

MEMO

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to sanction payment of the sum of Rs.4,83,00,000/- (Rupees four crore eighty three lakh) only in favour of 32 (thirty two) Urban Local Bodies, as detailed in the enclosed statement for meeting the cost for repair of infrastructure (Particularly roads), damaged by Aila during May, 2009 against the requirements as verified by the Municipal Engineering Directorate, West Bengal. The Urban Local Bodies should strictly adhere to the schemes as verified by the Municipal Engineering Directorate as well as to the schedule of rates indicated by it.

- 2. The District Magistrates concerned are hereby authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 1 above in T.R. Form No. 31 and disburse the same to concerned Urban Local Bodies within his jurisdiction, by transfer credit to the Local Fund Account of the said Urban Local Bodies with the respective Treasuries.

- 5. The receipt of CRF in future will strictly depend on timely submission of the Utilisation Certificate, as indicated in the foregoing para. In this respect the guideline circulated may be referred to.
- 6. The fact of drawal /non-drawal of the fund by the Urban Local Bodies should be reported to this Department as early as possible.
- 7. The charge is debitable to the head of account "2245-Relief on Account of NC-02-193-NP-Non-Plan-001-31-Grantsin-aid-02-Other Grants-V-Voted" under Demand No. 47 from the Budget Provision of Disaster Management Department. With reference to your letter No. SUDA-Health/DFID/08/406 dt. 15.10.2009 on the subject mentioned above I like to mention that subject to approval of your budget proposal fund amounting to Rs. 150.00 lakh (Rupees one hundred fifty lakh) has been released in your favour vide Order No. HFW/HSDI/501/HHW-39-06 dated 27.10.2009. Now on examination, it is seen that so far a total fund of Rs. 723.48 lakh had been released in favour of your organization during the financial year 2005-06 to 2008-09 out of which Rs. 614.49 lakh (Rupees six hundred fourteen lakh forty nine thousand) have since been utilized upto 30.09.2009. Moreover, from the SOE submitted to the Government under cover of your letter no. SUDA-Health/316/08/39 dated 08.10.2009 it is evident that the expenditure for the purpose during the 1st and 2nd quarter of the financial year is Rs. 69,07,642/- (Rupees sixty nine lakh seven thousand six hundred forty two) only.

In view of the position it is not clear to the Government how your organization will utilize such huge fund of Rs. 496.49 lakh during the current financial year particularly when the DFID Project is going to be closed in March, 2010. You are, therefore, requested kindly to submit an itemwise expenditure with detail clarification on the basis of which the estimated Project Budget for the current financial year has been worked out.




