At a glance report on Manual Scavengers

I. Abolition of Manual Scavenging

A Notification no. 1525/MA/P/C-10/3S-27/99 dated 13.11.2003 was issued by the Municipal Affairs Department prohibiting engagement of manual scavengers in urban areas following the directions laid down by Implementation of the Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition) Act, 2003. [Annexure - A]

II. Existence of Manual Scavengers: -

On scrutiny of the allegation made by Safai Karmachari Andolon an NGO, working on this field regarding existence of 29 manual scavengers in the State, it was found that only 11 of them appeared to be within the jurisdiction of urban areas of the State of West Bengal and after physical enquiry conducted by Municipal Engineering Directorate and Kolkata Municipal Corporation, it was found that no such manual scavenger do exists in urban areas. Accordingly the information was communicated to MoHUPA, Government of India. [Annexure - B].

III. Safai Karmacharis in Municipalities

After the last meeting of the Commission (3/4 months back) held on the issue of number of Safai Karmacharis in different ULBs, information was sought for from all ULBs. [Annexure - C]

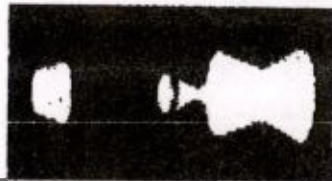
AND WHEREAS the Statutory periods after the publication of the aforesaid Draft Notifications are over;

In inviting reference to your letter No. 17034/1/2011-H(FTS-1801) dated 08.11.2011 addressed to the Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal on alleged existence of 29 identified manual scavengers and 56 dry latrines in the State of West Bengal, I am directed to inform you that after careful examination of the available document from 'Safai Karmachari Andolan' and on the basis of the enquiry reports obtained from Kolkata Municipal Corporation and Municipal Engineering Directorate under Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal, it appears that no such manual scavenger and dry latrine do exist in the urban areas of the State of West Bengal.

You will kindly appreciate that informations on the same subject had already been submitted to the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the Ministry of Rural Development, Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India. Copies are enclosed for your kind perusal.

I am further directed to inform you that regarding existence of manual scavengers or dry latrines, if any, as per report from 'Safai Karmachari Andolan' may be located within the jurisdictional limit of rural areas and details of which may be obtained from P&RD Department and also from Backward Classes Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal

With reference to the above, I am to inform you regarding Manual Scavengers as follows :

i) For District Darjeeling, West Bengal – Annexure – I -Manual Scavengers if any do not fall within the administrative jurisdiction of any Urban Local Body of Darjeeling District, which may fall within rural area, except 2 nos. (Sl. 1 & 7) within Siliguri Municipal Corporation. The existence of 2 nos. within Siliguri Municipal Corporation could not be checked due absence of detailed address.

ii) For District Jalpaiguri, West Bengal – Annexure – II - Existing Manual Scavengers if any do not fall within the administrative jurisdiction of any Urban Local Body of Jalpaiguri District, which may fall within rural area.

North 24 Parganas District, West Bengal – Annexure – III - M. E. Directorate's Engineer
visited along with Urban Local Body (Bhatpara Municipality) Engineer / personnel on
06.06.2011 and they found there is no existence of manual scavengers.

iv) For South 24 Parganas District – Annexure – IV which is not within the jurisdiction of M. E.
Dte. Kolkata Municipal Corporation may kindly be informed in this regards.

v) For District West Midnapore, West Bengal - Annexure – V - Existing Manual Scavengers if any
do not fall within the administrative jurisdiction of any Urban Local Body of West Midnapore
District, which may fall within rural area.

STATUS REPORT

INTEGRATED LOW COST SANITATION SCHEME: -

It is a centrally sponsored programme initiated in 1991 with the aim to put an end to the system of carrying night soil by head load by converting the existing service latrines into *Pour Flush Latrine* and by constructing new P.F.L latrines to minimize the environmental pollution of the towns.

195041 units constructed in phase I to XIV till date.

Kalna town has been included in Phase VII but this Phase has been dropped. Phase XI has not been considered by HUDCO.

Four newly constituted municipalities e.g. *Dhupguri, Dalkhola, Nalhati and Panskura*, have been covered under ILCS Programme in Phase-X & XIV respectively.

