

Madam,

We are sorry that we are late in replying to your letter marked SUDA-15/98(Pt-VI)/69 dated 06.12.2007 on the caption relating to different issues contained in the SOE inmquestion but it did happen for reason beyond our control. Please bear with us for this delay. Actually, we are to communicate our comments on the matter as under but before dwelling on it we would first request your goodself to kindly lend your patience to it and ponder over it for your considerate decision on 2), 3), 4) and 5) below.

- 1) Dr. (Miss) Sharon Fonning: She was Specialist Doctor who left the health services of IPP-VIII-(Extn.) in June,2007, who was paid for this month out the Honorarium made out for three months. R. 800/-(Rupees Eight hundred) only was paid to her and R. 1,600/-(Rupees one thousand and Six hundred) only was refunded to our O&M Account No. 1301998486 with Central Bank of India on 19.09.2007. This was suitably explained in the acquittance Roll which may have inadvertently escaped the attention while checking the Sheet. However, Xerox copy of the Bank Receipt is enclosed which, we hope, will help to close this case.
- 2) Accountant: This case is in need of a peep in retrospect to probe the ground on which he was taken in and the circumstances that necessitated it. Sri E.K. Dutraj was a retiree employee of Life Insurance Corporation of India in the cadre of Class I Officer whose status was equivalent to a WBCS Officer. He was selected in the interview and appointed as an Accountant on the consolidated Remuneration of Rs. 6,000/-(Rupees Six thousand)only in IPP-VIII-(Extn.)-Project during the period of World Bank sponsorship when he gained sufficient knowledge in day to day functioning of IPP-viii- besides earning popularity amongst the staff members of both Office and field. With the ceasing of World Bank sponsorship, the cells of four personnels including him as an Accountant were also wound up. The post of Accountant was an imprortant one which could not be substituted with a suitable hand from any source. He, however, continued to render his services as a gesture of goodwill and his continuation helped to garner the team spirit because of his amiable behaviour and unstinted support in almost all round work of the field and office which aspect he so nicely and soundly harmonized and saved from running into rough weather. He is a person of honesty, sincerety, integrity, diligency and, above all, a highly experienced hand who can handle all the work involved in IPP-VIII whenever reposed on him. We are very much satisfied with his performances and this is why he was offered this post on a nominal consolidated Remuneration of Ps. 4,500/-(Rupees four thousand and five hundred) only which 25 quite little considering his attributes beneficial to our IPP-VIII-(Extn.) which, your goodself will not disagree to. The appointment was offered vide our OFFICE ORDER NO. 104 of SEP- 15: 2006 under Item No. XCIV of Chairman-in-Council meeting dated 19.09.2006 (a xerox copy of this Order is also enclosed for your reference). This is one of the prestigeous Redit:

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Bodies wherein prestige of many dignitaries is involved. This case had the approval from it. So, we would request your goodself to kindly reconsider this case as a special one so that his retention, continuation and rich experience may come to the institution full use of our institution. At this juncture, we do not have any of the personnels like Community Development Officer, Urban Health Improvement Organiser or Sister-in-charge or Health Officer who could look after and monitor the functioning in IPP-VIII-(Extn. Office housed in Sagarmatha from where 78 HHWs, 16 FTSs, 3 Specialist Doctors, Four Part Time Medical Officers and Five Part Time PHNs operate wh need regular contact, assorted interaction, work related suggestion and support and other day to day services to balance the work spirit. It may be added here that his Remuneration was being paid from 'Contingency' head which is known to be of prerogative nature to be decided by the Chairman of the Municipality concerned. Immediately after hearing that his post ha been approved of he stopped drawing the Remuneration as offered to him vide above but has been working without any grudge whatsoever since January, We have every belief and faith that the matter will receive your benign favour which will accommodate him in this post of any other post befitting to his past position. Thanking you in anticipation.

3) Night Guards: Three guards were given appointment vide the then C.D. Specialist's Memo No. IPP-VIII/181/2002/Appointment dated 09. Sep. 2002 (a xerox copy of this letter is also encosed for your kind perusal) as approved of by the L.C.C. meetings held on 02.9.2002 and all of them were designated as 'Security Guards' on the consolidated Remuneration of Rs. 750/- pm which, after releases of two enhancements in between 1xt October, 2004 and 1st July, 2006 @ Rs. 250/- pm. on each occasion, became Rs. 1, 250/- pm (Rs. 750/- + Rs. 250/- + Rs. 250/-) which has been continuing so far. The higher slab of Honorarium was fixed keeping in view the constraint of the high expenses in comparison to other places so that they may concentrate in their duties wholly. As for the man-power, it may be mentioned here that there are two Health Posts each of which is located at a distance of 13 to 15 kms. Where kem two guards are posted and there is Maternity Home-cum-OPD which could not be left unguarded and another guard was posted there to safeguard the properties with modern equipments and sophisticated Testing Instruments. Three of the immovable properties with contents in them were to be guarded but it was not possible on the part of the only one guard which you would definitely appreciate. As such, three Security guards were appointed to cover up the overall security measures so that safety of the properties as said above may be ensured against any theft or damage. The Municipality, as a local guardian, could not depend on the mercy of the situattion nor could it avoid responsibility for which it had to contemplate upon this measure to have the properties with inside articles guarded properly. The fixation of higher slab of Honorarium is also because the candidates for filling up the vacancy of guard was not willing to work on such a low Honorarium for which the matter was placed in the L.C.C. meeting and hence, they were to be offered the Honorarium higher by Rs. 300/- p.m.

