Madam.

I have the honour to inform you that many Posts in IPP-VII health Units are vacant in our municipality after resignation or death of honorary health worker (H.H.W.) and other staffs. It is becoming very difficult to run day to day work of urban health in our Municipality without engagement in vacant Posts.

Following posts in IPP-VIII health Units are vacant in Bhatpara Municipality

- 1) H.H.W. 16
- 2) Attendant 3
- 3) S.T.S. 11
- 4) P.T.M.O. 4
- 5) F.T.S. 1
- 6) Clerk 1

We have send letters to Director, SUDA (Ref.no.- U-S/541 dt. 14.5.2011 and on E-7/DR-1/1044 dated 16.6.2011) and M.I.C. Municipal affairs(No-M-10/Dr-1/2077 dated 8/9/11) and had discussion with M.I.C. Municipal affair on 21.6.2011 but till date no action taken.

There should be proper revision of honorarium of P.T.M.O., Nurse, M.O. and other staff, at per Rural Health Mission or health department pay pattern. We are not getting doctor, Nurse etc at present honorarium.

There should be proper manpower in our municipal hospital. We cannot start newly expanded 2nd Floor in our Hospital (Done under KUSP Project).

Old list of Drugs for health units and Hospital should be revised for proper utilization of fund allotted from SUDA. for which we have already given detailed proposal to Director, SUDA (E-7/DR-1/1044 dated 16.6.2011).

All these matters are very essential for proper running of health establishment of Bhatpara Municipality and I would request you to take appropriate action.

Sir,

Forwarding information's regarding positions of health establishment Bhatpara Municipality as per Proforma given by you, for your consideration, at the same time I am drawing attention towards main problems of Municipality health establishment.

Present support given by Government (Through SUDA) is insufficient. Payment given to Doctors, Nurses and other technical Staffs is totally very poor. We are not getting Doctors, Nurses to run vital services of Hospital, though we have added one new floor with 20 bed capacities with two modern O.T.(under KUSP Programme) We cannot start it because of manpower shortage . So we suggest

- i) <u>Manpower is the most important problem to run</u> municipal hospitals, payment should be at per with health department for all Staffs'. We have given manpower requirement for Hospital in Annexure -B, for health units permission should be given for immediate engagement in approved post.
 - ii) Contingency amount should be increased for maternity /ESOPD /Health Units at least by 100%, as there is heavy increase of all cost in last ten years (like electric bills).
 - iii) Old drug list should be immediately revised to cover essential drugs needed in hospital, we have given in Annexure- C & D.

- a. Promotion of 60nos. staff out of 110 is still awaiting since 2005 :
- b Non receipt of approval of 62 pre '92 casual employees of Bhatpara Municipality;
- c. Approval of benefit for casual workers (Rs. 6600) not yet been received.

B) Financial matter;-

- We have not received any grant for purchase of land for SWM Projects refer to our correspondence J-2/WW/DR-1686 dated 2.8.2011.
- We are losing revenue from 3 nos Ferry Ghat : For detail refer to our correspondence F-4/Dr-2/1744 dated 5.8.2011.
- We have not, yet received Arearer claim on pension and family pension for 2009-10 and relief on arrear pension for 4th Pay Commission refer to our correspondence E-18/7193 &7194 dated 22.3.2011 though grant released vide memo no 14G/MA/N/C-2/1G-21/2009 dated 19.5.2011
- We are not getting any allocation of SFC, EGS, 13 Finance, WBUES (2nd Installment) and Tax on vehicle scheme though we have already submitted UC.
- e.We have to pay Rs. 12.4852 Crore towards ULB's Contribution for surface water project. We need financial assistance from the Govt.in this regard.
- f.Financial assistance required for enhanced gratuity payment to the ULB employees Rs.1.51 to 3.65 lac C) Development projects:

- a. we have sent 9 nos. development scheme vide memo no. A-32/DR-1/1867 dated 24/8/2011 but till date no fund allocated.
- b. The Rajiv Awas Yojana project has not yet been started in our Municipality. We have informed you the matter vide our letter no. M-10/WW/DR-2/759 dated 9.6.11
 - c. Storm Water Drainage and Inter- Municipal drain from Naihati to Icchapur canal.
 - d. Sewerage project. Crematorium, Beautification of Ganga ghats, Slaughter House under NGRBA.

