

Success Story of SUH (SARANYA) under NULM by Bongaon Municipality

Bongaon Municipality started a 50 bedded shelter unit on 30.07.2017 under the scheme Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) under DAY-NULM. This shelter has been identified to develop as model shelter in the State. At present 46 inmates are staying in this shelter unit. For 24x7 hrs monitoring a Shelter Manager & three caregivers in three shifts are working in this shelter. For special care of Women & Old age inmates ULB has engaged further two SHG members as Women Caregiver. A Primary Health Check Up unit is established in a room for the primary heath check up support for inmates for all days and two HHW were engaged for these purpose. This shelter is established 1 km from the Champaberia Bus Stand and 3 km from Bongaon Railway Station. ULB provided free food to all inmates daily four times. A Women SHG is engaged for cooking food for the inmates. City Mission Management Unit of Bongaon Municipality monitors day to day Operation & Management of Shelter. ULB itself running this shelter unit, through the fund support of O & M cost of NULM. Shelter Management Committee is constituted as per the guidelines of SUH. This Committee also closely monitors the operation & maintenance of SUH. All the infrastructures are provided as per the guidelines of SUH. ULB also installed CCTV Camera for 24x7 hrs surveillance & installed TV set for the recreation of the inmates. Daily Yoga classes arranged for the all the inmate by the ULB and one instructor is engaged for this purpose. Inmates in this shelter are entitled under different social benefit scheme. Bank A/C has been opened for the inmates. For their livelihood different hands on training are arranged regularly i.e. paper bag making, clothes painting etc. Each year in Durga Puja, ULB arrange a Puja Parikroma for all the inmatesand distribute clothes to all inmates. Regular (every month Last week) nigh survey is conducted for identification & rescue of homeless people from the nearby Bus Stand, Railway Station. Few glimpses of different activities are given below:







Guidelines for Establishment of Model Shelters

1. Introduction:

Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) is under implementation since 2014. Scheme for Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) is one of its components. At the time of bringing out these guidelines, more than 1000 shelters are operational across the country. It requires no emphasis that the urban homeless survive under numerous challenges like no access to public services such as health, education, food, water and sanitation.

In 2017, the Justice (Retd) Kailash Gambhir Committee, constituted as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, had visited shelters in 13 States/UTs and made certain observations, *inter-alia*, on the quality of shelters. Further, the lack of availability of necessary facilities and absence of basic infrastructure has also been flagged on many occasions by the National Mission Managers and Mission Director during their field visits from time to time.

In order to ensure quality shelters, the Ministry has advised the States/UTs, implementing SUH, to develop two model shelters, one in the capital city and another in a big city. These shelters will act as "*proofs of concept*" showcasing the mandated facilities for urban homeless. Subsequently, the State/UTs will be expected to replicate the same in other shelters.

The word "*proof of concept*" in the previous para does not refer to the physical infrastructure. It has been used more for the quality of care and services to the urban homeless which the shelter for urban homeless component intends to give. The present prevalent practice majority of states to select Shelter Management Agencies based on least cost tendering does not appear to do justice with this object and the same has been noted by the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court which visited shelters across the country.

Therefore, extreme care should be taken while selecting the SMA to ensure that the agency has good past track record and is technically capable of providing intended quality of care to the urban homeless. The nature of human resource available on the roll of agency, the function and technical soundness should be given adequate weightage while selecting the agency as detailed out in the later part of the document.

2. Identification of ULBs

- States/UTs should identify one or two ULBs as per their size, preferably the state capital and a million plus/big city.

- The ULB (s) identified, must have at least 50 identified urban homeless.
- Names of identified ULBs and the place chosen to establish the shelters need to be communicated to the Ministry.
- After receipt of intimation, the Ministry may depute its representative to visit the same before the establishment of shelter is finalized.
- Work for establishment of model shelter will start after receipt of confirmation from the Ministry.

