Minutes of the meeting with various Departments of the State Government to review the status of Prevention and Control of Vector Borne Diseases

Date- 26.10.2016
Venue- Chief Secretary's Conference Hall at Nabanna

Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal takes chair and welcomes all

The list of participants is enclosed at Annexure - 1.

Additional Chief Secretary. Health and Family Welfare Department started by briefing on the present status of Dengue. Acute Encephalitis Syndrome & Japanese Encephalitis (AES/JE) and Malaria in the State. In the current year (upto 14.9.18), there are 11,069 cases and twenty eight (28) deaths in the State due to Dengue which are higher than the cases (8516 number) and deaths (14 number) in the previous year. He states that Dengue is a notifiable disease and protocols are to be maintained for identification of cases & recording of deaths due to Dengue Therefore, records of each death are properly examined before confirmation, intermitient rainfall and high humidity even upto the end of October in this year are the catalyzing factors for breeding of mosquitoes. He also appraises the present situation of AES/JE and Malaria in the State, Till 19.10.2016, there are 124 cases of JE and twenty six (26) deaths due to JE, which are substantially less than the previous years. This is attributed to more coverage of JE vaccination of both children and adult. This year there are fifty four (54) deaths so far in the State due to Maiaria.

Director of Health Services informs that in this year, Dengue case fatality is higher because of infection by serotype DEN II (30%) and DEN IV (17%) which were much less in previous years. Out of the twenty eight (28) deaths in this year, twenty (20) are in the North 24 Parganes district.

Secretary (PHP) informs that as in previous years, in the current year also House-to-House surveillance including surveillance in office premises, construction sites, market places etc for detection of mosquito tarva & source reduction has been continuing in forty one (41) Urban Local Bodies since the month of April, 2016. For that purpose, around Rs. 6.50 crore has been sanctioned to SUDA from the Health and FW Department. This activity has been extended for the month of October too. Advertisements in print and electronic media are being published for awareness generation.

Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department asks to increase the number of H-to-H visits from the present once in a month to twice in a month in the next year. In case of outbreaks, the visit should be once in a week. He also says that proper training of the volunteers who undertake visits and the quality of this activity are to be ensured and he suggests marking of dates on the outside walls after house visits.

Secretary, Municipal Affairs Department says that in this year, Dengue cases are mostly concentrated in North 24 District (4484 fever cases out of 11069 in the State). Bidhannagar, North Dum Dum, South Dum Dum, Baranagar, Kamarhati, Panihati, Barasat municipalities are worst affected. He says municipalities have taken cleanliness measures and disposal of solid wastes on regular basis so that mesquitoes cannot breed Aiso, Fever Clinics have been set up at affected areas for

collection of blood sample and testing. SUDA has tagged doctors to each of the above mentioned affected municipalities.

Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation says that in the current year, cases of Dengue are less in KMC area in comparison to the previous year. H-to-H surveillance throughout the year, emphasis on source reduction, maintenance of database of probable breeding grounds have yielded result. He informs that KMC has appointed three (3) Emomologists.

Director of Medical Education requests to ensure quality of larvicides/insecticides used by the ULBs & proper mixing & effective spaying.

Chief Secretary emphasises on long and medium term measures to reduce menace of Dengue from next year. He requests all to improve quality of H-to-H visits and make it more intensive with strengthened monitoring & supervision. If required, new ULBs are to be brought under the H-to-H surveillance. Surveillance over construction sites, unfrequented areas, spray of larvicide over dumping grounds are to be ensured. Steps should be taken to tackle negative publicity. He asks Health and FW Department and Municipal Affairs Department to initiate proposal to strengthen manpower to combat Vector Borne Diseases.

The following decisions are taken-

- Meeting with the Chairpersons of forty one (41) ULBs would be held in the month of November, 2016 for prevention of Dengue and other Vector Borne Diseases
- Health and FW Department would submit proposal to create posts of Entomologists in each district and headquarter.
- Higher Education and School Education Departments would re-circulate advisory on prevention of Dengue to all educational institutions & ensure school/college premises are thoroughly checked and cleaned immediately before schools resume after the holidays are over.
- Alertness for prevention of Dengue and other Vector Borne Diseases would continue even in the month of November, 2016. Surveillance over markets, schools, unfrequented places to be intensified.
- From next year H-to-H surveillance on Dengue would be extended to more number of ULBs and number of visits to each house would be increased.
 Marking of dates of visits on the outside wall would be made mandatory.
- In the wake of death of some birds in Dethi, all concerned departments are requested to maintain alertness and immediately inform if any such incident occurs in the State.

