
CHANGE MANAGEMENT UNIT (CMU)

NOTE

As discussed, the note regarding proposal for engagement of medical professionals to implement the health component of KUSP is placed below in the file for kind perusal. It was envisaged that six medical officers and six nutritionists will be entrusted for responsibility of about 10 ULBs each so that they can visit each ULB twice a month.

As discussed, the medical professionals will monitor and supervise the implementation of KUSP programme, which will aim at strengthening the existing honorary health worker system in the ULBs. After the support of KUSP programme is withdrawn, Government may like to retain the positions of the medical professionals so as to continue the supervisory and monitoring activities of the health programme by constituting a cell for the purpose which may be located in KMDA/SUDA.

Pr Roy/F. D may kindly recall that IPP-VIII project was implemented with support from World Bank (for 5 yrs from 1995) in 40 ULBs in KMDA area. Later on the project was extended to another 10 ULBs outside KMDA, during 00-01 & 01-02. The project was meant for extending mother-child health coverage to BPL households in these ULBs through Hon Health Workers & mostly part-time Doctors.

Since June 02, the facilities are being maintained with financial budgetary support of this Deptt, which is to the tune of Rs 15 EKT.



Annually, through about 25% of recurrent expenses are met by the ULBs through collection of user charges.

Initially in 40 ULBs the project was implemented by KMDA, & in 10 ULBs outside KMDA, by SVDA. For maintenance phase it was decided by the Apex Committee chaired by MoC of this Deptt that there would be a single "cell" at KMDA. During its implementation stage KMDA & SVDA engaged a no of retired Doctors & ULBs officers & others (Dr B. Bhattacharya, Dr N. G. Ganguly etc - to name a few). During the last 2/3 years the service of all these retired personnel have been dispensed with. It was also decided by the Apex Committee that while the sect support to the cell would be provided by KMDA through redeployment, the cell would require the support of a few experts (Gynaec/Paediatric, nutritionists etc) to provide necessary support & guidance so as to maintain the quality of service. It was also decided that these posts should preferably be manned by personnel from Health

X Depth on Deportation, failing which we may have to go in for open market recruitment.

In view of what has been stated about this DPP proposes creation of 5 posts of ~~medical~~ medical specialists in scale no 18 (consolidated pay of Rs 120/- p.m. in case of contractual app), 2 posts of nutritionists in scale no 17 (consolidated pay of Rs 10,00/- & above), 1 post of officer prof/statistician (in scale 16 / Contractual pay of Rs 80/-) to be manned as indicated in previous para.

DFID while reviewing

the programs of KVSF (which has a health component & providing support to strengthen KMA & CMU) in May '95 has strongly ~~recommended~~ recommended the creation of above posts. (An extract of their recommendation is enclosed).

It is proposed these personnel may initially be treated at CMU in the