Asansol MC and *Kulti* town have been included in Phase - XII and *Bishnupur* town has also been included in Phase XIII. Those three towns are covered with conversion of Dry Latrines.

A. LIBERATION OF SCAVENGERS:-

Even after implementation of *ILCS Programme* with an aim to liberate and rehabilitate all the scavengers in other jobs, no existence of scavengers has been reported in 7 towns after carrying out a fresh survey. All the existing dry latrine has already been converted in low cost sanitary latrine.

There were 4022 nos. of dry latrines still existed in 7 non-KMA ULBs which had already been converted into PFL, an amount of Rs. 127.35 lakhs has been released so far. Rs. 145.30 lakhs has been utilized till date as stated below.

A total number of 10048 scavengers have so far been liberated and rehabilitated in different professions in 126 ULBs in West Bengal and there are no existence of manual scavengers in all the ULBs.

Comments on Draft Bill on "The Prohibition of Employment as manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Bill 2012" of Municipal Affairs Department:-

Section 5A This section prohibits hazardous manual cleaning of Sewer and Septic tanks and imposes obligation on employer to provide cleaning devices and protection gear to such workers to eliminate risk to their health and safety. To get the cleaning system mechanized and for taking protection measures as required for hazardous cleaning may necessitate huge fund. The period for completion of this huge task should be a few years instead of 1 year, after commencing of this Act.

Section 4 This Section prohibits insanitary latrine. Every insanitary latrine shall either be demolished or be converted into a sanitary latrine by the occupier at his own cost within 9 months from the date of commencement of this Act.

It appears that cleaning of Municipal open drains carrying human excreta with other waste will also attract this Provision as insanitary latrine and manual cleaning of such drains should be stopped from the date of commencement of this act. After enactment of this Act all such drains should be cleaned mechanically by using technique like high pressure waterjet and suction machine. It is very difficult to demolish or convert all the insanitary latrines in this state (particularly 60,072 insanitary latrines in urban area) within only a few months: some more time is required.

Key Strategy :

- Universal coverage – the entire urban population including both APL and BPL to be covered, while keeping the focus on BPL.
- Strengthening service delivery through a uniform 3 tier service delivery model.

- ANC / PNC Clinic, Immunisation Clinic, Growth Monitoring Clinic, General Treatment clinic, Awareness Programme on gender equality, age at married pregnancy, contraceptive adoption etc.

Third Tier :

Referral services either in the Municipal owned Extended Specialized Out Patient Department / Diagnostic Centre / Maternity Home, if any or in the Government run nearby hospital.

**BRIEF NOTES ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF NHRC ON MANUAL
SCAVANGING AND SANITATION**

There are **127** Urban Local Bodies in West Bengal including Corporation (Kolkata Municipal Corporation, Asansol Municipal Corporation & Siliguri Municipal Corporation). So far our report goes by virtue of a number of Notifications latest by 2004-05, the work of scavenging is completely stopped in any of the Urban Local Bodies. So far it is ascertained that there is no manual scavenging in any of the Urban Local Bodies. As per rules if anyone is found to engage any scavenging work for carrying night soil is punishable. Even if anyone is found to carry night soil at his own is also punishable.

1) Survey was completed on manual scavenging: - So far our report goes a total number of **10048** scavengers were identified, liberated and rehabilitated in **126** urban local bodies. It may be noted that there is no existence of manual scavengers in any of the local bodies.

2) The Municipal Engineering Directorate of Urban Local Bodies has taken effective steps to convert all the dry latrine into P.F.L. (Pour Flush Latrine). As per report **195041** units have been converted into P.F.L. in 14 phases against which fund utilized (Under Integrated Low Cost Schemes Sanitation) was Rs. **7745.69** lacs (Report as per Annexure 'A').

Only **4022** numbers of dry latrines are yet to be converted into PFL. It may be noted that the work of conversion of such dry latrines into PFL has been taken up and an amount of Rs. **127.35** lacs has been released for the purpose (Report As per Annexure 'B').

3) Nothing to comment.