Meeting concludes with the Chief Secretary reiterating that there must be no let up in the surveillance and cleanliness drives till the season is over.

The Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal took the chair & initiated discussion. He emphasized on integrated approach of both the State & Govt. of India officials for Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases with respect to various Central Government & other offices and residential premises situated within the municipal areas.

The Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal stressed that vectors of Malaria, Dengue, Chikunguniya breed in domestic & peri-domestic areas, and source reduction is necessary to prevent transmission of diseases. Role of various Govt. of India organization to prevent Vector Borne Diseases is to maintain clean enfronment, personal protection, notification of diseases, case management as per NVBDCP guideline, awareness generation, spray of larvicides etc. He requested all the GOI Officers to cooperate with the local municipal authority for inspection and implementing control measures during vector survey.

Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation requested Port Trust to do insecticide activities in their own areas. KMC would provide technical & training support, wherever needed.

Commissioner, Howrah Municipal Corporation stated that during vector survey larvae have been identified in Ramrajatala Station in South Eastern Railways and in Foreshore Road areas under Port Trust, and requested to take corrective measures.

Commissioner, Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation expressed need for vector survey in Income Tax Quarter & CGO complex.

Thereafter, following actions were suggested after detailed discussion:

Discussion:

Army & BSF have their own arrangement of cleaning of premises, identification of mosquito breeding places, fogging, educating the personnel and diagnosis & treatment of cases regarding Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases i.e. Dengue / Malaria following the NVBDCP guideline.

Both the organizations stated that peripheral areas (e.g. Mominpur and others), construction sites, vast land in Panagarh etc. need attention by the respective Urban Local Body for cleaning of drains, larvicidal spraying

Income Tax Department stated that the personnel who are engaged in cleaning of premises need training so that breeding places could be identified and destructed.

Actions :

Army & BSF will send the list of civilian territory to the Municipal Commissioner, KMC; Commissioner, Howrah & Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation and Chief Medical Officer of Health of the respective Districts. The contact details of these officers are at Annexure II.

Accordingly, the ULBs and the concerned CMOHs will prepare plan & undertake actions.

Other GOI organizations i.e. Port Trust, Eastern & South Eastern Railways, Income Tax, Post & Telegraph, State Level Bankers Committee, Food Corporation of India (Eastern India) will also take action. It cleaning of drains, Waste Management, identification & destruction of mosquito breeding sites. In case training is required for the personnel, the organization shall identify the trainees and contact the concerned Municipal Corporations and / or District CMOHs for facilitating the training.

Discussion:

- Notification of Vector Borne Diseases regular notifications are being received by Health Department from Army & BSF.
- Notification need to be forwarded by other GOI Departments like Railways, Port Trust & others.

Actions :

Notification / reporting format to be circulated by Health & Family Welfare Department with a guideline regarding flow of information.

The Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal took the chair & initiated discussion. He emphasized on integrated approach of both the State & Govt. of India officials for Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases with respect to various Central Government & other offices and residential premises situated within the municipal areas.

Contd. to P-2.

The Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal stressed that vectors of Malaria, Dengue, Chikunguniya breed in domestic & peri-domestic areas, and source reduction is necessary to prevent transmission of diseases. Role of various Govt. of India organization to prevent Vector Borne Diseases is to maintain chain environment, personal protection, notification diseases, case management as per NVBDCP guideline, awareness generation, spray of larvicides etc. He requested all the GOI Officers to cooperate with the local municipal authority for inspection and implementing control measures during vector survey.

Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation requested Port Trust to do insecticide activities in their own areas. KMC would provide technical & training support, wherever needed.

Commissioner, Howrah Municipal Corporation stated that during vector survey larvae have been identified in Ramrajatala Station in South Eastern Railways and in Foreshore Road areas under Port Trust, and requested to take corrective measures.

Commissioner, Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation expressed need for vector survey in Income Tax Quarter & CGO complex.

