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Sub: Request to expedite the progress of new construction of U-PHCs under NUHM  $\mathop{\mathrm{Sir}}\nolimits_{*}$ 

The progress of construction of new U-PHCs under NUHM is very poor in Howrah MC since a long time period. As of now, total fifteen (15) U-PHCs have been sanctioned for construction of new U-PHC building for Howrah MC. But, not a single U-PHC building has been fully completed and functional at newly constructed buildings till date. Although, several reminders have been given from this end to expedite the progress of construction of new U-PHCs.

In this context, State Urban Health Planning Manager from SPMU has visited Howrah MC to explore the hindrance of construction of new U-PHCs on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2018. He has visited all the sites selected for construction of new U-PHC building jointly with the Nodal Officer, Howrah MC and other officials of CPMU. He also met MMIC (Health) in the evening on 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 for debriefing of his observation. A copy of his filed visit report is annexed herewith.

I'd therefore request you to look into the matter personally, so that, the progress of construction of U-PHCs could be expedited and completed within this financial year, otherwise approval of new U-PHC building may have be shifted to other potential places where progress of construction is good for the interest of the overall urban population especially the urban poor and vulnerable sections.


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
