



Sub: Misappropriation of fund by the Secretary, 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society'

A jointly signed letter has been received from the Founder Chairman, Founder Vice-Chairman and Founder Member of 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' regarding 'Misappropriation of fund' by their Secretary(put up in CP side for records, flagged-X). The copy of the said letter had also submitted by them to the Registrar of the Society.

In brief, the committee members of 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' had stated the followings:

- Sri Amit Sanyal, Secretary of stated society siphoned huge amount of fund which is
  the aberration to the provision of Societies Registration Act.
- 2. Huge amount of expenditure are falsely booked in the audited final accounts resulting siphoning of public exchequer.
- 3. Sri Sanyal had received an advance of Rs. 1 Lac from Haldia Municipality in his personal name and again received a self cheque of Rs. 15000/- from Khardah Municipality which amounts to gross financial irregularities violating the provisions of Society Registration Act.
- 4. The committee members are in the dark about the functioning of their society, i.e. 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' and its present financial status and also of its existence.
- 5. As stated, Sri Sanyal in correlation with the Treasurer presently the said society is deeply entangled with conspiracy and siphoning of public exchequer.
- 6. They alleged, the Secretary that he has changed the composition of the society and managed Chairman's signature in a ticklish manner by putting all 5 Balance Sheets and Profit & Loss A/C.

The aforesaid committee members of 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' has Submitted the copy of 'Registrar of Firms, Societies and Non-Trading Corporation, W.B's letter addressed to the Secretary, of stated Society. An explanation was sought by the Registrar from the secretary for the complaint lodged within 30 days from the receipt of stated letter.

It is pertinent to mention here that based on the proposal submitted by Khardah Municiaplity in 2014-15 they have got an approval on 'Bag Making (Leather & artificial leather)' training for 50 candidates under the stated empanelled training institute, i.e. 'The West Bengal Charmaga Workers Welfare Society'. As per present norms 50% of the total training cost has also been released by this office to the ULB.





In this connection Khardah Municipality has submitted a letter vide memo no.

Kdh(M)/106/15 dt. 09/06/15(flagged-Y), in which the ULB has stated that they are not in a position whether they should start the training or not.

#### Recommendations:

- The allegation lodged by the Committee members of 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' is now under the jurisdiction of Registrar of Firms, Societies and Non-Trading Corporations, W.B
- 2. If the concerned authority reject or cancel the registration no. of the stated society then the society will be dissolved automatically.
- 3. By virtue of their position, as a non-registered society they will loose their status as a Empanelled Training Institute of SUDA.

In this preview it is suggested to pend the training programme of Khardah Municipality and may wait for further communication of 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' committee.

If agreed, a line of communication to the Khardah Municipality regarding pending of training and refund of 50% training fund may be made from our end.

ULB Ref. No. Kdh(M)/493/15 dt. 30/10/2015 of Khardah Municipality.

Under above reference the Khardah Municipality has requested for getting permission of imparting the approved training course, i.e. Bag Making(leather & artificial leather) for 50 candidates under 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society'.

It is pertinent to mention here that a complaint had been lodged by few members of the 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' and also 'Registrar of Firms, Societies and Non-Trading Corporations, West Bengal'. As a result this office had requested the Khardah Municipality vide memo no. SUDA-21/2015/781 dt. 10/07/2015 to withheld the approved training course and also requested to refund Rs. 1,50,000/-(50% training cost), released with approval letter.

After stated communication the Khardah Municipality had with hold the training programme and refunded the 50% training cost i.e. Rs. 1,50,000/- vide memo no. Kdh(m)/240/15 dt. 04/08/15 & Cheque No. 982677 to this office. Received document is put up(flagged-Y) for records.

It has learn't from recent communications of Khardah Municipality and also the said enlisted training provider that 'Registrar of Firms, Societies and Non-Trading Corporations, West Bengal' has declared in their memo no. 254-FIR dt. 18/08/2015 (flagged-X) that i) "As per records, the said society is registered under West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961,....., ii) "The registration is obviously valid".

Based on the aforesaid clearance of 'Registrar of Firms, Societies and Non-Trading Corporations, West Bengal' the 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' (empanelled training provider of SUDA) may be treated as a valid Registered Society with his present portfolio.

