Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) is an autonomous body established under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. FSSAI is responsible for protecting and promoting public health through the regulation and supervision of food safety.

Quality Assurance:- FSSAI has been mandated to perform various functions related to quality and standards of food.

The FSSAI has prescribed standards for following food products:

- Dairy products and analogues
- · Fats, oils and fat emulsions
- Fruits and vegetable products
- Cereal and cereal products.
- Meat and meat products
- Fish and fish products
- Sweets & confectionery
- Sweetening agents including honey
- Salt, spices, condiments and related products
- Beverages, (other than dairy and fruits & vegetables based)
- Other food product and ingredients
- Proprietary food
- · Irradiation of food

State License: As the members of SHGs / ALFs / and CLFs under NULM programme has been started various types of marketable food productions in their own. Now it is important to register all food products for quality control under FSSAI licensing /registration under State License which will help SHGs to unleash their capabilities to generate meaningful and sustainable livelihoods.
