- Treatment of minor ailments at door-step of the beneficiaries.
- Awareness on women and child Health, gender equality, age at marriage / pregnancy, public Health, National Health Programme etc.
- Distribution of condoms, oral contraceptive pills, IFA, ORS etc.
- Early registration of pregnancies, pregnancy care, clean and safe delivery, nutritional care during pregnancy, identification of danger signs during pregnancy.
- Counselling regarding breast-feeding, weaning and immunizations.

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Second Tier :

All the ULBs provide clinic services from 328 nos. of Urban Sub-Centre each covering 10,000 population. Each Sub-Centre is manned by First Tier Supervisor (FTS) daily and part-time Medical Officer on clinic days i.e. ANC / PNC Clinic, Immunisation Clinic, Growth Monitoring Clinic, General Treatment clinic, Awareness Programme on gender equality, age at married pregnancy, contraceptive adoption etc. The Sub-Centres are functioning from the rented accommodation.

Third Tier :

Referral services either in the Municipal owned Health facilities or in the Government run nearby hospital.

Since 1985 Community Based Primary Health Care in 64 Urban Local Bodies are being run under different Projects like CUDP-III, CDSIP, IPP-VIII (Extn). R. C. H. Sub Project at Asansol, DFID assisted HHW Scheme, These projects were initiated with special focus on the urban poor with the fund from the World Bank and DFID and with the involvement of Health & Family Welfare Department, Municipal Affairs Department and Urban Development Department. Thus out of total 126 ULBs 63 ULBs (41 in KMA and 22 in Non-KMA) have already been covered under the said projects. Presently the completed projects are continued and maintained by the State Government in the prespective of successful implementation of the aforementioned projects undertaken from time to time now the State Government has decided to extend the similar health care facilities to the entire population of the rest 63 Urban Local Bodies with special emphasis on urban poor. Accordingly, a Draft Project plan on Community Based Primary Health Care Service in 63 Non-KMA Urban Local Bodies has been prepared in consultation with the Health & Family Welfare Department (A copy of the Project Plan is placed below for kind perusal). The matter was also discussed by Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department with Ministerin-Charge, MA & UD Departments.

The MA Department may review this component of the project and come up with a revised proposal to the Finance Department for approval.

The project is similar to the one which is being implemented in 11 municipal towns under the DFID-assisted Honorary Health Workers (HHW) Scheme. It has been stated by the Health and Family Welfare Department that it would be possible to accommodate the expenditure for this project within the Health System Development Initiative (HSDI) Programme (assisted by DFID). It is felt that instead of treating it as a new scheme, it would be desirable to incur expenditure on account of this project out of the DFID-assisted HSDI Programme. The fund flow for this programme will depend on utilisation of fund. If fund released in the first year is not properly utilised, there will be reduced flow of fund in the second year. The completed Projects are continued and maintained by the State Govt.

The primary health care system in the remaining 63 ULBs are virtually non-existent in comparison to rural set up. For curative and diagnostic health service support, the population is dependent on the Govt. Health Centres / Institutions meant primarily for the rural populace and/or Private Health System. Primary and Public Health System is totally absent, making the entire population vulnerable to communicable diseases.

These 63 ULBs, having an estimated urban poor of 11.23 lakhs, are to be brought under Primarily Health Care System. It is proposed that community based primary health care services more or less similar to IPP-VIII may be introduced in these ULBs. National Health Programmes may also be included under this set up. Linkage with the Sub-Divisional / District hospital may be established, for referral cases. It is proposed that Public Health measures and National Health Programmes may be provided to the entire urban population in these ULBs.

 A Ward having less than 1000 BPL population will have one HHW; a Ward having BPL population between 1000 and 2000 will have 2 HHWs and so on. There will be a minimum of one HHW per Ward regardless of whether that Ward has BPL population or not.
- While the HHW shall be responsible for primary health care of the BPL families under her jurisdiction, she shall also be responsible for both public health services and health statistical data collection for the entire population within her geographic jurisdiction / project-block.
- The HHW will be accountable to Ward Committee / Ward Councillor concerned.

As you are aware the Health & Family Welfare Department, Municipal Affairs Department & SUDA are working together to bring out an uniform urban health service delivery system for the whole of West Bengal in tune with the Urban Health Strategy, 2008.

In keeping with the commitment of providing minimum basic health services to all the urban population, the following has been decided

- 1. Extension of the Community Based Primary Health Care programme in 63 Non-KMA ULBs for a further period of 1 year w.e.f. 01.04.10
- 2. Continuation of **HHW** scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs from the State Budget for a period of 1 year w.e.f. 01.04.10

Provision of fund of F.s.10.00 Crores has been made for the year 2010-2011 on basis of the following:

- 1. The rate of salary for the staff of ULBs under the programmes has been calculated on the existing scale.
- Funds for training of HHWs/FTS were released in previous years and as per status report submitted vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-I)/08/597 dated 01.02.
 Most of the training is complete. The unspent fund lying with SUDA will take care of the gap in training.
- 3. As stated in the letter vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-1)/08/597 dated 01.02. 10 the IEC materials have been printed all Kits and Manuals have been bought. Fresh allocation is made only to the extent replenishment would be required. Detailed list of articles that is proposed to be bought may be supplied.
- 4. Allocation for furniture and equipments have been made in the previous years and the report from SUDA states that the same has been purchased for all the health centres, so fresh allocation is not made in this sector. Fresh allocation may be made if required. SUDA has to submit list of Furniture and equipment bought and intended to be bought under the scheme.

- 5. Allocation for Drugs will be released subject to submission of Drug list. SUDA may be requested to make the purchases of drugs from CMS approved vendors at CMS approved
 - price.

Further SUDA may be requested to submit the following:

- 1. List of all the ULBs under these programmes and their set-up. 2. The infrastructure available in these set-up including existing Manpower.
 - 3. List of medicines that are purchased and supplied under these schemes

 - 4. UC of amount aiready spent by SUDA

It may be noted that once the urban health service delivery system is in place the sanction made towards these schemes will automatically cease and unspent fund will merge with the budgetary allocation to be made for the integrated scheme.