3. Survey & Identification of Urban Homeless

Completion of third party survey to identify the homeless and identification of the places of their congregation will be a pre-requisite for selection of a ULB/city. The survey data must also be accepted by the appropriate authority in State/UT. As far as possible, site of the model shelters should provide maximum convenience to the homeless identified.

4. Construction of Shelter

- A model shelter can be newly built or refurbished old building.
- If re-furbished building is being used, it must have necessary certification from the concerned agency on its fitness.
- The structure should preferably have environmentally friendly design, rain water harvesting, solar heating/ lighting facilities etc.
- States/UTs may adopt innovative & affordable building designs for construction of model shelters.
- State may draw upon the expertise of the agencies like HUDCO & HPL for design of model shelters and also use pre-fabricated structure for speedy construction of shelters.
- Location should be close to the places of congregation of homeless and their places of livelihoods as far as practicable.
- The shelters should be geo-tagged on city maps so that their location is available on city maps, travel guide maps, online maps, etc. published by various agencies for easy access.
- The addresses of shelter must be displayed on a sign board on the bus stands/ railway stations to guide the homeless persons.

5. Facilities in a Model Shelter

The SUH guidelines prescribe the list of facilities which are to be made available at every model shelter so as to enable the homeless persons to live with dignity. Model Shelters will incorporate/add facilities from time to time as amended in the guidelines/orders of the Courts for improving their standard of living. The facilities to be ensured are:

- Well ventilated rooms.

- Water arrangement (Regular potable drinking water and other needs) and sanitation.
- Adequate bathing & toilet facilities-if there are women residents, then separate facilities must be provided.
- Standard lighting for shelter.
- Adequate fire protection measure, as per the norms.
- First-aid kit.
- Pest and vector (mosquito) control arrangements.
- At least monthly cleaning of blankets, mattresses and sheets, and maintenance of other services.
- Common kitchen/cooking space, necessary utensils for cooking and serving, cooking gas connections etc. The deficiency in the utensils must be replenished on regular basis.
- Child care facilities for children by linking the shelter to the nearest Anganwadi Center.
- Facilitation for convergence with other services/entitlements.
- Personal lockers for personal storage space
- Common recreation space
- The shelter must be disabled friendly as per the relevant guidelines.
- Arrangement of CCTV camera (s).
- Free food to 10% of residents (old, infirm and those who cannot pay for it) out of O&M cost.
- Provision of computers to capture the details of inmates.

6.

Funding of all the proposals of model shelters (*newly built, refurbishment, O&M*) should be approved by Project Sanctioning Committee. The State/UTs may also dovetail CSR funds/donations, wherever available.

7.

- It has been observed that states are resorting to least cost tendering which results in poor quality of care and services. Therefore, selection of shelter management agency (SMA) should be done in a transparent manner following the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) system. The prime objective should be how best a shelter can be managed without compromising the standards set out under the SUH guidelines. Care should be taken to engage reputed agencies with past experience in providing care to the vulnerable sections of the society.
- The records and registers, mentioned in the operational guidelines of SUH, should be maintained neatly. These must be checked (*with appendage of signatures*) by the SMC at least once a month.
- The Shelter Management Agency must ensure deployment of mandatory staff for management of shelters. Mandatory staff for shelter management beside general staff, as provided in the guideline, should also include -

- Trained Psychologist-cum-counsellors and Livelihoods expert (full or part time as per the need).
- If there are women residents in the shelter, at least one women staff must be deployed by the SMA.
- Multi-language facilitators should be enlisted/empaneled to communicate with the residents having language issues.
- Hospitals/Doctors/Health worker on roll for weekly visits and during emergency. The shelter must also maintain a verifiable record of such visits.
- The efforts made to reunite the homeless residents with their families, wherever applicable, must be duly recorded by the SMA.

8.