Hence,

- a) Permission may be given to Khardah Municipality to start the training under 'The West Bengal Charmaja Workers Welfare Society' b) Again the 50% training cost, i.e. Rs.1,50,000/-to be released.

Sub: Issue of Certificate of Participation for candidates trained under EST&P component of DAY-NULM

Ref. No. K14014/3/2015-UPA. Vol. II(FTS-14532) of UPA Divn. MoHUPA

- A) Under above reference MoHUPA has informed that due to delay in the assessment and certification of trained candidates under EST&P, placement of candidates is also getting delayed. They have advised that a 'Certificate of Participation" may be issued to participants completing the course under EST&P on an interim basis. The certificate can be used by candidates to seek employment; however, this Certificate of Participation is not a substitute for the certificate to be issued by NCVT or SSC.
- B) It has also mentioned in the letter that "The States/STPs should make sure that each candidate successfully completing a course under EST&P gets and NSQF complaint certification in due courset, in addition to the 'Certificate of Participation'.

As directed by MoHUPA, WBSULM may instruct their enlisted Training Providers of erstwhile SJSRY to issue a training participation letter, stating 'Certificate of Participation' to the candidates completed/completing their training during 2014-15 & 20116.

It has learnt that Modular Employable Skill(MES) courses under DGT, are being mapped. For preparation of NSQF complaint certification for the candidates completing training under EST&P we may request Director, RDAT to let us know the present list of NSQF converted MES courses.





Sub: Audit Query

Audit team has raised some queries regarding service tax paid to the training providers through the Urban Local Bodies in EST&P Component under NULM.

Statement and Queries of the Audit team are as follows:

- Government of India had exempted service tax vide Notification No. 13/2013 dt. 10/09/2013.
- As per records, during February, 2016 to July, 2016 a sum of Rs. 18.90 lakh was released to the training agencies.
- The said amount has been released by 12 ULBs to six training agencies, as shown in the table given by audit team.
- For clarification the team has given the following points.
  - Whether the local authority had verified the registration of service tax i) of the agencies claiming the service tax before the payment?
  - Whether the local authority had assured that service tax collected for ii) services exempted by the Government of India was deposited into the Government account?
  - iii) Steps taken by the local authority for recovery of such irregular payment from the training providers.

#### Observation & recommendations:

- On scrutiny, it is observed that during February, 2016 to July, 2016 a sum of Rs. 18.90 lakh was released by this office to twelve ULBs based on their claims submitted for Service Tax.
- From office records a broad sheet on service tax paid to the ULBs is prepared and put up. The data provided by the team is well matched with our records.

Hence, we may clarify the above points (i) to (iii) raised by the audit team from the twleve ULBs to whom the said amount had been released by this office earlier for payment of service tax to their training agencies.

Sub: Completion of training and issuance of Certificate of Participation for the candidates trained under EST&P component of DAY-NULM

Ref. No. K14014/3/2015-UPA. Vol. II(FTS-14532) of UPA Divn. MoHUPA

The erstwhile SJSRY programme has been restructured in NULM programme since April 2014 in two phases. In first phase i.e. from April, 2014 only 58 ULBs have come under NULM and in 2<sup>nd</sup> phase i.e. from April 2016 the rest of the 67 ULBs have incorporated in DAY-NULM programme.

A) Under above reference memo MoHUPA, GOI had directed to instruct the training providers to issue a 'Certificate of Participation' to the candidates who completed EST&P training on an interim basis. The certificate can be used by candidates to seek employment; however, this Certificate of Participation is not a substitute for the certificate to be issued by NCVT or SSC. It was suggested because of the delay in the assessment and certification of trained candidates under EST&P.

In 1<sup>st</sup> phase 58 ULBs have been informed accordingly vide our memo no. SUDA-17/2012(Part-2)/900(58) dt. 06/05/2016(put up in CP side) as above.

Presently we are to inform the aforesaid information to the 67 ULBs of 2<sup>nd</sup> phase for proper functioning of training programme.

B) Since April 2016 a fair number of training approvals have accorded to the 67 ULBs of 2<sup>nd</sup> phase. We need to have a training status report for compilation and records. The existing training status report format is enclosed with the draft letter.

