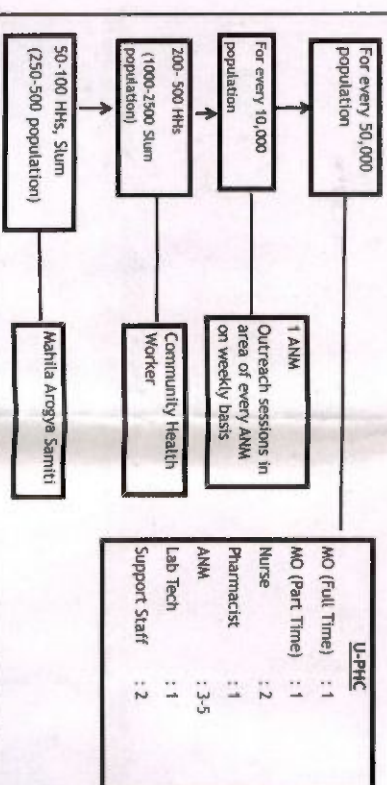
Public Health Manager (PHM) & Urban Health Planning & Monitoring Manager (UHPMM)

- Public Health Managers (PHMs) & Urban Health Planning & Monitoring Managers (UHPMMs) are the pivot for implementation of NUHM in different ULBs
- One Public Health Manager (PHM) is sanctioned for each & every Municipality. He/she will supervise the activities under NUHM and assist the Nodal Officer -NUHM / Health Officer of the Municipality for Implementation of NUHM
- Urban Health Planning & Monitoring Managers are posted at Municipal Corporations. One Urban Health Planning & Monitoring Manager is responsible to look after few Boroughs/MC and will be stationed at Borough Executive office /Municipal Corporation depending up on the administrative structure of the particular Municipal Corporation

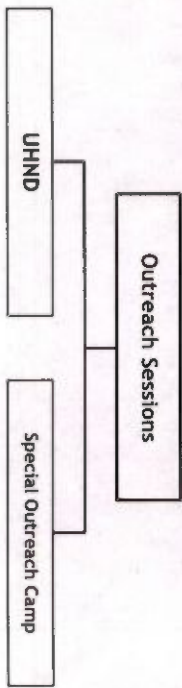

Services under UHND (1)

