I am directed to inform you that CBPHCS Programme in 63 non-KMA ULBs was started in the year 2006 with the support of the Department of Health & Family Welfare this 2009 and Dankuni Municipality has been estimated by merging Dankuni, Mrigala, MAnoharpur & part of Garalgacha Gram Panchayat where Uttarpara Kotrang Municipality had already set up 7 nos of sub-contres under IPP VIII, all of which now fall within niewly formed Dankuni Municipality.

Now, introduction of Urban Health Programme in Dankuni Municipal Area independently is under active consideration of this Department.

In the circumstances, I would like to request you to consider inclusion of Dankuni Municipality under CBPHCS so that Urban Health Programme can be implemented by the said municipality independently by way of using the existing 7 sub-centres and the staff may be allowed to be continued in the proposed CBPHCS set up.
