2. One computer and One Data Asstt for compilation of data (if ULBs need specific support from District Health samity, it may be spelt out in the meeting
3. specific funding for AVD. To do so, if you prepare tentative budget (No of centre x Rs 50 x 4 x 12) for each ULBs and submit in the meeting we may push to finalized from available funds (funds for alternate vaccinator)
4. Streamlining of vaccines supply from District based on the monthly requirements (if it can be worked out it will be helpful)
5. We need to submit coverage report (presently district monthly report dose not capture that, so you have to prepare from your data base)
6. Monitoring plan.

Khalil Ahmed, I.A.S., District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas presided over the meeting. Dr. S. N. Bagchi, Project Manager WBSISC initiated discussion on strengthening Routine Immunization in the Municipalities of South 24 Parganas. After prolonged discussion the following resolutions were adopted in the meeting for effective implementation of the Program.

1. Supply Cold chain equipments (ILR & DF) to 7 ULBS

To overcome the acute shortage of ILR & DF, it has been decided that the district will supply 6 ILRs to Maheshtala (M)-2, Rajpur Sonarpur (M)-2, Diamond Harbour (M)-1, Baruipur (M)-1 & 5 DF (Budge Budge (M)-1, DH (M)-1 and Rajpur Sonarpur (M)-2) immediately from the District store (attention -Dy. CMOH-III).

2. Funds for alternate vaccine delivery/ alternate vaccinators

Baruipur – M will hire alternate vaccinators & the rest Municipalities will be supported funds for Alternate Vaccine Delivery (ADV) by the CMOH, South 24 Parganas. Accordingly total requirements of fund for one year will be Rs.1,71,000/-(approx) This fund will be utilized from funds for slum & underserved area under strengthening Routine Immunization(SRI) 2009-2010. The project Officer – Health (SUDA) will send a consolidated proposal to CMOH , South 24 Parganas for this purpose. The CMOH will allocate the fund for 1 year directly to the Chairman of the respective ULBs. The ULBs will submit SOE & UC on quarterly basis to the district authority (attention -CMOH, South 24 Parganas & Project Officer Health (SUDA).

3. Supply of vaccines & Logistics to ULBs

The district will ensure that all vaccines & logistic should be supplied to all ULBs on monthly basis for Diamond Harbour (M) the vaccine will be supplied from Diamond Harbour -SDH.

For other ULBs it will be supplied from District Store (attention- DY CMOH-III).

4. Immunization waste management

Project Officer, Health (SUDA) will prepare a consolidated Waste management plan and send to CMOH, South 24 Parganas for 7 ULBs. The plan will include identification of out sourcing agency for disposal of Immunization Waste & also funding requirement for one year. Since no funds under Immunization waste management has been sanctioned under strengthening Routine Immunization funds, the Dist. Health & FW Samity may explore possibility of sanctioning funds from accrued interest of NRHM flexi pool funds. The CMOH will submit proposal to dist. Health & FW Samity for approval (Attention- Project officer, health (SUDA) & Dy. CMOH- III).

5. Monthly meeting on Routine immunization

It has been decided that Dy CMOH-III will organize regular monthly meeting at District HQ on 6th of every month (or next working day if 6th happens to be holiday) exclusively for ULBs. It will be attended by all ULBs. During this meeting, the ULBs will submit monthly-consolidated report of Immunization (Attention- Dy CMOH-III).

6. Routine Immunization Reporting format

The ULBs will submit hard copy of the coverage report on Block NRHM format (Attention - ULBs representative).

7. Incorporation of ULBs activities under District Health Plan

District health authority will incorporate ULBs activities in District health Plan.

8. Computer Assistant & Computer support

Presently all blocks are submitting online immunization reports to District/ State through online reporting structure. However ULBs do not have computer and Computer Assistant. Project Officer, Health (SUDA) will submit consolidated proposal for supply of one computer and one computer assistant for all 7 ULBs. District Health & FW Samity will explore necessary funding support for the purpose (Attention - Project Officer, health (SUDA)/ Dy CMOH-III).

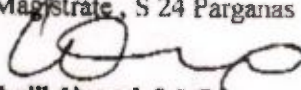

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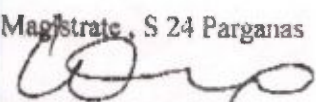

S u b: Improvement of Immunization Coverage in hard-to-reach areas.

You are aware that in spite of our best efforts to improve the immunization coverage, there are still some areas which are hard to reach and remain unattended. In order to improve immunization status, some priority interventions, such as identification of those areas and area specific plan, have already been made by you. Funds for the same have already been released for this purpose.

In this connection, reference is invited to letter no. H/SFWB/12(18), dated 8th January, 2008 wherein it has been mentioned that financial implication of each session will be as follows:-

Honorarium for the alternative vaccinator	: Rs. 300/- per session.
Contingency	: Rs. 50 per session.

Contd. in Page - 2.

During the recently-held Regional Review Meetings taken up by Hon'ble M.I.C., it has been pointed out by some District Authorities that such restriction of payment of Rs. 300/- only for the alternative vaccinator has created some problem in the ground situation.

In view of this and in partial modification of the above order it has since been decided that this amount of Rs. 300/- can also be utilized in full or in part as per local plan or intervention that may include alternative vaccinator, mobility support or any other area specific necessities, in order to reach out to these unserved/underserved hard-to-reach areas.

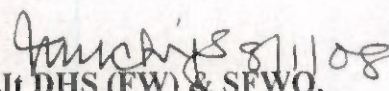

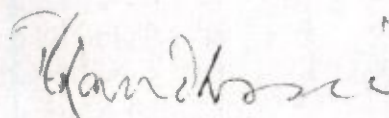