- Health related services
 - ✓ Registration of all pregnant women

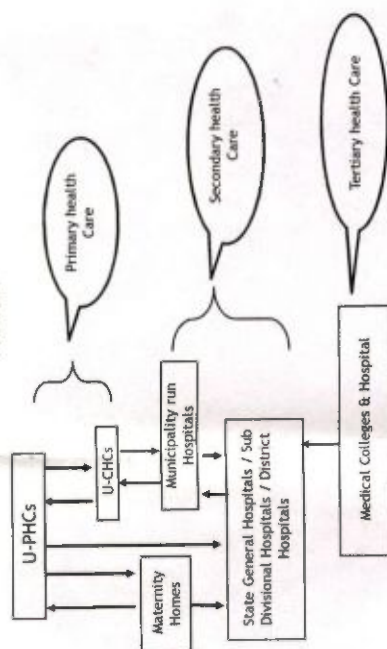

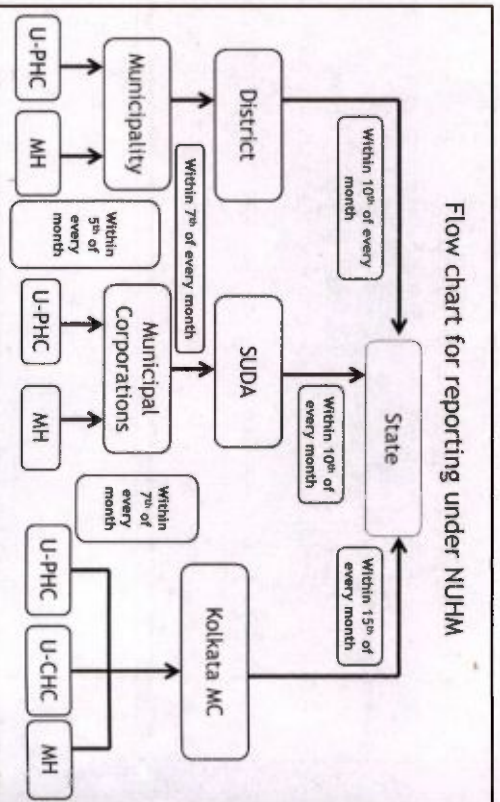

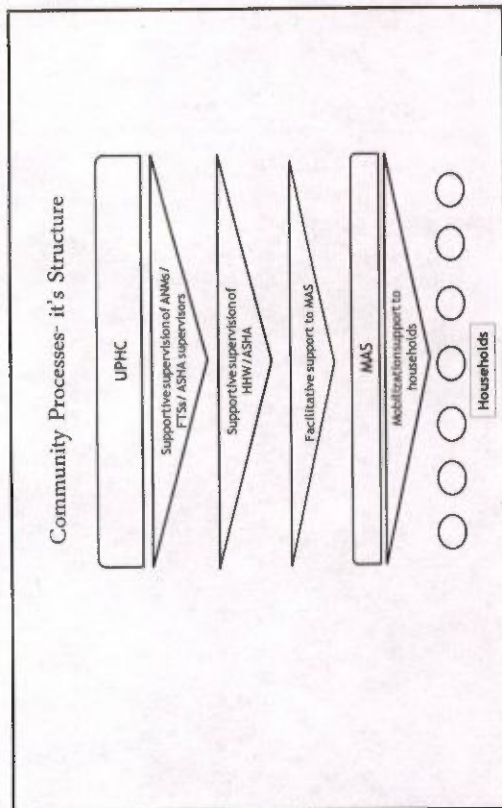
Flow chart for reporting under NUHM

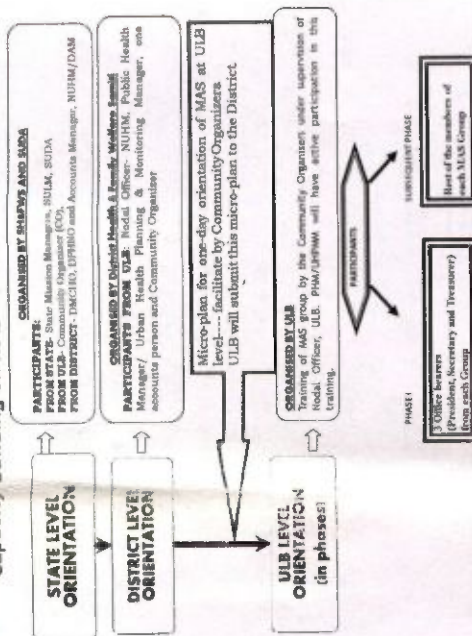

1. Absorption of HR from URCH to NUHM

Under urban RCH 99 MOs were sanctioned for all 99 ULBs selected to implement Urban RCH. One Mo was sanctioned for each and every ULB irrespective of its population. Some 58 MOs were recruited under Urban RCH. The remuneration of these MOs was Rs. 20000.00/month.

It is to be noted that MOs under NUHM will be recruited for U-PHC. Remuneration of these MO will be Rs. 40000.00/month for full time and 24000/month for part time MOs.

ANM under Urban RCH were recruited for 30000 population. Urban Health Centre (UHC) was created and the ANM were supposed to function from these UHC. Under Urban RCH both ANM and GNM were recruited for the post of ANM. Majority of these ANM were GNM by qualification. Among these GNM a good number were retired government employee.

1(a) MO will be absorbed as PTMO of NUHM

1(b) ANM / GNM will be absorbed to the post of ANM under NUHM

2. Utilisation of approved salary for PTMO under NUHM

Till engagement of PTMO under NUHM, the ULB may deploy MO having minimum qualification MBBS @ not exceeding Rs. 900/- per day for at least 06 hours duties at UPHC.