- 4) The Government of West Bengal is following the manual of Employment of Manual scavengers and construction of dry latrines (Prevention Act, 1993.)
- 5) So far as the elimination of the practice of manual scavenging and rehabilitation work is concerned in West Bengal, the Department of Municipal Affairs and Department of Backward Class Welfare through its Directorate and Corporation such as Municipal Engineering Directorate and State Urban Development Agency for the Municipal Affairs Department and West Bengal Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Development and Finance Corporation are closely monitoring the programme. District Magistrates within their jurisdictions are monitoring the works like conversions or demolition of dry latrines, rehabilitation of manual scavengers, prosecution of defaulters etc.
- 6) Nothing to comment for the State of West Bengal.
- 7) In West Bengal, Municipal and Panchayet bodies have not allowed construction of a new house with dry latrine or without a water shield latrine or sanitary latrine. On the contrary for a number of years the Panchayet bodies have been encouraging low cost sanitary latrine for every household. It may be noted that a number of districts, so far our survey report goes, have been fully sanitized.
- 8) Nothing to comment.
- 9) The scholarship to the children of manual scavengers have not been stopped in West Bengal even after their parents have been liberated from manual scavenging and rehabilitated. So far our report goes 2609 boys and girls have been provided with grants of Rs. 48,09,350 for the year 2009-10. It may be noted that for the year 2010-11 Rs. 80,32,350/- is required for the purpose of grants to 4239 boys and girls belonging to the families of scavengers (Report as per Annexure 'D').

10) The Panchayet and Urban Local Bodies are taking steps to issue BPL cards for the scavenger families who are entitled.

11) Banks are requested to simplify their procedure for giving loans to the scavengers for their rehabilitation. So far our report goes against a target group of 6708 identified scavengers' families, 3733 number of bank loans were disbursed to the scavenger families. (Report as per Annexure 'C').

12) Urban Local Bodies publish notices in print media for not to indulge in the practice of scavenging.

13) It is imperative on the part of State Human Rights Commission to monitor the elimination of manual scavenging and their consequent rehabilitation.

INTEGRATED LOW COST SANITATION SCHEME: -

It is a centrally sponsored programme initiated in 1991 with the aim to put an end to the system of carrying night soil by head load by converting the existing service latrines into Pour Flush Latrine and by constructing new P.F.L latrines to minimize the environmental pollution of the towns.

195041 units constructed in phase I to XIV till date.

Four newly constituted municipalities e.g. Dhupguri, Dalkhola, Nalhati and Panskura, have been covered under ILCS Programme in Phase-X & XIV respectively.

A. LIBERATION OF SCAVENGERS:-

Even after implementation of ILCS Programme with an aim to liberate and rehabilitate all the scavengers in other jobs, no existence of scavengers has been reported in 7 towns after carrying out a fresh survey. All the existing dry latrine has already been converted in low cost sanitary latrine.

There are 4022 nos. of dry latrines still existing in 7 non-KMA ULBs. For conversion of these dry latrines into PFL, an amount of Rs. 127.35 lakhs has been released so far. Rs. 145.30 lakhs has been utilized till date.

A total number of 10048 scavengers have so far been liberated and rehabilitated in different professions in 126 ULBs in West Bengal and there are no existence of manual scavengers in all the ULBs.



Major Urban Health strategies / activities carried out :

Key Strategy :

- Universal coverage – the entire urban population including both APL and BPL to be covered, while keeping the focus on BPL.
- Strengthening service delivery through a uniform 3 tier service delivery model.
- Strengthening institutional arrangements and inter departmental convergence.
- Strengthening monitoring and evaluation.

Activities :

First Tier :

All the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) provide outreach services through fortnightly home visit by Honorary Health Worker (HHW) engaged from community. One HHW covers 1,000 to 1,500 BPL population.

- Awareness on women and child Health, sexuality, gender equality, age at marriage / pregnancy etc.
- Distribution of condoms, oral contraceptive pills, IFA, ORS etc.
- Early registration of pregnancies, pregnancy care, clean and safe delivery, nutritional care during pregnancy, identification of danger signs during pregnancy.
- Counselling regarding breast-feeding, weaning and immunizations.
- Treatment of minor ailments at door-step of the beneficiaries.