The matter has attained almost six years by now by which time they have crossed the age bar of going for another job and, in the circumstances, retrenching them at this stage does not sound humanitarian eithe Remuneration of the guards, Attendants and Sweepers is being paid from the 'contingency' head and if three of them could be accommodated on the 'contingency' head and if three of them could be accommodated on the basis of the provision for the 'contingency' payment being of prerogative nature to be decided by the Chairman of the Municipality concerned, it would the Chairman of their morose and anxiety caused by the situation which is overcasting their simple and honest livelihood. This is also a case approved in the L.C.C. meeting which is also a Body consisting of many highly responsible personnels whose dignity is to be upheld by us. Had this matter come out at the very

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beginning, it would not hit so hard, although three guards at the minimum are our necessity in view of the hilly regions where extra allowances are also granted under the head "Winter Allowance" and this, you could kindly appreciate, make a difference from plains to Hills. Taking the totality of this varying situation as stated, we hope that your goodself would favour us as well as the guards by reconsidering their case as a special case on the humanitarian ground so that we may not be put to hardships for safeguarding the property which is a vital aspect to be looked into vis-a-vis the guards may also not suffer the blow.

We hope, the matter would we very sympathetically be dealt with so that their appointments may not have to be revoked on these hard days of crisis which may fall heavy on them. Your considerate decision in the matter will be highly appreciated. Thank you.

4) Might Guards: This refers to your letter marked SUDA-15/98(Pt-VI)/08/21 dated 18.07.2008[is linked with the case under Sl. No.3) hereinabove on the basis of which the matter may kindly be reconsidered. Thank you.

Enclosed the communication of the Chairman, Darjeeling Municipality bearing no. IPP-VIII/Acs/Revamp/SHPs/008/Ekd dt. 14/26.08.2008 which speaks for itself.

You may be aware that IPP-VIII (Extn.) programme had been launched in 10 Non-KMA ULBs wherein Darjeeling is one of them, in the year 2000. The World Bank's assistance came to an end in 2002, after which Dept. of Municipal Affairs is providing fund for maintaining primary Health care activities. This is to mention here that 16 Sub-Health Posts (SHP) had been established in the year 2002, at Darjeeling Municipality under IPP-VIII (Extn.) to cover 31,534 beneficiaries. Usually, the clinic services i.e. ANC, PNC Clinic 1 – 2 per month, Immunisation Clinic – 1 per month, General Treatment Clinic – 1 per week and Awareness Programme – 2 per month are rendered from each of the SHPs.

Now the Chairman have sought grant of additional 6 nos. of SHPs to reach the services to the scattered areas where the BPL families reside.

The table below will show the no. of wards, BPL population covered earlier, no. of existing HHWs & SHPs and the BPL population enumerated by the recent survey (Year 2006).

No. of Wards	Population covered earlier	No. of existing HHW	No. of existing SHP	BPL population as per survey 2006
32	31,534	78	16	15,356

It may be mentioned here that due to difficult terrain in the hill area, no. of HHWs and SHPs were provided at enhanced rate i.e. approx 400 population per HHW instead of 1,000 population; and approx 1900 population per SHP instead of 5,000 population.

You are requested to look into the matter and furnish a report in respect of need for additional 6 nos. of SHPs by the Darjeeling Municipality.

Madam.

With the recent reshuffling of Darjeeling Civic Body, we collectively made a solemn pledge to revamp all the establishments falling under Dareeling Municipality directly exhibitinectly. In the process, we came across some disadvantages somewhere that have so far deterred smooth functioning, of which IPP-VIII-(Estnn.) is the one. It is so nice that the Government has provided such a beneficial health facilities at the doorstep of the BPL(below poverty line) people but for some predominating odds, delivery of this service has not become effective. This may be evident from the following narration.

We are lucky that there are Sixteen(16) Sub Health Posts under IPP-VIII-(Extn.), Darjeeling Municipality. These Centres have been catering to the medical needs of the BPL families for about Eight years against some odds or the others which were discovered by our new incoming Councillor, in charge of the IPP-VIII-(Extn.). The thorough post mortem conducted by the Councillor-in-charge reveals that majority of the BPL families reside in the scattered areas from where their respective health centres of IPP-VIII are mostly inaccessible this accessibility is further intensified coming to the narrow and somehwere the narrowest passes through the highlands which again involves indiscriminate risk factors for the patients to reach Centres. Moreover, on such narrow passes, the only alternative transportation is to carry on the strature but this mode is also does not prove hazardfree, as the strature may any time dash against the unchopped hillock, standing either side of such passes which are very narrow either.

At the stage as above, what we have mooted out is to increase the number of Sub Health Posts by at least Six so that the existing ones may remain undisturbed for the nearby BPL families and the additional Six opened at such places which will easily minimise the above disadvantages and obstructions to the greatest extent for effective and efficient health services in a still better way. The success of this venture solely depends on your help and co-operation. So, the matter is placed before your goodself to kindly advocate our humble proposal for coverting the same to a solid action in the perspective. Sorry for this indulgence but we could not help either.