3. Duty hours of full time and part time MO is to be specified and responsibility of both the MOs to be clearly defined.

4. Existing Health Scheme are as under :

- (a) UPHCS in 52 ULBs funded by MA Department
- (b) HHW Scheme in 11 ULBs funded by DHFW
- (c) CBPHCS in 63 ULBs funded by DHFW

5. Utilisation of existing HHW and FTS under NUHM

It is also envisaged that dedicated drug distribution centres be opened for the identified concentration of vulnerable groups, through NGO/CSOs, which will have provisions for emergency OTC drugs and contraceptives. Special attention would be paid to organizing outreach sessions for these vulnerable communities. For targeted IEC/BCC interventions, the details of which will be as per the city PIP, the provision is Rs.5 per capita for the target urban vulnerable population (in line with the provision for IEC/BCC under NRHM). This will also include community mobilization, identification of recently settled urban poor families and support through NGO/CSO. The details of this mobilization strategy will be as per the city PIP.

Points to be discussed in the meeting with the MA Department

1. **Fund flow to the ULBS under NUHM and opening of bank account:** Fund for Municipal Corporations (MC) other than Kolkata (Siliguri, Asansol, Durgapur, Chandannagar and Howrah) will be released to SUDA by the State Health Samity (SHS). SUDA will release fund to these MCs as per requirement. The Corporations will submit monthly Statement of Expenditure (SOE) and quarterly Utilisation Certificate (UC) to SUDA. SUDA will submit quarterly UC to SHS. Separate Bank Account will be maintained by the City Urban Health Society for fund under NUHM.

Fund for the other Municipalities (26 approved for NUHM under State ROP_2013-14) will be released to CMOHs (District Health Samity). CMOHs will release fund to respective Municipalities as per requirement. These Municipalities will submit monthly Statement of Expenditure (SOE) and quarterly Utilisation Certificate (UC) to the respective CMOHs. CMOHs will submit quarterly UC to State Health Samity. Separate Bank Account will be maintained by the Municipalities for the fund under NUHM.

Fund for Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) will be sent directly to KMC.

2. **Formation of City Urban Health Society:** As per NUHM Implementation Framework (no. L. 19017/1/2008-UH), the Municipal Corporations will form a City NUHM Society and registered under Society Registration Act. At the city level, the management of NUHM activities will be coordinated by a City level Urban Health Society headed by the Mayor of respective MC. Representative of DM/SDO may be the member of the society depending up on the nature of city, whether it is a District or Sub divisional Headquarters.

A framework for City NUHM Society is proposed as follows. This is applicable for the Municipal Corporations (Siliguri, Asansol, Durgapur, Chandannagar and Howrah). Proposed composition of City Urban Health Society

SUDA may send necessary directives to the MCs for formation of society.

3. **Procurement of Drugs and equipments:** The CMOH of the district will procure drugs and equipments for the U-PHC and CHC run under NUHM. The MO in-charge of the U-PHC and CHC will place quarterly indent to respective CMOH through their ULBS and CMOH will supply the stock accordingly. As the procurement of the smaller ULBs may not be bulk enegh to get their supply from the CMS approved firm. Therefore this procedure will help ULBS to get quality medicine from CMS approved firm.

Otherwise the ULBS may purchase medicine and equipments as before following the procurement norms.