We need your direct interference into the matter

D) Health Units & Hospital matter:

- a. Our main problem is Manpower in hospital and we request you to give required manpower, with same pay structure of Health Dept. Staffs.
- b. In health units present approved vacant posts needed to be filled up urgently and permission to be given to SUDA for proper payment to .P.T.M.O. and GNM Nurses as per rate of Rural Health Mission or
- c. Contingency amount for Health units, ESOPD & Maternity should be at least doubled because of heavy electricity bill and escalation in all other cost since last decade.
- d. to fill up the vacant post of I Phylide memo no. SUDA health / 538 /09 /392 dated 28/1/2011. All these matters are very very essential for the development of Bhatpara Municipality and I would request you again kindly to take appropriate action.







- If the HHWs within the age group of 50 years are not available keeping other criteria for FTS selection unaltered, selection be done from freshly engaged HHWs completion of six experience.

You may be aware that as per Urban Health Strategy, 2008, one HHW is to look after 1,000 BPL population contained in a single ward and there will be a minimum of one HHW per ward regardless of whether that ward has BPL population or not.

A statement for 126 ULBs showing ULBs-wise no. of wards, total BPL population as per recent survey, estimated no. of required HHWs and existing no. of HHWs is enclosed at Annexure – A. While calculating required no. of HHWs per ward of the ULB, the BPL population per HHW has been kept to 1,500 nos. keeping in view natural growth rate.

The statement at Annexure – A reflects that the ULBs implementing CUDP III, CSIP, IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII (Extn.) and RCH Sub-Project are having more than required no. of HHWs for the specific Health programmes. However, communications are being received from the Chairman of the ULBs seeking permission to fill up vacant post for Honorary Health Workers (HHWs).

As per latest household survey, 2006, the BPL population per ward, estimated no. of required HHWs and the existing no. of HHWs under different Health programme are enclosed at Annexure - I.

As per guideline/ Urban Health Strategy, one HHW is to be allotted for a population not exceeding 1000 BPL contained in a single ward. A ward having less than 1000 BPL population will also have one HHW; a ward having BPL population between 1000 - 2000 will have 2 HHWs and so on. There will be minimum one HHW per ward regardless of whether that ward has BPL population or not. However, while calculating required no. of HHWs per ward, 1 (one) HHW is earmarked for 1500 BPL population in a single ward instead of The same principle had been followed in 63 Non-KMA ULBs implementing CBPHCS and 11 Non-KMA ULBs implementing HHW Scheme.

It may be seen that none of the ULBs is entitled to get HHWs to fill up the existing vacancy as there are already excess no. of HHWs existing.

Under the circumstances, may we inform the ULBs stating the above facts for making necessary adjustment by re-organising the existing HHWs within the wards of the ULBs irrespective of Health Programmes.


From the statements placed below it appears that in 63 ULBs where IPP - VIII, IPP VIII (Extn.), RCH (Asansol Sub-project) and DFID assisted HHW Programmes were implemented, the total sanctioned strength of Honorary Health Workers is 6869, which appears to be on the much higher side in comparison with total no. of current BPL population (22.56 lakhs) as well as total no. of wards (1517 nos.) in the concerned 63 ULBs.

Now as per Urban Health Strategy published by the Health and Family Welfare (H&FW) Department, one Honorary Health Worker (HHW) is to be engaged for each ward of an ULB irrespective of BPL population of that ward or one HHW per 1000 BPL population of the concerned ward. If the total BPL population of a ward exceeds 1000, additional HHW can be engaged based on the aforesaid norm. Accordingly estimated no. of HHW for 63 ULBs comes around 2,374 while the existing no. of HHWs working in the abovementioned 63 ULBs as already mentioned is 6869. Hence there is at present 4,495 nos. of surplus HHW in 63 ULBs. Incidentally it is mentioned that in remaining 63 ULBs implementing CBPHCS, engagement of HHW has been made following the above strategy and hence there is no surplus HHW.

Now as the total no. of HHWs exceeds revised requirement of ULBs, the point which may be decided is whether SUDA should accord approval to the proposal(s) of ULBs to fill up sanctioned vacancies in the posts of HHW. Incidentally it is mentioned that since the HHWs have been engaged on honorarium basis, the maximum age limit for extension of their tenure of engagement have not yet been decided by the Government inspite of the fact that many ULBs have verbally reported that a good of no. of such workers are not physically strong enough to make required nos. of field visit, which is their basic function. Now as this is a touchy issue, we may at present request the ULBs who has already sought SUDA's approval to fill up vacancies of HHW to re-organise HHW structure as per requirement of each ward in a meeting of ULB level MHFW Committee with approval of BOC.


