Sri A.K. Singh, Under Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India vide No. K-14015/1/2015-UPA/FTS-12299 dated 07.09.2015 (CP-1) informed the Director, SUDA that the Project viz. 'Skill Development for Sustainable Income Generation, West Bengal' (CP-2 to CP-18) submitted by Indian Institute of Cerebral Palsy (IICP) and forwarded/recommended by Government of West Bengal vide letter no. SUDA-85/2014/1784 dated 02.01.2014 has been approved by the Project Approval Committee of the Ministry in its meeting held on 02.6.2015 for implementation as I&SP Project under National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM) at a cost of Rs. 872500/- to be completed in 2 years alongwith activity plan and milestone of fund release schedule of the project submitted.

In this connection, he has requested to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) as prescribed in the Operational Guidelines of I&SP Project under NULM (CP-19 to CP-25), with the IICP for immediate implementation of the project. After receiving the information on signing the MoA and start of the project, the Ministry will release the fund in accordance with the milestones prescribed for the same approved by the Ministry.

Hence considering the above issues and as per guideline of I&SP Project, following actions may be taken up:

1. To enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) between West Bengal State Urban Livelihoods Mission (WBSULM) and Indian Institute of Cerebral Palsy (IICP) for implementation of the Project viz. 'Skill Development for Sustainable Income Generation, West Bengal'. The **Draft MoA** is placed in **CP-32 to CP-48** for kind approval.

If approved, a draft letter for calling IICP at SUDA for signing the MoA is placed in **CP-49** for kind approval.

2. In the Operational Guideline of I&SP Project, it is mentioned that (please see **CP-29**)
 - i) The SULM will be required to maintain a separate account for funds released under this component. As funds released to the State Governments/SULM under this component are meant for particular projects, therefore the release of Grants-in-Aid to States for implementation of other components of NULM will not depend on the utilization of funds released for projects under I&SP component.
 - ii) Audit of the approved I&SP project is required to be carried by an Auditor (Chartered Accountant) appointed for the purpose. The audit may preferably be done through a Chartered Accountant empanelled by the CAG or the Income Tax Department.
 - iii) The interest amount accrued on the deposits of the I&SP Project funds in Banks at State and Implementing Agency levels shall be treated as part of the Project funds and shall be utilized on Project activities only. Accordingly, the interest earned on funds should be shown separately and should be added to the available funds while claiming subsequent installments.

Hence, a **separate Bank Account** may be opened by WBSULM for I&SP Project under NULM.

CONCEPT NOTE :-Innovative & Special project (I&SP)1. Background:-

Innovative And Special Projects (I&SP) is the major component and newly added Component under NULM . The objective of the I&SP Project is to upgrade livelihood opportunities to the Urban poor specially who are not directly beneficiaries and deal their life in very vulnerable situation within a time frame . This Component will focus on the promotion of novel initiatives in the form of innovative projects.

2.) KEY PROBLEM AREAS :- Till now WBSULM did not develop the key policy regarding Innovative & Special Project (I&SP) . So for the implementing the project , WBSULM are facing some problems.

2.1) It is observed that, some few organizations submit proposals for the Innovative & Special Project (I&SP) under NULM throughout the year . So , it is a continuous process to review & resubmission the project for the approval . For a result it reflects on our project .

2.2) In our State , only one proposal of Indian Institute of Cerebral Palsy , Taratola (IICP) , has been approved by the GoI for the year of 2015-2016 & 2016-2017 .

Last year (2016-2017) only Two Proposals has been sent to the Govt of India for the approval of the PAC Committee . But till now no response has come from their end till now .

2.3) some other organizations have submitted I&SP Project under WBSULM , but they are not innovative in nature as such .

2.4) To reach all target groups under NULM, WBSULM may agree for Public, Private, Community Partnership (P-P-C-P) with reputed NGOs to achieve the objective of the NULM .

3) **PRESENT SITUATION :-** As per the Guideline WBSULM did not able to reach to the all target groups . As per the I&SP guideline WBSULM may utilize 5% of the total central fund . The Details of Central Grant has given below and total amount in respect of % may Utilize in the Innovative and Special project has given below.

 3.3) WBSULM may use as project cost Rs. Rs. 3,10,17,300 for this Component .
 3.4) WBSULM did not able to spend the amount due to insufficient of the project proposal from the Suitable NGOs

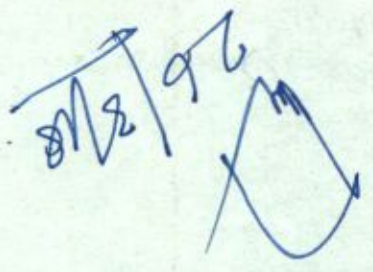

Based on the previous NS (Page No – 13- 21) and based on the discussion the topic with the presence of Mission Director SUDA, it is advised to re-think the issue of RFP of I&SP project as RFP is not mandatory in this case.

Some Observations on RFP process in respect of Innovative Projects :-

Findings regarding RFP Vs Innovation :-

- We know , A request for proposal (RFP) is a document that solicits proposal, often made through a bidding process, by an agency or company interested.

- Only One agency can be selected through this process .
- By this process only low bidder can be selected .

- In that case , selected projects may not be in innovative , may not be possible to cover the said target groups or their livelihood opportunities .

- On the other hand, there are more possibilities for an organization who have submitted proposals by fulfilling all criteria and also in innovative mode but not able to compete because of the rule- that only lower bidder can be selected . WBSUTLM will not be able to select the organization because of RFP though it was more innovative rather than the selected organization .

- Innovative & Special Project is the project where multiple organizations may submit proposals with different innovations for the different target groups .

- Another thing is, as per Guideline of the I&SP Govt organizations, Semi Govt Organization and Govt Agency, ULB may also submit Proposals to the WBSULM. But by this one window (RFP) these organization may not be participate.

So, based on the Guideline, WBSULM may implement the project component through Public, Private, Community Partnership (P-P-C-P) with strong strategies to create long-term and sustainable livelihood opportunities which may cover organisation of the urban poor, formulation and implementation of innovative but not in RFP mode but through project sanction and approval committee.

WBSULM may follow the para of 7.4 and 8.2 of the Guideline of I&SP

project :-

- The State Government / WBSULM will examine the proposal in terms of profile and experience of the agency proposing the project, justification and feasibility of the project, funding details, modalities for implementation, time schedule for completion etc., and send their recommendations/comments along with the proposal to the National Mission Directorate, NULM.

- The consent of the State Government / ULB or any other agency who will be required to maintain the assets, or sustain the project after the project period is required to be produced at the time of recommending the project to the National Mission Directorate, NULM.