4. **New construction, repair and renovation:** A model plan of for U-PHC will be given to all ULBS for construction of new U-PHC. At least 3000² ft space is required for construction of new U-PHC. Execution of construction work may be done in the following ways:
 - a. MED (Municipal Engineering Division) may prepare the plan estimate for new construction as well as repair renovation. MED may also be entrusted with execution of construction work. There are five Circle office of MED in the state. Fund for execution of work may be placed to the Circle office by the CMOH or fund may directly be placed to MED head office by the State Health Samity.
 - b. The plan estimate of the construction work may be done by the respective ULB. After getting approval from the MED the ULB may execute the work. Municipal Affairs Department may be requested to explore the possibilities for execution of construction work.
5. **Signing of MOU:** An MOU will be executed between State Health Department and SUDA to implement NUHM in the 5 Municipal Corporations (Siliguri, Asansol, Durgapur, Chandannagar and Howrah) and SUDA in turn will Sign an MOU with these 5 MCs.
6. **Utilization of HHW (Honorary Health Worker) or recruitment of new ASHA:** Involvement of the existing HHW in NUHM might be a crucial issue in implementing NUHM in the State. In the context of recruitment of ASHA the involvement of HHW in NUHM may be considered in the following ways.
 - a. ASHA will be recruited for the vulnerable population only. Therefore we can recruit ASHA for the vulnerable population and HHW may be shifted to an area other than the vulnerable population.
 - b. The HHWs may be re-designated as ASHA or they may be allowed to work as HHW in place of ASHA. In this situation these HHW will get fixed remuneration from the ULB as before and above that they might be given performance base incentives from NUHM.

A Status Report

Health Component of KUSP

With the objectives of strengthening the existing community based primary health care services in the ULBs, DFID has extended support under KUSP not only to 40 KMA ULBs but also to Non-KMA ULBs. One of the major components of urban health care approach has been the community based honorary health worker scheme which has been operationalised in West Bengal since 1986 through different health programmes like CUPD III, CSIP, IPP-VIII, UHIP in KMA ULBs and IPP-VIII (Extn.), RCH Sub-Project, Asansol and HHW Scheme in Non-KMA ULBs.

To get an overview of the existing health care delivery system a study had been conducted by CMU through Interim Support Consultants (ISC). The intended outcomes of the study were to strengthen the community based HHW programme to improve access to and the quality of health services for the urban poor; and to develop a frame work for mainstreaming HIV/AIDS as part of the larger health care system in the ULBs.

A Health Steering Committee was constituted during November, 2004 by CMU to finalize the design of the health component of KUSP Programme. The Study Report of ISC including key findings and recommendations was shared with Health Steering Committee and subsequently with Health Officer & Asstt. Health Officer of the ULBs.

A number of activities have been undertaken under Health Component of KUSP since FY 2004-05. The salient activities are as under :

A) Capacity Building of different categories of Health Man Power of the ULBs

- ✓ Organised 5 days residential training course for 64 nos. of Health Officers (HO) & Asstt. Health Officers (AHO) of 46 ULBs on **updating technical knowledge** and **strengthening managerial skill on Public Health** by All India Institute of Hygiene & Public Health (AIHH & PH).
- ✓ Conducted training of 64 nos. of trainers (HO & AHO) on **Food & Nutrition** and **Growth Monitoring** by CMU.
- ✓ Trainers training imparted by CMU to 64 nos. of HO & AHO on **RCH & Family Planning**.
- ✓ Co-ordinated and organized training to 153 nos. of Health Officer, Asstt. Health Officer and Medical Officer by State AIDS Cell in 5 batches to strengthen facilitators' capacity on **STD / HIV / AIDS**.