Thereafter, following actions were suggested after detailed discussion:

Discussion:

Army & BSF have their own arrangement of cleaning of premises, identification of mosquito breeding places, fogging, educating the personnel and diagnosis & treatment of cases regarding Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases i.e. Dengue / Malaria following the NVBDCP guideline.

Both the organizations stated that peripheral areas (e.g. Mominpur and others), construction sites, vast land in Panagarh etc. need attention by the respective Urban Local Body for cleaning of drains, larvicidal spraying

etc.

Income Tax Department stated that the personnel who are engaged in cleaning of premises need training so that breeding places could be identified and destructed.

Actions :

Army & BSF will send the list of civilian territory to the Municipal Commissioner, KMC; Commissioner, Howrah & Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation and Chief Medical Officer of Health of the respective Districts. The contact details of these officers are at Annexure II.

Accordingly, the ULBs and the concerned CMOHs will prepare plan &

undertake actions.

Other GOI organizations i.e. Port Trust, Eastern & South Eastern Railways, Income Tax, Post & Telegraph, State Level Bankers Committee, Food Corporation of India (Eastern India) will also take actions wir.t. cleaning of drains, Waste Management identification & destruction of mosquito breeding sites. In case training is required for the personnel, the organization shall identify the trainees and contact the concerned Municipal Corporations and / or District CMOHs for facilitating the training.

Discussion:

Notification of Vector Borne Diseases – regular notifications are being received by Health Department from Army & BSF.

Notification need to be forwarded by other GOI Departments like Railways, Port Trust & others.

Actions :

Notification / reporting format to be circulated by Health & Family Welfare Department with a guideline regarding flow of information.





The Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal took the chair & initiated discussion. He emphasized on integrated approach of both the State & Govt. of India officials for Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases with respect to various Central Government & other offices and residential premises situated within the municipal areas.

The Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal stressed that vectors of Malaria, Dengue, Chikunguniya breed in domestic & peri-domestic areas, and source reduction is necessary to prevent transmission of diseases. Role of various Govt. of India organization to prevent Vector Borne Diseases is to maintain clean environment, personal protection, notification of diseases, case management as per NVBDCP guideline, awareness generation, spray of larvicides etc. He requested all the GOI Officers to cooperate with the local municipal authority for inspection and implementing control measures during vector survey.

Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation requested Port Trust to do insecticide activities in their own areas. KMC would provide technical & training support, wherever needed.

Commissioner, Howrah Municipal Corporation stated that during vector survey larvae have been identified in Ramrajatala Station in South Eastern Railways and in Foreshore Road areas under Port Trust, and requested to take corrective measures.

Commissioner, Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation expressed need for vector survey in Income Tax Quarter & CGO complex.

Thereafter, following actions were suggested after detailed discussion:

Discussion:

- Army & BSF have their own arrangement of cleaning of premises, identification of mosquito breeding places, fogging, educating the personnel and diagnosis & treatment of cases regarding Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases i.e. Dengue / Malaria following the NVBDCP guideline.
- Both the organizations stated that peripheral areas (e.g. Mominpur and others), construction sites, vast land in Panagarh etc. need attention by the respective Urban Local Body for cleaning of drains, larvicidal spraying etc.
- Income Tax Department stated that the personnel who are engaged in cleaning of premises need training so that breeding places could be identified and destructed.

Actions :

- Army & BSF will send the list of civilian territory to the Municipal Commissioner, KMC; Commissioner, Howrah & Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation and Chief Medical Officer of Health of the respective Districts. The contact details of these officers are at Annexure II.
- Accordingly, the ULBs and the concerned CMOHs will prepare plan & undertake actions.

Other GOI organizations i.e. Port Trust, Eastern & South Eastern Railways, Income Tax, Post & Telegraph, State Level Bankers Committee, Food Corporation of India (Eastern India) will also take actions w.r.t. cleaning of drains, Waste Management, identification & destruction of mosquito breeding sites. In case training is required for the personnel, the organization shall identify the trainees and contact the concerned Municipal Corporations and / or District CMOHs for facilitating the training.

Discussion:

Notification of Vector Borne Diseases – regular notifications are being received by Health Department from Army & BSF.

Notification need to be forwarded by other GOI Departments like Railways, Port Trust & others.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting chaired by Chief Secretary on 8.3.2016 at the Chief Secretary Conference Hall at Nabanna in connection with the prevention and control of Vector Borne Diseases in ensuing season.

