With regard to issue at serial no. 1, following discussions were held:

Priority shall be given for filling up the vacancy for the post of HHW, FTS, Health Officer, Doctors, paramedical staff and others which are to be dealt separately.

Existence of Creche under CUDP III in three ULBs namely Garulia, North Barrackpore and Hooghly Chinsurah may be examined.

Norms of Health manpower according to Health facilities may be made uniform.

Each of the ULBs should have Health Officer in position.

Office of Health Officer shall have minimum other staff to run the office.

Existence of post of Urban Health Improvement Organiser (UHIO) under IPP-VIII and IPP-VIII

(Extn.) may be examined – views of the ULBs may be obtained.

Shri Kundu will provide the records available with DLB relating to approve manpower under CUDP

Pay structure of Health manpower may be revised.

With regard to miscellaneous issues at serial no. 2, the Committee Members discussed some relevant issues which need addressal:

 Guideline for Leave Rules for Health functionaries engaged under Urban Health Programmes - Draft guidelines for leave rules prepared by the Department may be finalized.

Re-organisation of Health Programme and Manpower at ULB level for five Urban Health Programmes which are in O & M phase - It was intimated by the Jt. Secretary, Dept. of MA that a file has already been placed by the Department to the Hon'ble MIC, MA & UD relating to unified Health Programmes.

Age of superannuation of Health functionaries may be determined – It was reported by no. of ULBs that due to aging grass-root level Health functionaries are unable to provide Health care services which need extensive home visit.

The above issues will be examined by the Committee in the 2nd meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

This is to bring your kind notice to the fact that inadequate posting of HHW and FTS in our Dhuliyan Municipality is being hampered the public service very badly. As per BPL family and total population thereof, posting of HHW & FTS are incongruous inasmuch as total BPL family in our Dhuliyan Municipality is 10874 and total population of that BPL families may exceed 55 thousand minimum. Under this calculation we may get 55 nos. of HHW and 11 nos. of FTS, but we have 13 nos. of HHW in place of 55 and 8 nos. of FTS in place of 11.

Dhuliyan Municipality is no doubt Polio prone area and it is now hardly possible to give effect to the matter of immunization totally in the area for the shortage of aforesaid staff, though we have alacrity in the work to remove all the difficulties in the matter.

It may make a parsing allusion that δ Nos. of sub-centers is already running till date for Immunization, ANC/PNC, and Outdoor health clinic, Awareness Programme, Growth Monitoring Programme and National Health Programme.

Considering the facts and circumstances you are, therefore requested for posting of at least 42 nos. of HHW and 3 nos. of FTS including all infrastructure thereof.

Henceforth, I shall be pleased enough if an additional HHW staffs are sanctioned for the requirement of the prevailing condition and smooth running of the programme.





Sir.

This is to inform you that some of the ULBs requested to sanction additional no. of HHWs either due to increase no. of BPL population in the ward after finalization of BPL population survey 2006 or increase no. of ward.

As per project proposal of CBPHCS, one HHW is to be allotted for a population not exceeding 1000 BPL contained in a single ward. A ward having less than 1000 BPL population will also have one HHW; a ward having BPL population between 1000 – 2000 will have 2 HHWs and so on. There will be minimum one HHW per ward regardless of whether that ward has BPL population or not. However, while calculating required no. of additional HHWs per ward, 1 (one) HHW is earmarked for 1500 BPL population in a single ward instead of 1,000. Statement showing ward-wise BPL population of the ULBs, no. of additional HHWs required is enclosed at Annexure – A. It may be seen that total 88 additional no. of HHWs will be required by 8 ULBs namely Nalhati, Chakdah, Baduria, Contai, Old Malda, Haldia, Jiaganj Azimganj and Purulia who have submitted proposal. Out of the said ULBs, Purulia is implementing HHW Scheme and the others CBPHCS.

Financial implication per year at present rate of honorarium i.e. Rs. 2,000/- per head per month will be Rs. 21.12 lakhs for those additional HHWs. We may obtain approval from DHFW for required no. of additional HHWs as the fund for both the Projects – CBPHCS & HHW Scheme are being provided by them.



This is to mention here that the municipality had submitted initially ward-wise list of slum population under his reference no. 93 dt. 12.06.2006 (copy enclosed for ready reference) - reflecting 54% BPL population in 17 wards.

The proposal of CBPHC was on the basis of BPL population @ 33% of the total population and the estimated no. of HHWs calculated either based on 33% BPL population or @ at least 1 HHW per ward, whichever is higher. Dept. of Health & Family Welfare approved the said proposal. Total population of Baduria Municipality as per 2001 census was 47,418, 33% of which comes to 15648 (estimated BPL population). As per principle, (1 HHW per 1,000 BPL population) the no. of HHWs comes to 16 (approx). Since the ULB is having 17 nos. of wards, the approved no. of HHWs was 17 and FTSs / Sub-Centres - 4 nos.

The selection, training of HHWs already completed and engaged since 01.08.2007.

However, as stated by the Chairman, Baduria Municipality, the recently published list of BPL population is higher in comparison to the previous list. Ward-wise no. of existing BPL population has been submitted by the Chairman which is 33,468 (copy enclosed).
