

Placed herewith communication of the Department of Health & Family Welfare vide memo no. HF/O/PSB/3C-13/2010/03/1(1) dt. 29.03.2010 (at Annexure - A) in connection with extension of CBPHCS and HHW Scheme for a further period of one year w.e.f. 01.04.2010. DHFW has kept provision of fund of Rs. 10.00 Crores for FY 2010-11 based on some points. The observations against the said points are detailed below:

The unspent fund lying with SUDA will take care of the gap in training. | In case of CBPHCS, training of HHWs of 45 days duration has started at Raghunathpur Municipality in the last week of March, 2010 as Kulti Municipality could not yet start the programme, training programme of HHWs has been kept in the current FY.  Training for FTSs could not yet been started for Mirik, Raghunathpur and Murshidabad Municipality. The said training programme has been planned during current FY 2010-11. As Kulti Municipality has not yet started the programme, the question of training of their FTSs does not arise at present.  As the staff of M & S Cell at ULB level were not in position at one point of time, orientation training conducted by SUDA did not cover each of the persons. Consequently such orientation training is being continued on need basis.  Moreover, apart from the above mentioned basic training, a no. of re-orientation training for the grass-root level Health functionaries is required round the year for updating knowledge and strengthening capacity. This is to mention here that in all the Urban Health Programmes which are in O & M phase, regular re-orientation training programme has been kept in the schedule and budget is being provided by Dept. of Municipal Affairs.  Under HHW Scheme after completion of all the basic training courses for grass root level Health functionaries, re-orientation training had been conducted in each year. | 3.         | As stated in the letter vide SUDA-Health/69(PtI)/08/597 dt. 01.02.2010, the IEC materials have been printed, all kits & manual have been bought. Fresh allocation is made only to the extent replenishment would be required. Detail list of articles that is proposed to be bought may be supplied.  | Family Schedule for each of the families covered by the HHWs will be required in the very next year for which procurement may be started by SUDA in the last quarter of this FY.  HMIS format have been procured by SUDA and supplied to the ULBs for three years during the period 2006-07, which has already been used up by the ULBs. In fact during the last FY, many of the ULBs had placed requision for supply of HMIS formats which could not be addressed because of shortage of fund received. Hence, a proposal would be submitted to DHFW soon.  HHWs kit bag was provided at the start of the Project in phases during FY 2006-07 & 2007-08. A kit bag lasts for maximum two years. Hence, it also needs replenishment. A proposal may also be submitted to DHFW. Since launching of the programme, uniform had been provided to grass root level Health functionaries by KUSP. As were provided to ULBs implementing other than CBPHCS programme. A set of Uniform does not last beyond two years. Hence, it is high time to replace those uniform. A proposal in this regard may also be submitted to DHFW.  For IEC hard component, provision has not been kept in the estimated budget for FY 2010-11. But group discussion by the HHWs at community level and by FTS at Sub-Centre level with the community women has been slated to raise the awareness level which is the most essential part of IEC. For the reason budget provision has been kept for FY 2010-11. May we write to DHFW for making some allocation in this regard? |  |
| 4.         | Allocation for Furniture & Equipment have been made in the previous years and the report from SUDA states that the same has been purchased for all the Health centre, so fresh allocation is not made in this sector. Fresh allocation may be made if required. SUDA has to submit list of furniture & equipment bought and intended to be bought under the scheme. | Responsibility has been vested with the ULBs for purchase of furniture & equipment. Due to fund crisis no. of ULBs could not yet procure all the approved items of furniture & equipment. However, we may write to the ULBs to submit the list of furniture & equipment already bought and intended to be bought. After obtaining the said information we may write to DHFW.  |  |

During implementation of the HHW Scheme, a policy decision had been taken by the authority to purchase drug, furniture & equipment for SHP, HP & MMC by the ULBs. The same principle has been followed in case of CBPHCS. Therefore, the question of purchase of drug by SUDA does not arise. Moreover, earlier there was no stipulation to purchase drugs from CMS approved vendors at CMS approved price, as the requirement for many of the ULBs are smaller in quantity item-wise for which vendors often did not show any interest. This was experienced for the ULBs which are in O & M phase. A separate self contained note in this regard is placed at Annexure - C for taking decision. |  |  |  |



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Printing & supply of HMIS Forms & Weekly (B) **Immunisation Report Form** 

Placed herewith communication from memari, chandrakona, & taki municipality on the subject of provision of uniform and umbrella to the grass root level health functionaries.

This is to mention here that Kit Bag with contents was provided in the year 2006-07 & 2007-08 to each of the Grass-root level health functionaries for carrying materials required for home visit. Furthermore two sets of uniform and one umbrella had been provided by KUSP to grass root level health functionaries of all the Urban local Bodies including ULBs implementing CBPHCS in the year 2007-08.

As two years have already been passed, there is a felt need to replace the uniform, umbrella and Kit bag.

HMIS Forms required for three years had been printed by SUDA and supplied to the said ULBs in 2006-07.3 years had already been passed. The ULBs are pressing hard for supply of the said items.

Though fund provision for both the component has been kept in the Budget estimate for 2010-11, DHFW in his letter no. HF/O/PSB/3C-13/2010/03/1(1) dt. 29.03.2010 has mentioned that fresh allocation would be made available to replenish the said items.

Requirement of estimated fund for uniform, kit bag and umbrella is Rs. 9.96 lakhs, 2.93 lakhs and 1.75 lakhs respectively; thus totaling Rs. 14.64 lakhs. Estimated requirement of fund for printing of HMIS Forms & Weekly Immunisation Report Forms is Rs. 3.97 Lakhs.

Draft letters to DHFW are enclosed at Flag-A & B for signature, if approved.