Dengue

Action points

- a) Health and FW Department will release fund to SUDA for House-to-House surveillance activity for Dengue from April 2016 to September 2016 (six rounds) in 45 ULBs. Preparatory meeting with these ULBs has already been held on 16-02-16.
- b) Municipal Affairs (MA) Department will arrange printing of IEC materials shared by H and FW Department and will also arrange display/distribution of leaflets, posters etc.
- c) Quality of Dengue House-to-House surveillance to be ensured. MA Department would consider changing those volunteers whose quality of work is poor.
- d) All ULBs will arrange pasting of stickers on the outside walls of buildings where volunteers have visited. This will ensure quality of surveillance and monitoring.
- e) CEO, West Bengal will be duly intimated about the Dengue House-to-House Surveillance to be taken up from April, 2016.
- f) MA Department will instruct all 45 ULBs to share the reports generated following completion of mothly rounds of Dengue Surveillance with the CMOH for analysis and targeted interventions.
- g) KMC, HMC and BMC will arrange display of big size flex at prominent places for awareness generation on Vector Borne Diseases.
- h) MA Department will organize meetings with GOI offices especially Railways, Defense, Port Authorities etc. in the Municipal Corporation areas for effective vector control in their premises.
- Both KMC and BMC will arrange for churning of water of different canals flowing through its areas to kill mosquito larva.
- j) HMC will take special care to prevent Dengue incidences in Liluah, Pilkhana areas.
- k) KMC, HMC and BMC will take special care for surveillance of under-construction buildings and also the old abandoned premises.
- ARD and MA Departments will jointly chalk out plan to remove all pigs from Kolkata. Till finalization of this plan, ARD will arrange netting of pigs.
- m) MA Department is also requested to arrange meeting with KMC and other adjoining ULBs to ensure coordinated efforts for Dengue control.
- n) MA Department will instruct all ULBs in the State to ensure availability of insecticide.

AES/JE

Vaccination of JE in the age group of 1-15 yr. has been completed in all districts and Kolkata. It is observed that during 2015 deaths due to JE were more in the age group of 50 yr. and

above. Adult vaccination (15-65 yr.) has been completed in Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri and Dakshin Dinajpur. It is continuing in Malda, Uttar Dinajpur, Burdwan, Bankura and Hooghly districts. Occurrences of non JE AES cases are more in the State. So ensuring safe drinking water supply is most essential.

Action points

- a) PHE and MA Departments are requested to ensure safe drinking water supply, construction of platforms and raising the platforms of tubewells. H and FW Department shares line list of AES/JE affected areas with PHE.
- b) CD & WD and SW Department has at present no system of Take Home Ration. They are requested to consider this for AES/JE affected persons.

Malaria

Plasmodium falciparum (PF) cases are rising but deaths are decreasing. Annual Parasite Index in overall is decreasing in the State but rising in Purulia district.

Action points

- a) H and HW will distribute 75,000 LLINs in Purulia, Bankura and Paschim Medinipur districts in the most affected Blocks.
- b) Panchayet & RD and MA Departments to cooperate with the H and FW Department for effective Indoor residual Spray activities and for holding 1000 IEC cum Service camps in high case load villages on monthly basis for 6 months starting in April 2016.

Kala-azar

At present Kala azar problem is limited to 23 Blocks in Darjeeling, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur, Malda, Murshidabad and Birbhum districts.

Action points

- a) Panchayet & RD Department is requested to cooperate with the H and FW Department for effective Indoor Residual Spray activity.
- b) Panchayet & RD and CD & WD and SW Departments are requested to take steps for community awareness for early referral of cases.

Zika

An emerging viral disease has been declared by WHO as Public Health Emergency of International Concern on 1st February, 2016. The vector mosquito is same as that of Dengue and Chikungunya. Necessary surveillance for persons coming from affected countries has been put in place by GOI. Reports are being collected from the delivery points and community health centres to detect incidences of micro cephaly, if any. Activities for control of vector mosquito along with personal protection and community awareness generation are to be taken up by concerned Departments.

The next meeting will be held on 04.4.2016 at 10.30 AM under chairmanship of Chief Secretary.
