000/- during 2009-10 and 2010-11 respectively has been transferred from NRHM Flexi pool to the account of RCH-II Wing towards procurement of inter alia IFA, Deworming, Vit A Solution.

However procurement of Drugs for Urban Units was inadmissible under NRHM programme guidelines.

Thus, the expenditure to the tune of Rs. 6,71,47,174.00 (Rs. 43647000.00 + Rs.23500174.00) was incurred in contravention of NRHM guideline for inadmissible purposes.

This is brought to the notice of Government.

18. Unauthorised utilization of Rs.192.78 lakh by SUDA beyond project period

approval of DFID supported Honorary Health Worker Scheme (HHWS) in 11 Non KMD Area at a total cost of Rs. 5.90 crore. The project basically involved selection/training and deployment of HHW @ one per 200 BPL households for providing mother child care on IPP pattern. It has been decided to set up a central co-ordination cell of SUDA and a Municipal Management cell at each of the 11 Non KMD Municipalities to co-ordinate and implement the project. The entire funding for the project will be provided by DFID for one year, likely to be extended for five years.

The honorarium liabilities against all the posts of the central coordinating cell at SUDA as well as the Municipal Management cell will be borne out of the project fund to be provided by DFID.

Accordingly, GoI released Rs. 2.00 crore vide DD No. 420743 dt. 8.1.04 in fovour of West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti (DFID) for implementation of the project activities.

Out of the Rs. 2.00 crore, Rs. 173.82 lakh were released during March 2004 to March 2006 to SUDA considering the delay in starting the project particularly in the context of Parliamentary Election in May 2004, the end date of the project had been extended by DFID & GoI to June 2005 with no escalation in project cost.

As per G.O No. HF/SPSRC/HSDI/HHW/10/2004/125 dated 29.6.05 it was stated that the HHW scheme being implemented in 11 Non KMDA Municipalities shall be included in the United Kingdom/India Health System Development Initiatives –Grant 2005, sanctioned by DFID.

It had now been decided by H&FW Department that the pilot HHW scheme, being implemented in 11 Municipalities, shall be include in the

United Kingdom/India Health System Development Initiative -grant 2005, sanctioned by DFID. The grant has been recommended for sanction by Department of Family Welfare, Govt. of India on June 16, 2005 and clearance has been given to DFID by DEA, Govt. of India on June 2005.

Accordingly, the following funds were placed from HSDI Grant 2005, to SUDA for continuation of the project upto March 2010.

While releasing fund during 2009-10, the H&FW Department, Govt. of West Bengal vide letter no. HFW/HSDI/502/HHW-30/06 dated 27 10:09 intimated to SUDA that the project of HHW Scheme in 11 Non KMA ULB, will come to an end on 31.3.10. SUDA authority approached H&FW Department, Govt. of West Bengal that three months were required to finalise the closing of accounts in 11 Non KMA ULBs as well as at SUDA and Rs. 72.36 lakh was required to meet up the recurring expenditure for this period. They also requested to allow three months time beyond 31.3.10 and to allow incur recurring expenditure during period out of fund available with SUDA. Project Director, HSDI vide order dated 24.2.10 extended 3 months

beyond 31.3.10 to finalize the closing of accounts in 11 Non KMA ULBs as well as of SUDA without the approval of Pr. Secretary of the H&FW Department violating the delegation of financial power.

It was also revealed that SUDA authority did neither refund the balance amount of Rs. 198.72 lakh nor submitted any closing accounts of 11 Non KMA ULBs as well as of SUDA to SH&FW Samiti Govt. of West Bengal till 27.3.2012.

SH&FW Samiti, Govt. of WB also did not take any action to receive back the amount of Rs. 192.78 lakh from SUDA.

It was also revealed that SUDA authority in each year demands fund not based on need resulting in accumulation of fund at their end.

Thus, H&FW Samiti, Govt. of WB allowed SUDA authority to utilize Rs. 192.78 lakh unauthorizedly according to their will beyond project period.

This is brought to the notice of Government.

Sir,

As you are aware the Health & Family Welfare Department, Municipal Affairs Department & SUDA are working together to bring out an uniform urban health service delivery system for the whole of West Bengal in tune with the Urban Health Strategy, 2008.

In keeping with the commitment of providing minimum basic health services to all the urban population, the following has been decided

- 1. Extension of the Community Based Primary Health Care programme in 63 Non-KMA ULBs for a further period of 1 year w.e.f. 01.04.10
- 2. Continuation of HHW scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs from the State Budget for a period of 1 year w.e.f. 01.04.10

Provision of fund of F.s.10.00 Crores has been made for the year 2010-2011 on basis of the following:

- 1. The rate of salary for the staff of ULBs under the programmes has been calculated on the existing scale.
- 2. Funds for training of HHWs/FTS were released in previous years and as per status report submitted vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-I)/08/597 dated 01.02. 10. Most of the training is complete. The unspent fund lying with SUDA will take care of the gap in training.
- 3. As stated in the letter vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-I)/08/597 dated 01.02. 10 the IEC materials have been printed all Kits and Manuals have been bought. Fresh allocation is made only to the extent replenishment would be required. Detailed list of articles that is proposed to be bought may be supplied.
- 4. Allocation for furniture and equipments have been made in the previous years and the report from SUDA states that the same has been purchased for all the health centres, so fresh allocation is not made in this sector. Fresh allocation may be made if required. SUDA has to submit list of Furniture and equipment bought and intended to be bought under the scheme.

5. Allocation for Drugs will be released subject to submission of Drug list. SUDA may be requested to make the purchases of drugs from CMS approved vendors at CMS approved

Further SUDA may be requested to submit the following:

- 1. List of all the ULBs under these programmes and their set-up.
- 2. The infrastructure available in these set-up including existing Manpower.
- 3. List of medicines that are purchased and supplied under these schemes

It may be noted that once the urban health service delivery system is in place the sanction made towards these schemes will automatically cease and unspent fund will merge with the budgetary allocation to be made for the integrated scheme. The modalities of the same may be decided once the scheme is operationalized. Yours faithfully,

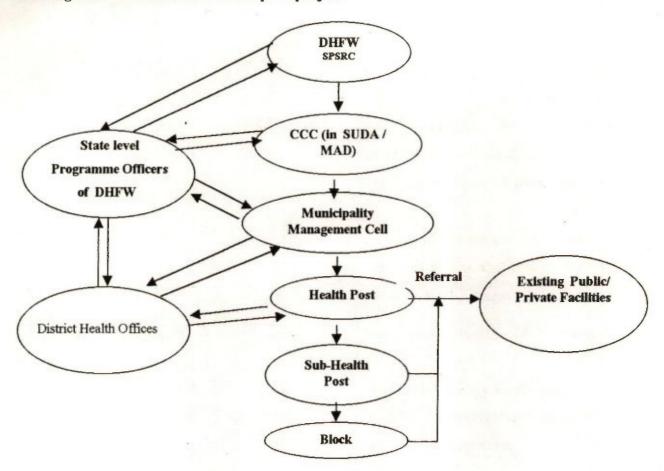