- Trainers training were imparted to 76 nos. of HO & AHO including Kolkata Municipal Corporation by CMU on **Health Management Information System (HMIS) & Family Schedule.**
- 2 days training sessions conducted at ULB level by the HO & AHO to 8643 nos. of Honorary Health Workers (HHWs), First Tier Supervisors (FTSs) and Second Tier Supervisors (STSs) on **National Health Programmes.**
- HO & AHO imparted 3 days training to 8640 nos. of HHWs, FTSs & STSs on Re-designed Family Scheduled and HMIS at ULB level in FY 2006-07 and 11385 nos. in FY 2007-08.
- HO & AHO imparted training to 9785 nos. of HHWs, FTSs & STSs on STD / HIV / AIDS at ULB level.
- 2 days training course on RCH & Family Planning conducted by HO & AHO at ULB level to 9643 nos. of HHWs, FTSs & STSs.
- ✓ Organised **capacity building session** ^{on 23} (2 days) for the 88 nos. Medical Professionals and Paramedics by West Bengal State Immunisation Support Cell (WBSISC) in three batches.
- Coordinated in organizing hands on training of **25 days on Routine Immunization (RI)** for FTS at District Nursing Training School in collaboration with Dept. of Health & Family Welfare and WBSISC. The objective of this training is to develop vaccinators to strengthen Routine Immunization at ULB level. Out of 18 districts, ULBs of 7 districts have already been completed this training. So far, out of 1743 FTSs, 704 have been trained.
- HO & AHO imparted 2 days training to HHWs, FTSs & STSs on Routine Immunisation at ULB level wherein 9743 nos. have been trained.
- ✓ Organized sensitisation training on **Vector Borne Disease Control** by NGO in batches wherein Councillors-in-Charge (Health), Health Officer, Asstt. Health Officer and Sanitary Inspector participated. Total no. of participants was 145.
- Grass root level Health functionaries were trained on Vector Borne Diseases by Health Officer & Asstt. Health Officer at ULB level in batches. The training was of 2 days duration for each batch and 2671 nos. were trained.
- ✓ Organised capacity building training of 45 nos. of Health Officer & Asstt. Health Officer by VMMC and Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi on Public Health Management.

- Organized sensitization training on "Swine Flu" by Public Health Wing of Dept. of Health & Family Welfare to the 110 nos. of Health Officer, Asstt. Health Officer and Medical Officer of 65 ULBs.

B) Strengthening Health care service delivery

- Strengthened Health care services through Sub-Centres (SCs) by providing support for refurbishment i.e. repair & renovation including provision of basic facilities like toilet & drinking water, replacement of necessary furniture & equipment to 38 KMA & 7 Non-KMA ULBs.
- Each HHW carry Kit Bag along with contents like medicine for common ailments, dressing materials, ORS, Oral Pill and Condom etc. to provide health care services at the door-step of the community during their fortnightly home visit. All the HHWs of 40 KMA & 11 Non-KMA ULBs were provided with Kit bag along with contents to strengthen door-step health care services.
- Family Schedule is used by the HHW for each of the household to keep record on Health data and to monitor the progress. Reporting of Health services provided by the HHWs done by using reporting format designed for the purpose of Health Management Information System (HMIS). Initially, there were variegated types of Family Schedule and HMIS format for the different Urban Health Programmes. To simplify and to maintain uniformity in the ULBs irrespective of the Urban Health Programmes, Family Schedule and reporting format was re-designed by CMU jointly with Dept. of Health & Family Welfare and Urban Local Bodies (ULBs).
- Printing of re-designed Family Schedule & reporting format were undertaken by CMU centrally and provided to the ULBs.
- Supported group discussion, by HHWs & FTSs with community on specific Health issues, deployment of folk media by the ULBs to generate Health awareness amongst the community, organization of baby show by the ULBs and display of hoardings on Health messages.
- Strengthened weighing of under five years children at sub-centres to detect early malnutrition and corrective measures thereof. The children falling under grade-1 & 2 are counseled by HHWs and Grade 3 & 4 are referred to the nearest hospitals.
- To create awareness in community, conducted IEC programme through cooking demonstration by using locally available raw materials of food items. Community mother were involved in cooking demonstration process. The primary aim was to sensitise community mothers to make the best use of available resources to prevent mal nutrition.

C) Providing logistic support to grass root level Health functionaries & ULBs

- Uniform & Umbrella were provided to HHWs, FTSs & STSs of 40 KMA & 74 Non-KMA ULBs.
- 32 KMA ULBs were provided with Computer solely for Health Cell.