#### Sub: Skill Training status of 2nd phase DAY-NULM towns

Erstwhile SJSRY programme has been restructured as National Urban Livelihood Mission. In 1<sup>st</sup> phase i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2014, 63 Urban Local Bodies have come in its arena. Further, 67 ULBs have been incorporated in DAY-NULM programme from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016. In 2<sup>nd</sup> phase programme a number of training approval has been accorded to the new NULM towns.

To know the present status of training a format has developed and submitted for approval.

If approved, a draft along with the said format is put up for signature.

the last review meeting of DAY-NULM of 58 ULBs held at SUDA it was observed that most of the training courses approved in FY. 2014-15 and 15-16 are either completed or near to completion. To update the current status of training a prescribed format may be communicated to all 58 ULBs where NULM programme has started in 1st Phase.

From the format following training course wise report could be known.

- Date of Commencement
- Date of Completion
- Expected date of completion
- Whether ULB has submitted assessment data or not
- Whether 2<sup>nd</sup> installment training fund received by the ULB

After compilation of information received from the 58 ULBs this office may approve training courses to some ULBs who have already completed their approved training course/s to achieve their target of EST&P in 2016-17. Further, some 2<sup>nd</sup> installment training fund can be released, who have not received the same.

#### Sub: Placement report of EST&P training under DAY-NULM programmne

Since inception of NULM programme a number of approval for Skill training under EST&P component of NULM has been accorded to the ULBs. As per guidelines of NULM third party assessment and certification to be done after completion of training. After certification of the candidates placement (70% and above) is also a major criteria.

For lengthy and delayed process of assessment and NCVT certification the otal training and placement is being interrupted, i.e. i) Delay in getting National level certificate, ii) Drop out of the trainees at the time of assessment, iii) Release of raining fund etc.

To overcome the bottleneck situation of EST&P training and placement previously this office had released 2<sup>nd</sup> installment training fund to some ULBs on the basis of submission of their training completion report to initiate the process of placement at ULB level with or without NCVT certification. As per present norms all ULB have to upload the placement data in NULM portal time to time. It is noticed that most of the ULBs are not properly uploading the placement data in time.

It is proposed to communicate a report format on training and placement to the ULBs to whom 2<sup>nd</sup> installment training fund has already been released. It is expected that after compilation of data we may generate the following information.

- Status of placement after completion of training. Whether its assessment and certification has done or withheld till date?
- If percentage of placement is satisfactory (70% and above) then we may release remaining part of training fund (20%) to the ULBs.
- From the stated data sheet we may get some information on percentage of SC/ST, minority, male, female etc., by which this office may generate some reports required for our department or GOI time to time.

The report format is placed in CP side for approval.



- All training courses to be National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) compliant. May see the order memo no. K-14012/1/2014-UPA dt. 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017(flagged-Y). NSQF- compliant MES courses may be imparted by the State. Out of 577 MES courses 302 courses are presently approved by National Skill Qualification Committee (NSQC) under Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship(MoSDE).
- Since inception, Modular Employable Skills (MES) training courses were accorded approval for training to the ULBs up to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017.
- It is to mention here that presently out of 302 NSQF aligned MES courses only SUDA approved MES courses are compliant with NSQF. A list of NSQF compliant MES Courses is put up for compliances (Flagged-A).
- All skill training courses have to follow Common Norms introduced by MoSDE
  and also implemented by MoHUA in EST&P training. So as to implement
  common norms of training the operational guidelines have been amended time to
  time by MoHUA submitted for approval. GOI has also insisted upon
  empanelment of fresh Training Providers for EST&P training.
- From 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 onwards all training assessment to be done by respective Sector Skill Council(SSC) under National Skill Development Corportation(NSDC) and assessment data to be handled through SDMS portal of NSDC(flagged-B). We may request TET Deptt. for assessment through NSDC for further training.

## Sub: Assessment & Certification of EST&P training through RDAT

Assessment and Certification of EST&P training is an integral part of DAY-NULM programme. Since inception of NULM programme Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development(PBSSD) under Technical Education, Training and Skill Development (TETSD) Department has been arranging for Third Party Assessment(TPA) and Certification of the candidates imparted skill training courses under NULM after obtaining necessary information from WBSULM.

