In response to the above mentioned letter, I would like to describe the chronological fact from the inception and also want to express the opinion of the municipality more elaborately regarding the project of Shelter Of Urban Homeless people.

- Proposal sent to SUDA for construction of SUH via memo no Memo No 1448/Gnl dated 06/12/2017
- Approval at the meeting of Board of Councillors on 29/12/2017
- Sending of application and detailed site plan to SUDA via memo no: 1648/Gnl dated 16/02/2018
- Feasibility report to the Municipal Engineering Department, Barasat via memo no 1750/Gnl dated 20/03/2018
- Municipal Engineering Department has asked for the NOC of the Land Authority via Memo no MED/N24PGS/31 / IN-16/2018 dated 10/04/2018
- Municipal Engineering Directorate also informed our office in memo no ME/N24PGS/124/IN-16/2018 dated 04/05/2018 after the site inspection of the land that the proposed land is suitable for the construction of the above mentioned project
- Sending of letter at District Primary School Council for the NOC of them via memo no 287/Gnl dated 21/07/2018
- We got the NOC from the Sub Inspector of Schools, District Primary Councils, North 24 Pargana via email dated 11/10/2018
- Our office contacted with the BLRO dept and they informed us that the land is currently in the possession of Refugee Relief & Rehabilitation department.
- Our office sent the official request letter at your department for the hand over via memo no: 892/Gnl dated 07/02/2019 along with the site plan.
- RR&R dept has completed the inspection of the land on 06/03/2019
- RR&R dept asked for the Mouza map of the Mouza Basudebpur, North 24 Pgs for this land via memo no: 79/RC(Reg) dated 18/04/2019.

- Letter from RR&R dept via memo no 99/RC(Reg) dated 11/06/2019 raising some queries about the dilapidated school building, pump house and park.
- Letter from our Municipality to your office via memo no 211/Gnl dated 20/06/2019 resolving the queries.
- Last Physical follow up by our officials at your office on 02/08/2019
- Further queries from RR&R dept via Memo no 135/RC(Reg) dated 02/08/2019

Our opinion:

As per the conversation with your office dated 02/08/2019, I would like to inform you that the dilapidated building structure will be demolished. The pump house is situated at the corner of the land and we will keep the pump house as it is now and construct the shelter just keeping the space for this pump house. The space of the municipal park will be shortened to some extent to construct the shelter but we will decorate the park more beautifully as it will fall just beside the proposed shelter.

In this regard, I would like to request you to take this matter as most urgent and provide us with your No Objection for this project as soon as possible. The **Mouza map of Basudebpur Mouza, a fresh site map/ detailed project plan, NOC of school dept** as asked by you, have been attached along with this letter.

- More than one official in-charge of Geo-tagging can be registered for one ULB/City.
- If a new Shelter home is created then it can be added by 'Add Shelter' option.
- If any new shelter is added through the mobile APP then full details of the shelter should be updated by the ULB/City.
- Approval of the 'Geo-tagged Shelter' image shall be done by the NMMU.
- Only after approval the image by the NMMU, location of the shelter will be available on the <http://geourbanmission.gov.inportal>.

2. A copy of User Manual detailing out the process of using geo-tagging app is also enclosed herewith for reference. You are requested to initiate the process of geo-tagging the shelters operational and complete the exercise at the earliest but not later than February end, 2019.

Sub:-Making over of all khas or Vested tanks and ferries to the Panchayat Institutions.

In accordance with the decisions taken by the Cabinet Sub-Committee on Panchayat Institutions for the transfer of Khas or Vested tanks, hats, bazars and ferries to the Panchayat bodies for their control and management it has been decided by the Board of Revenue that the following steps should be taken for the quick implementation of the decisions:-