D) Innovative Programmes

- **Community Led Total Sanitation (CLTS)** was piloted in 5 slums of Kalyani Municipality in early 2006 as the ULBs decided to implement CLTS moving away from the conventional approach of toilet construction at the individual household level offered by different ongoing projects & programmes. The objectives of this programme was to trigger the community so that the community is empowered to decide their owns health & sanitation improvement through self mobilization of Urban poor. All the councilors were exposed & oriented to the CLTS approach through “Hands on Training”, meetings & workshops. A no. of training was organized at the ULB & slum level to develop facilitators’ capacity wherein HHWs, FTSs, members of NHC & CDS as well as natural leaders of the slums participated. Community decided locally and initiated collective local action towards making their environment open defecation free. Eventually, the CLTS approach spreaded to all the 52 slums of Kalyani Municipality. More than 1800 toilets were constructed by slum residents within the time span of one & half years after 1st triggering. The Kalyani Municipality was declared 1st open defecation free town and received President Award in the year 2009.

The CLTS approach acted as one of the tools for behavioural change of the community to tackle the issue of open defecation. This practice reduces incidence of gastro intestinal disorders considerably. As it was community driven approach, it did not stop with the implementation of “no subsidy” latrine construction, the community undertook other initiatives like eliminated wash waste water accumulation around hand pump, platform of hand tubewells repaired and plastered with cement, cleaned the age old clogged drains within the slums, started non-formal / adult education and stopped country liquor business in the slums.

The experience of CLTS approach at Kalyani Municipality was shared with the KMA ULBs in a workshop wherein representative of DFID, Govt. of India and Bangladesh participated.

- **Adolescent Health Care Programme**

With the objective of improving awareness of adolescents on RCH, Reproductive Hygiene and healthy behavioural practices for prevention and control of STD / HIV / AIDS, generating awareness on socio-legal aspects of women rights and providing adolescents health care support through adolescents friendly clinic, the adolescents health care programme was piloted in Budge Budge Municipality in the year 2007. CMU conducted Trainer's training session of HO / AHO & MO of the ULB. In turn the trainers conducted training of 3,000 nos. of adolescents girls so far. Knowledge Attitude Belief & Behaviour (KABB) study was conducted amongst adolescents girls who attended the adolescents friendly clinics. Some of the salient findings – 32% of adolescents girls had worm infestation and 26.5% complained of abdominal pain during menstruation, 10.6% adolescents were anaemic having haemoglobin level ~~above~~^{below} 12gm%.

With this experience of Budge Budge Municipality, the adolescent health care programme was extended to KMA ULBs. So far 16 ULBs completed training for 12730 nos. of adolescent girl and 9 ULBs have started adolescent friendly clinic.

- **School Health Programme**

Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction (AA & FS) have been accorded to 97 ULBs to implement School Health Programme. The objectives of this programme are to promote positive health of school children, early diagnosis & treatment, prevention of diseases and inculcating health consciousness amongst the children of primary, SSK & non-formal school located within the slums or in the vicinity of the slums. Development, printing & supply of training module, school health & referral card to the ULBs undertook by CMU. Trainers training of HO & AHO of the ULBs were also done by CMU. The respective ULB formed medical team, conducted training of medical team & teachers, provided First Aid Box to the schools. As on 31st December, 2009, out of 97 ULBs, 69 ULBs have started School Health Programme and completed health check up of 53832 nos. of students of 630 schools. From the records it is revealed that 54% of the school children suffer from worm infestation, 29% from anaemia, 14% vitamin deficiency, 11% Iodine deficiency. The children were treated at site and referred to the secondary facility, if needed and followed up.

E) Urban Health Strategy

- Urban Health Strategy, 2008 has been developed jointly with Dept. of Health & Family Welfare with the objectives of
 - decrease maternal, child & infant mortality by providing better & consistent quality services to families in Urban areas with special focus on Urban poor, underserved and vulnerable population through enhanced demand and universal access to quality services;
 - reduce prevalence of communicable diseases
 - improve quality of basic health services by providing supervisory, managerial, technical and interpersonal skills to all levels of health functionaries
 - generate awareness & enhance community mobilization

The key strategies are

- Universal coverage
 - Strengthening service delivery through a uniform three tier service deliver model
 - Strengthening institutional arrangement and inter departmental convergence
 - Strengthening monitoring & evaluation.
- **Detailed Project Report (DPR)**
 - ✓ 545 nos. of DPRs submitted by the ULBs have been approved by CMU during FY 2007-08 to 2009-10. The proposals are mainly towards strengthening health care service delivery through expansion of Extended Specialized Outpatient Department (ESOPD), Maternity Home (MH), Diagnostic Centre; Repair and Renovation of Sub-centres; Purchase of furniture and equipment; Procurement of new ambulance and repair of existing one; Procurement of additional medicine; Implementation of Public Health Programme; Awareness generation and health check-up camp; Training etc.