Second Tier :

All the ULBs provide clinic services from Urban Sub-Centre covering 10,000 population. Each Sub-Centre is manned by First Tier Supervisor (FTS) daily and part-time Medical Officer on clinic days.

- ANC / PNC Clinic, Immunisation Clinic, Growth Monitoring Clinic, General Treatment clinic, Awareness Programme on gender equality, age at married pregnancy, contraceptive adoption etc.

Third Tier :

Referral services either in the Municipal owned Extended Specialized Out Patient Department / Diagnostic Centre / Maternity Home, if any or in the Government run nearby hospital.

At a glance report on Manual Scavengers

I. Abolition of Manual Scavenging

A Notification no. 1525/MA/P/C-10/3S-27/99 dated 13.11.2003 was issued by the Municipal Affairs Department prohibiting engagement of manual scavengers in urban areas following the directions laid down by Implementation of the Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition) Act, 2003. [Annexure - A]

II. Existence of Manual Scavengers: -

On scrutiny of the allegation made by Safai Karmachari Andolon an NGO, working on this field regarding existence of 29 manual scavengers in the State, it was found that only 11 of them appeared to be within the jurisdiction of urban areas of the State of West Bengal and after physical enquiry conducted by Municipal Engineering Directorate and Kolkata Municipal Corporation, it was found that no such manual scavenger do exists in urban areas. Accordingly the information was communicated to MoHUPA, Government of India. [Annexure - B].

III. Safai Karmacharis in Municipalities

After the last meeting of the Commission (3/4 months back) held on the issue of number of Safai Karmacharis in different ULBs, information was sought for from all ULBs. [Annexure - C]

**BRIEF NOTES ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF NHRC ON MANUAL
SCAVANGING AND SANITATION**

There are **127** Urban Local Bodies in West Bengal including Corporation (Kolkata Municipal Corporation, Asansol Municipal Corporation & Siliguri Municipal Corporation). So far our report goes by virtue of a number of Notifications latest by 2004-05, the work of scavenging is completely stopped in any of the Urban Local Bodies. So far it is ascertained that there is no manual scavenging in any of the Urban Local Bodies. As per rules if anyone is found to engage any scavenging work for carrying night soil is punishable. Even if anyone is found to carry night soil at his own is also punishable.

- 1) Survey was completed on manual scavenging: - So far our report goes a total number of **10048** scavengers were identified, liberated and rehabilitated in **126** urban local bodies. It may be noted that there is no existence of manual scavengers in any of the local bodies.
- 2) The Municipal Engineering Directorate of Urban Local Bodies has taken effective steps to convert all the dry latrine into P.F.L. (Pour Flush Latrine). As per report **195041** units have been converted into P.F.L. in 14 phases against which fund utilized (Under Integrated Low Cost Schemes Sanitation) was Rs. **7745.69** lacs (Report as per Annexure 'A').
Only **4022** numbers of dry latrines are yet to be converted into PFL. It may be noted that the work of conversion of such dry latrines into PFL has been taken up and an amount of Rs. **127.35** lacs has been released for the purpose (Report As per Annexure 'B').
- 3) Nothing to comment.

4) The Government of West Bengal is following the manual of Employment of Manual scavengers and construction of dry latrines (*Prevention Act, 1993.*)

5) So far as the elimination of the practice of manual scavenging and rehabilitation work is concerned in West Bengal, the Department of Municipal Affairs and Department of Backward Class Welfare through its Directorate and Corporation such as Municipal Engineering Directorate and State Urban Development Agency for the Municipal Affairs Department and West Bengal Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Development and Finance Corporation are closely monitoring the programme. District Magistrates within their jurisdictions are monitoring the works like conversions or demolition of dry latrines, rehabilitation of manual scavengers, prosecution of defaulters etc.

6) Nothing to comment for the State of West Bengal.

7) In West Bengal, Municipal and Panchayet bodies have not allowed construction of a new house with dry latrine or without a water shield latrine or sanitary latrine. On the contrary for a number of years the Panchayet bodies have been encouraging low cost sanitary latrine for every household. It may be noted that a number of districts, so far our survey report goes, have been fully sanitized.

