Placed below is the copy of communication of DHFW bearing no. HFW/HSDI/13/07 dt. 18th January, 2007 in connection with release of fund towards implementation of Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs upto 31.03.2007.

It may be seen in para 2 that the though the procurement of medicine is recurring in nature, the item has been kept in the Non-recurring part of the budget.

In this connection it is to mention that it was decided by the Dept. of Municipal Affairs that the procurement of medicine would be decentralized and the responsibility would be vested upon the ULBs concerned. Accordingly, the ULBs had already procured medicine as per the list approved by DHFW through the respective procurement committee set up for the purpose at ULB level comprising of Project Director (ADM or SDO), Chairman of the ULB, ACMOH, Executive Officer or in his absence an officer authorized on his behalf.

As the procurement of medicine is recurring in nature, the budget for this item has been kept under the recurring head for an amount of Rs. 75.55 lakhs (Rupees 48.05 lakhs for Sub-Health Post and Rs. 27.50 lakhs for OPD), forwarded by the Dept. of Municipal Affairs under memo no. 259-S/06 dt. 20.04.2006. Since no approval has been received under the A/C head of "Procurement of Medicine", the ULBs would not be able to procure the required medicines. This will cause interruption of service implementation and will badly hamper the continuity of clinical services including distribution of medicine to the Urban Poor at household and SHP level under the scheme, resulting likely this interest of the people to avail services of project infrastructure.

As the clearance of the budget and fund for Rs. 256.90 lakhs has only been received recently, Out Patient Department (OPD) could not be established in this FY. Hence, budget provision kept for procurement of medicine for an amount of Rs. 27.50 lakhs would not be required.

This was discussed in the meeting of Project Director (HSDI) and Special Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal and Director, SUDA held at Swasthya Bhawan on 15.02.2007. Pursuant to the above discussion, the notes have been prepared for submission to the Project Director (HSDI) for – (a) keeping the procurement of medicine under the recurring head of the budget, (b) approval for procurement of medicine for SHP only as per the approved list of DHFW by the ULBs, (c) release of fund for Rs. 48.05 lakhs for procurement of medicine for SHPs only to CCC, SUDA for onward release to the ULBs concerned.

It is not clear why the civilians residing in the said Cantonment area are not receiving any such health services from the different health facilities of Defence Authority located in that area.

To sort out this issue it is suggested that a joint meeting may be convened with the Chairman of both the Barrackpore & North Barrackpore Municipality, Chief Executive Officer of the Cantonment Board, CEO or Secretary of KMDA, Director, SUDA, Dr. K.D. Ghosh, MLA and the Jt. Secretary, Dept. of Municipal Affairs.

With due honour the undersigned would like to place before your goodself the following facts for your perusal:-

1. That within the geographical domain of the Noapara Assembly Constituency, from which the undersigned was elected, a vast area is under the Barrackpur Cantonment Board, which is the oldest cantonment in our country, excluding the areas under (i) Barrackpur Municipality (ii) North Barrackpore Municipality and (iii) a small number of Defence Estates.

. That the total population (as per 2001 Census) in the Barrackpur Cantonment Board Area is 22014 (out of which male 12215 and female 9799) the lion's share of population is poverty-stricken.

3. That unlike the two adjacent municipalities where there is elected Board of Councillors as peoples representatives to run the municipal affairs there is no elected board of peoples' representatives except only one nominated member & the cantonment Board is practically run by the C.E.O. i.e., Chief Executive Officer of the Cantonment Board.

That launching of various Govt. programme (Central as well as State) like Health, Education, Poverty Alleviation e.g. UHIP (Urban Health Improvement Project) KUSP (Kolkata Urban Services for the poor) ICDS Janani Surakha Yoyana Scheme, Urban Health Mission, Rogi Kalyan Samity SJSRY, PMRY, formation of Self-Help Groups, Self-Employment Schemes, Sarbasikha Abhijan etc. are yet to be initiated in this particular area.

That moreover different social assistance schemes/ projects of Central & State Govt. e.g., Granting of (i) G.R. (ii) Old age Pension (iii) Widow Pension have not yet been done to a single resident of this area.

That the only reason of such non-implementation of the Govt. Schemes/ Projects may be due to the fact this cantonment Board Area has not yet been categorised as an area eligible to enjoy status at per with municipalities though the residents in this area are mostly civilians carrying on their civilian lifestyle just like the residents of adjacent two municipalities.

The other reason of course, may be that with a view to implementing all the above stated Govt. Programmes/ Schemes such representation demanding at per municipal status was never raised earlier before.





Water Quality Monitoring is an important component in surveillance related activities. This year we have supported conducting a training program on Water Quality Monitoring at Durgapur following a large out break of water borne viral hepatitis. Around 60 professional staff participated.

Keeping in view the high incidence of water related diseases in the city of Kolkata and adjoining areas, we are now organizing at NICED a one-day workshop on 16th December, 2005 to provide hands-on training to professional staffs involved in drinking water quality monitoring. The curriculum will cover building up appropriate skills for professional staff directly linked to supply and monitoring the quality of drinking water.
