Sir,

The World Bank assisted IPP-VIII. 10 Additional Cities, West Bengal sanctioned in the month of January 2000, by Govt. of India has completed its run in the month of June, 2002. Practically the Project has enjoyed actual period of two years after completion of miscellaneous paraphernalia for start. This two year functioning of the Project has achieved significant impacts on various target set. Some of the encouraging results of Impact Assessment are as under:

It may be appreciated in this connection that a Project of this dimension should be floated for at least five years to emanate sustainable results. Nevertheless the instant Project has been able to score positive achievements within its small span of run. It may therefore be expected that further run of the Project will likely to attain universal achievement in real sense of quantity & quality; both for physical targets as also outcome indicators.

There are multifarious valid reasons for the proposed extension of the Project. The short Project period available was just adequate for completion of the extensive civil construction for 46 Health Facilities at the fag end. The delayed completion of civil works have resulted in late commissioning and operationalisation of Facilities. The scheme, Hospital Waste Management could not be implemented for paucity of time and delayed completion of O.P.D. cum MH construction. Many sophisticated Diagnostic Gadgets for the Diagnostic Centres viz. X-Ray. Ultra-Sonography, Semi Auto Analyser etc. procured recently under the Project, now require additional arrangements for installation & operationalisation. Addition and alteration of the space and suitable electricity provision for the purpose need to be provided.

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Thus in-consideration of incomplete status of the Project towards attainment of its physical and infra-structural goals, I would like to propose for extension of the Project beyond June 30, 2002 till March 31, 2003. No additional cost shall be involved for the purpose, the savings of the Project will accommodate expenditure for the extended period. I may further add that the proposed extension of the Project period will brighten and consolidate the status of the Project in addition to completion of the infra-structural works and service deliveries in holistic sense.