8) Nothing to comment.

9) The scholarship to the children of manual scavengers have not been stopped in West Bengal even after their parents have been liberated from manual scavenging and rehabilitated. So far our report goes 2609 boys and girls have been provided with grants of Rs. 48,09,350 for the year 2009-10. It may be noted that for the year 2010-11 Rs. 80,32,350/- is required for the purpose of grants to 4239 boys and girls belonging to the families of scavengers (*Report as per Annexure 'D'*).

10) The Panchayet and Urban Local Bodies are taking steps to issue BPL cards for the scavenger families who are entitled.

11) Banks are requested to simplify their procedure for giving loans to the scavengers for their rehabilitation. So far our report goes against a target group of 6708 identified scavengers' families, 3733 number of bank loans were disbursed to the scavenger families. (Report as per Annexure 'C').

12) Urban Local Bodies publish notices in print media for not to indulge in the practice of scavenging.

13) It is imperative on the part of State Human Rights Commission to monitor the elimination of manual scavenging and their consequent rehabilitation.

STATUS REPORT UPTO 2010-2011

INTEGRATED LOW COST SANITATION SCHEME: -

It is a centrally sponsored programme initiated in 1991 with the aim to put an end to the system of carrying night soil by head load by converting the existing service latrines into Pour Flush Latrine and by constructing new P.F.L latrines to minimize the environmental pollution of the towns.

195041 units constructed in phase I to XIV till date.

Four newly constituted municipalities e.g. Dhupguri, Dalkhola, Nalhati and Panskura, have been covered under ILCS Programme in Phase-X & XIV respectively.

Funding pattern of different Phases is furnished below: -

A. LIBERATION OF SCAVENGERS:-

Even after implementation of ILCS Programme with an aim to liberate and rehabilitate all the scavengers in other jobs, no existence of scavengers has been reported in 7 towns after carrying out a fresh survey. All the existing dry latrine has already been converted in low cost sanitary latrine.

There are 4022 nos. of dry latrines still existing in 7 non-KMA ULBs. For conversion of these dry latrines into PFL, an amount of Rs. 127.35 lakhs has been released so far. Rs. 145.30 lakhs has been utilized till date.

A total number of 10048 scavengers have so far been liberated and rehabilitated in different professions in 126 ULBs in West Bengal and there are no existence of manual scavengers in all the ULBs.

Background of CBPHCS and HHW Scheme

CBPHCS Scheme was launched in 63 Non-KMA ULBs during February, 2006 vide communication of DHFW bearing no. HFW/HSDI/URBAN Health/02/05/38/06 dt. 21.02.2006 (at Flag – A) with an estimated budget of Rs. 5829.68 lakhs for three years (at Flag – B).

HHW Scheme was launched in 11 Non-KMA ULBs during February, 2004 vide communication of DHFW bearing no. SS(P)/HSDI/HHW/628 dt. December 5, 2003 (at Flag – C).

Major Urban Health strategies / activities carried out :

Key Strategy :

- Universal coverage – the entire urban population including both APL and BPL to be covered, while keeping the focus on BPL.
- Strengthening service delivery through a uniform 3 tier service delivery model.
- Strengthening institutional arrangements and inter departmental convergence.
- Strengthening monitoring and evaluation.

Activities :

First Tier :

All the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) provide outreach services through fortnightly home visit by Honorary Health Worker (HHW) engaged from community. One HHW covers 1,000 to 1,500 BPL population.

- Awareness on women and child Health, sexuality, gender equality, age at marriage / pregnancy etc.
- Distribution of condoms, oral contraceptive pills, IFA, ORS etc.
- Early registration of pregnancies, pregnancy care, clean and safe delivery, nutritional care during pregnancy, identification of danger signs during pregnancy.
- Counselling regarding breast-feeding, weaning and immunizations.
- Treatment of minor ailments at door-step of the beneficiaries.

Second Tier :

All the ULBs provide clinic services from Urban Sub-Centre covering 10,000 population. Each Sub-Centre is manned by First Tier Supervisor (FTS) daily and part-time Medical Officer on clinic days.