- i) Lists of Khas or Vested tanks (Gram Panchayat-wise in respect of which the lease or settlement with the private individual or fishermen or Cooperative Societies of fishermen etc. expires on the last day of Chaitra, 1385 B.S. should be prepared immediately.
 - ii) As soon as the Lists are prepared such Khas or Vested tanks should be formally handed over to the respective Gram Panchayat on and from the 1st Baisakh, 1386 B.S.
 - iii) Likewise lists of Khas or Vested tanks remaining unsettled may be prepared and such tanks handed over to the Gram Panchayat immediately.
 - iv) Separate lists of Khas or Vested tanks (Gram Panchayat-wise) in respect of which lease or settlement would expire on subsequent years should be prepared immediately indicating against each the date on which the term expires.
 - v) As and when the tenure of lease or settlement of such tanks expires these should be promptly handed over formally to the concerned Gram Panchayats.
 - vi) In case any Khas or Vested tanks whose jurisdiction extends over more than one Gram Panchayat, such Khas or Vested tank should be handed over to the Panchayat Samity.
 - vii) Khas or Vested tanks extending over more than one Panchayat Samity, should be handed over to the Zilla Parishad concerned.
 - viii) In respect of Vested ferries Panchayat Samiti-wise lists of such ferries in respect of which the lease or settlement expires on the last day of Chaitra, 1385 B.S. should be prepared immediately and such ferries formally handed over to the respective Panchayat Samities.
 - ix) A complete Panchayat Samiti-wise list of Vested ferries whose terms expires on subsequent years should also be prepared immediately indicating against each the date of expiry of settlement so that they may be handed over to the concerned Panchayat Samiti on time.
 - x) The ferries covering more than one Panchayat Samiti may be handed over to the Zilla Parishad after expiry of their tenure of lease or settlement.

II. National Programme for Prevention and Control of Deafness (NPPCD):

State Govts. have to submit audited UC & audited SOE from 2013-14 so that funds to these States for carrying out NPPCD activities are released in time. States should also ensure posting of one Data Entry Operator with each District Nodal Officer (DNO). State Nodal Officers (SNOs) and DNOs must be provided an office space by States along with necessary infrastructure like computer for carrying out their activities.

The Member States informed that the Programme is being implemented by them as per the guidelines issued by M/H&FW.

The Council observed that NPPCD is an ongoing programme. The Member States were advised to send the ATR/Compliance Report to M/o H&FW at the earliest.

Decision: The Council treated the agenda item as resolved.

III. Issues related to Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery (ANM)/General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) Schools :

Utilization Certifications and progress reports/MoU for GNM/ANM Schools are pending from Member States.

The Member States informed that the Programme is being implemented by them as per the guidelines issued by M/H&FW.

The Council advised the Member States to furnish requisite information along with pending UCs to the M/o H&FW at the earliest.

(Sponsored by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs(MoHUA))

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has been pursuing with the member States on establishment of shelters for Urban Homeless under DAY-NULM. The Hon'ble Supreme Court is monitoring the matter and member States were requested to expedite the establishment of shelters.

The Council reviewed the progress and advised the Member States to speed up establishment of shelters as per their targets and send report to the MoHUA at the earliest.

Decision: The Council treated the agenda item as resolved.

Item No. 6: Expeditious clearance for Right of Way (RoW) for Network of Spectrum (NFS) Defence Project
(Sponsored by Department of Telecommunications)

Govt has approved the rollout of a pan India Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) based network exclusively for Defence Services popularly known as Network for Spectrum (NFS). This time bound project is being implemented by BSNL in 'Mission Mode' to meet the stringent timelines. Any delay in rolling out this project of national importance will adversely affect all missions of critical capabilities of Armed Forces. Expeditious clearances for RoW are necessary to avoid delay in the implementation of this project of national importance.

Chief Minister, West Bengal stated that for granting Right of Way (RoW) clearance to BSNL for defence purposes, necessary directions have already been issued to all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs).

The Council observed that clearances for RoW are very important for the implementation of the project and advised the Member States to look into this matter on priority basis.

Decision: The Council treated the agenda item as resolved.

Item No. 7: Issues relating to Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Teacher Education (CSSTE)
(Sponsored by Ministry of Human Resource Development)

CSSTE, initiated in 1987, was revised for the 12th Five Year Plan with an approved outlay of Rs. 6308.45 crore to be shared between the Centre and the States in the revised ratio of 60:40. It aims to provide infrastructural and institutional support to Government Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs). States had been advised to take several measures including hiring deserving Teacher Educators on an annual basis, vacancies in the TEIs to be filled up on an urgent basis, to conduct Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) on annual basis, filling up of vacancies in DIETs, SCERTs, Colleges of Teacher Education (CTEs) and Institutes of Advanced Study in Education (IASEs),