Minutes of the meeting held on 21.10.14

The meeting was held on 21.10.14 at 2nd floor NRHM Building, Swasthya Bhawan, where Mission Director, NHM, West Bengal was the Chairperson.

Director State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) and representatives of five Municipal Corporations (Siliguri, Asansol, Durgapur, Chandannagar and Howrah) were present in the meeting. Discussion was held on implementation of NUHM programme in five Municipal Corporations. The officials present in the meeting were as follows:

Meeting started at 11 am. At the outset the Mission Director, NHM, West Bengal, explained that it took some time to start the programme in the state to finalise the modalities to run the programme. She requested the nodal persons from Municipal Corporations to form the City PMU and complete the process of formation and registration of City NUHM society and inform the SUDA accordingly.

MD, NHM, explained who are the stakeholders of NUHM and importance of these stakeholders in regard to implement the programme effectively. The representatives of Municipal Corporations were requested to work out the plan to sensitize stakeholders like Health Care Providers and people's representatives. Sensitization of the community will be done later on.

MD, NHM requested the house to complete the following activities and send the feed back to SUDA and state. These activities are 1) Line listing of the sites for UHND. 2) Preparation of the calendar of UHND as approved by NUHM ROP. 3) Line listing of the approved U-PHC, U-CHC. 4) A plan for outreach activity both routine and special.

The Project Officer (Health), SUDA, Dr. Shibani Goswami requested the representatives of the municipal corporations to work out the road map for efficient and effective implementation of NUHM.

The NUHM Nodal Officers of the Municipal Corporations requested to provide a guideline of UHND. In this regard State nodal officer NUHM explained that the guideline of Government of India for UHND is yet to be received. But he also informed the house that a working guideline will be prepared soon and it will be sent to the SUDA and the concerned ULBs.

Director, SUDA, has informed the house that for financial activity under NUHM a separate bank account will have to be opened by SUDA itself and by the municipal Corporations. In this regard he also stated that for opening new account by SUDA and the five other Municipal Corporations, approval is to be taken from the Finance Department. But for the convenience of the activity under NUHM he suggested that we can operate the financial activity under NUHM using the existing account of SUDA and other municipal Corporations. But separate accounts will have to be maintained.

The Director, SUDA also advised the representatives of Municipal Corporations to take necessary initiatives to build up a proper convergence among the different wings of the same corporations and with other departments.

The GIS expert Arpita Mukherjee from SUDA shared a power point presentation with the house. She presented a brief out line on mapping. Regarding selection of agencies for mapping it was decided that the Terms of Reference for the purpose will be prepared form SUDA and it will be shared with all concerned ULBs for their guidance in preparing the GIS map for Urban Local Bodies.

MD, NHM, reviewed the status of implementation of NUHM in individual municipal Corporations and these are as follows:

Chandannagar: a) Initial meeting for implementation of NUHM has been done. b) City NUHM society has been formed. c) Registration of the society has not yet done. D) Sites for the facilities have been identified.

Howrah: a) Initial meeting done. b) City NUHM Society has not been formed. c) They may change some of the sites for U-PHC.

Durgapur: a) Meeting done. b) City NUHM society has been formed. c) Registration is pending. d) Sites for facilities have been identified.

Asansole : a) Meeting done. b) City NUHM society has been formed. c) Registration is pending. d) Sites for facilities have been identified.

Siliguri: Sites for the facilities has been identified.

However all were requested to adhere to the norms of NUHM and take steps for speedy implementation of the programme.