- ANC / PNC Clinic, Immunisation Clinic, Growth Monitoring Clinic, General Treatment clinic, Awareness Programme on gender equality, age at married pregnancy, contraceptive adoption etc.

Third Tier :

Referral services either in the Municipal owned Extended Specialized Out Patient Department / Diagnostic Centre / Maternity Home, if any or in the Government run nearby hospital.

At a glance report on Manual Scavengers

I. Abolition of Manual Scavenging

A Notification no. 1525/MA/P/C-10/3S-27/99 dated 13.11.2003 was issued by the Municipal Affairs Department prohibiting engagement of manual scavengers in urban areas following the directions laid down by Implementation of the Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition) Act, 2003. [Annexure - A]

II. Existence of Manual Scavengers: -

On scrutiny of the allegation made by Safai Karmachari Andolon an NGO, working on this field regarding existence of 29 manual scavengers in the State, it was found that only 11 of them appeared to be within the jurisdiction of urban areas of the State of West Bengal and after physical enquiry conducted by Municipal Engineering Directorate and Kolkata Municipal Corporation, it was found that no such manual scavenger do exists in urban areas. Accordingly the information was communicated to MoHUPA, Government of India. [Annexure - B].

III. Safai Karmacharis in Municipalities

After the last meeting of the Commission (3/4 months back) held on the issue of number of Safai Karmacharis in different ULBs, information was sought for from all ULBs. [Annexure - C]





STATUS REPORT

INTEGRATED LOW COST SANITATION SCHEME: -

It is a centrally sponsored programme initiated in 1991 with the aim to put an end to the system of carrying night soil by head load by converting the existing service latrines into *Pour Flush Latrine* and by constructing new P.F.L latrines to minimize the environmental pollution of the towns.

195041 units constructed in phase I to XIV till date.

Kalna town has been included in Phase VII but this Phase has been dropped. Phase XI has not been considered by HUDCO.

Four newly constituted municipalities e.g. *Dhupguri, Dalkhola, Nalhati and Panskura*, have been covered under ILCS Programme in Phase-X & XIV respectively.

Asansol MC and *Kulti* town have been included in Phase - XII and *Bishnupur* town has also been included in Phase XIII. Those three towns are covered with conversion of Dry Latrines.

Status Report on ILCS Programme of different phases at a glance is furnished below:-

A. LIBERATION OF SCAVENGERS: -

Even after implementation of *ILCS Programme* with an aim to liberate and rehabilitate all the scavengers in other jobs, no existence of scavengers has been reported in 7 towns after carrying out a fresh survey. All the existing dry latrine has already been converted in low cost sanitary latrine.

There were 4022 nos. of dry latrines still existed in 7 non-KMA ULBs which had already been converted into PFL, an amount of Rs. 127.35 lakhs has been released so far. Rs. 145.30 lakhs has been utilized till date as stated below.

A total number of 10048 scavengers have so far been liberated and rehabilitated in different professions in 126 ULBs in West Bengal and there are no existence of manual scavengers in all the ULBs.

Comments on Draft Bill on "The Prohibition of Employment as manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Bill 2012" of Municipal Affairs Department:-

Section 5A This section prohibits hazardous manual cleaning of Sewer and Septic tanks and imposes obligation on employer to provide cleaning devices and protection gear to such workers to eliminate risk to their health and safety. To get the cleaning system mechanized and for taking protection measures as required for hazardous cleaning may necessitate huge fund. The period for completion of this huge task should be a few years instead of 1 year, after commencing of this Act.

Section 4 This Section prohibits insanitary latrine. Every insanitary latrine shall either be demolished or be converted into a sanitary latrine by the occupier at his own cost within 9 months from the date of commencement of this Act.

It appears that cleaning of Municipal open drains carrying human excreta with other waste will also attract this Provision as insanitary latrine and manual cleaning of such drains should be stopped from the date of commencement of this act. After enactment of this Act all such drains should be cleaned mechanically by using technique like high pressure waterjet and suction machine. It is very difficult to demolish or convert all the insanitary latrines in this state (particularly 60,072 insanitary latrines in urban area) within only a few months: some more time is required.