গৃহহীন, দরিদ্র, পিছিয়ে পড়া মানুষদের জন্য নির্মিত আবাসন ঐ সমস্ত মানুষদের বর্তমান অবস্থান এবং জীবিকাশ্রম-এর যতটা সম্ভব কাছাকাছি হওয়া প্রয়োজন। এইসব গৃহহীন মানুষরা সাধারণত রেল স্টেশন, বাস ডিপো, বাজার, পাইকারী বেচাকেনার বাজার-এর মত জায়গায় আশ্রয় নেন। দেখতে হবে যে এই নতুন আবাসন কেন্দ্রটি যেন এই সমস্ত জায়গার থেকে দূরে না হয়। এছাড়াও প্রয়োজনে অন্যান্য এলাকা, যেমন জনসাধারণের জন্য সাধারণ ভাবে ব্যবহৃত জায়গা, শিল্পাঞ্চল, বিনোদন-এর জন্য ব্যবহৃত ফাঁকা জায়গায় - নির্দেশিকা ও মূল পরিকল্পনায় পরিবর্তনের মাধ্যমে আবাসন কেন্দ্র নির্মাণ-এর জন্য অনুমতি প্রদান করা যেতে পারে।

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

Inmates of 'Abhayashram'- Shelter for Urban Homeless engaged in making paper pouch (thonga) for generating livelihoods. Daily, these inmates make paper pouches of approx. 1Kg of newspaper (which is mainly collected from the local community) and sell it in the local market at Rs.32/Kg . These products are not only Eco-Friendly but also Bio-Degradable.



Sal leaf plate

Jharna Self Help Group. Ward No 32, Palasdiha, Durgapur, CDS – 5

Jharna SHG under National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) was formed in July 2016 with 13 members out of which 8 members are engaged in Sal Leaf Plate making with machine. Jharna SHG group comprises of all Adivasi (ST) members has got Revolving Fund and after Grading it has got CC Loan from UBI Bank of amount Rs 1.25 lacs. The Group is also part of in Durgapur ALF 12. The sal leaf plate business unit was inaugurated by ShriManas Roy Councillor Ward 32, Durgapur Municipal Corporation in the month of June 2018.

Micro economy of Sal Leaf Plate business unit

- Cost of sal leaf plate machine – Rs 20,000 /- inclusive of GST
- Sewing machine costs – Rs 7,000 /-
- Raw material attached with sticks – Purchase from Adivasisparas of Malandighi Gram Panchayet
- 1 finished sal leaf plate requires 2 sal leaf raw material attached with sticks
- Raw material costs – 1000 pieces @ Rs 250. 1 piece @ 25 paisa
- Raw material carrying costs – Rs 600

- Production capacity – 250 to 300 finished sal leaf plate products
- Working capacity of the group with the machine per day – 6 hours daily
- Per hour production capacity – 40 to 50 pieces
- Monthly production capacity – 7000 to 8000 finished sal leaf plate
- Electricity consumptions per month – 40 Units
- Unit cost of production of 1 sal leaf plate finished product – 65 paisa (2 sal leaf attached with sticks, stitching costs, carrying costs, electricity and interest payment to Bank)
- Selling cost of 1 piece of finished sal leaf plate – 75 paisa
- Expected monthly income generation after deducting raw material cost, electricity, carrying cost and interest payment to Bank – Rs 1000

Jharna group sells sal leaf plate to shops, road side restaurants, caterers & decorators for marriage and various other purposes, local pujo and festivals etc. First month of their business they have earned Rs 1000 after deducting raw material costs, electricity and interest payment to bank. The group is planning to expand their business activities by buying another set of sal leaf plate making machine and sewing machine in future. These will double their production capacity and earning.



PLASTIC BAN CAMPAIGN OF KALYANI MUNICIPALITY BY SHGS UNDERDAY-NULM

Kalyani Municipality has targeted the most problematic single use plastic by conducting a baseline assessment. To identify the most problematic single use plastic, as well as the current cause, extent and impacts of their mismanagement.

Considering the best actions to tackle the problem Kalyani Municipality has appointed 120 no. SHG ladies for regular awareness campaign at different market places under Kalyani Municipality.

Raise public awareness about the harm caused by single used plastics. Clearly explain the decision and any quantitative measures that will be followed by every residence & stake holder of Kalyani Municipality.

To promote alternatives before the ban or penalty comes into force, assess the availability of alternatives. SHG ladies had already been producing eco-friendly and fit-for-purpose alternatives (i.e different type of paper bags and cloth bags) that do not cause more harm to the environment. It also generates an alternative livelihood for SHG members and it will also engage them in business activates.

Kalyani Municipality is also planning to collected revenue in the why of penalty as mentioned earlier on single use plastics to maximise the public good. To support environmental projects or boost local recycling with the funds.