In a meeting held with Principal Secretary, TETSD Deptt. and Director, SUDA & Mission Director, WBSULM it was decided that PBSSD under TETSD Deptt. would not take the responsibility of assessment & certification of the candidates completed training after Lot-9. They have suggested to send the remaining candidates details to Regional Directorate of Apprenticeship Training(RDAT) under Directorate General of Training(DGT) for TPA and NCVT certification. The TETSD Deptt. has also assured to pursued our pending certification with RDAT.

Till date the assessment data of around 30000 candidates (including 2746 candidates of KMC) of different ULBs are still lying with our office. The candidate details are also prepared in DGT prescribed format for submission.

The SDIS portal for assessment & certification has stopped on and from 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. It is learnt that backlog assessment to be done with the permission from DGT, MoSDE, Govt. of India.

It is proposed that we may communicate the matter with Director General, DGT, GOI for getting permission of pending assessment and the copy may be forwarded to RDAT, Kolkata and PBSSD for persuasion.

It is also to mention here that if they permit this office to upload the data through our Training Providers for assessment the assessment cost have to pay directly to the Assessing Body by this office after their claim like other States.

Followings information received from Training Officer, RDAT Kolkata.

- As SDIS portal is disabled, at present RDAT Kolkata is unable to initiate assessment of pending NULM batches. SUDA may contact to DGT for the same with copy forwarded to RDAT Kolkata.
- No communication received by RDAT Kolkata regarding the initiative of recent upload of 4008 candidates into SDIS portal.
- As per new assessment process, RDAT Kolkata is only responsible for approval of testing centre once the batches are uploaded into SDIS portal. RDAT Kolkata confirmed that no such batches appear in their portal now.
- 4. Also,RDAT approve testing centre based on feedback from State Nodal Person of corresponding scheme. Surajit Mondal appears to be the same for Skill Training under NULM in West Bengal. Technical Officer,RDAT mentioned an email from Surajit Mondal regarding rejection of 5 testing centres during August, 2018.

EST&P component under DAY-NULM intends to provide training to the urban poor as per the skill demand from the market, so that they can set up self-employment ventures or secure salaried employment.

Under the present practice, after completion of training the TPs enter requisite data on SDIS portal and the training details are forwarded to Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development (PBSSD), under Technical Education, Training & Skill Development Deptt, lot wise, from SUDA for initiating liaison with Assessing Body for assessment, certification.

- Total 30124 candidate data (Lot-10 & Lot-11) are still pending for third party assessment from NCVT.
- PBSSD has expressed unwillingness to facilitate assessment for pending 30124 proposals vide its memo no TET/PBSSD/SUDA-01/2016/633(2) dated 02/08/2018.
- In the mean time, from NMMU, GoI total 14020 candidate data has been posted into SDIS portal from NULM MIS and the batches are ready for assessment.
- A follow up email received from NMMU on 20-02-2019 to expedite the assessment process.

Under the aforesaid circumstances, SUDA may initiate the process of assessment through STPs and per candidate Rs. 800/- (Eight Hundred Only) may be paid by SUDA itself once the assessment and certification get completed successfully and acknowledged by concerned ULB.

If approved, proposed process may be as follows for the batches in Lot-10 and Lot-11 only,

Step 1: SUDA Notify STPs about the assessment data uploaded into SDIS portal and corresponding User ID and password received from NMMU,GoI.

Step 2: STP to contact AB and organize assessment in presence of ULB representative.

Step 3: Result Published by AB on SDIS portal.

Step 4: STP download certificate from SDIS portal and upload accordingly into MIS portal.

Step 5: AB raise bill for assessment to SUDA in attached format.

If approved, the above process along with bill format may be communicated to corresponding STPs and ULBs.

The above proposal for assessment of pending batches under DAY NULM is placed for your kind perusal.

The revised arrangement for assessment and certification of EST&P trainees has been drawn up at "A" nsp-54.

Out of a total pendency of 30124 candidates for assessment and certification, data for 14020 candidates have been already ported to the SDIS portal. The remaining data for 16104 candidates would still have to be ported from the NULM portal to the SDIS portal. The process of assessment by the assessors nominated by the SDIS is already under way without the previous arrangement through PBSSD. Therefore the revised arrangement may now be finalized through the proposed process flow as enunciated at "A" prepage, if approved. SMMU SULM will monitor the activity fortnightly through the TPs and ensure a report to be submitted to this office. The upfront monthly plan of the ABs are to be shared with the SMMU SULM also apart from being shared with the TPs.