- The Executive Committee (EC) of the ULB must be constituted and operational in the ULB, selected for establishment of model shelter.
- Shelter Management Committee (SMC) with local ward member should be in place to supervise the day-to-day functioning. It must meet regularly; at least once a fortnight.
- Model shelter must have an effective grievance redressal mechanism in a time bound manner.
- The shelter should be linked with nearby college/university, so that the students can engage with the residents, ensure quality of the shelters, and learn community service. This will help develop empathy in the young generation towards the vulnerable population. The report submitted by the students must be examined by the SMC referred to the EC for resolution, if required. A copy of these guidelines must be shared with the Principal of the colleges (linked) to sensitize the student volunteers.
- The Shelter may also be linked with nearby medical college, if available, for regular visit by the students/interns for health check up and educating inmates regarding health and hygiene aspects.
- SMC must ensure that entry for homeless in the shelters is not discouraged, for those not possessing any ID card etc. Rather, the SMA must facilitate preparation of ID/Aadhar for the residents, not possessing these documents.
- The State/ULB must conduct an independent third party quality evaluation of the shelter on a quarterly basis. This should evaluate the functioning of the SMA also.
- A social audit of the shelter must be conducted once a year. A reputed educational institution or similar organization may be entrusted with this.

9.

- Model Shelters will be a space for convergence and provisions of various entitlements of social security, food, education and health care systems. SMA will keep a record in respect of each and every resident in this regard. These include:
 - Identity proof, EPIC;
 - Old age, widows and disability pensions;

- Aayushman Bharat scheme
- BPL cards, PDS ration cards etc.
- Financial inclusion
- ICDS services
- Admission of children to government schools
- Insurance schemes, whichever applicable
- Admission to public hospitals for health care
- Linkage to PMAY
- Free legal aid, wherever applicable

- Model Shelters will provide space and scope for livelihood opportunities for its inmates for their living.
- The homeless persons in shelters should be given priority under various schemes, and government programmes. This include convergence with PMAY for allotment of houses; skill training under DAY-NULM or PMKVY and convergence with the state schemes.



This is regret to inform you that one of the participated agency Named **M.A.Sufian Construction** is technically allowed from your end. But you are well aware that the concern agency submitted **fake balance sheet & turn over document (as his turn over is less as per required criteria)** which was one of the participating criteria for the tender. **Chairman of Beldanga Municipality**, Tender Inviting authority, himself enquired the matter and found that the agency submitted the fake document and he recommends **not to technically allow the concern agency.** Moreover Executive Engineer, M.E. Directorate, Murshidabad Division also recommended **not to allow the concern agency due to submission of fake document. But the concern agency is technically allowed from your end. I don't know what is the reason?**

Submission of any fake document in tender process is a violation of tender norms and rules. In general legal action is being taken against such agency but as a Superintending Engineer of a Govt. Dept, you have allowed him.

Chairman, Beldanga Municipality who is TIA as well as Executive Engineer, M.E. Directorate, Murshidabad Division enquired the allegation against agency **M.A.Sufian Construction** about submission of fake document of balance sheet as well as Turn Over document and they have found the allegation is true against the agency and they both have intimated you the same in their correspondence but you have ignored their observation as well as their recommendation.

My humble request to you that please review your technical recommendation and if you have any doubt about the enquiry report of Chairman as well as Executive Engineer, M.E. Dte, Murshidabad Division, then enquire the matter from yourself but if a fraud agency is technically allowed in spite of submitting fake documents in support of participating criteria, this is a violation of tender rules. As a technical head as well as tender monitoring authority, a responsible as well as right justification for any tender is solicited from your end but in this case your justification is unfortunate or illegal.

I, as one of the participating bidder of the tender, requesting you to look into the matter otherwise, I will take the help of law.

He has also suggested selecting new site that should be 26mX 15m for the proposed SUH building. Area of site that have been selected for the proposed site is 52m X 11m. There is no such vacate land in well communicated area under Kharagpur Municipality. The proposed site is located in a well communicated area.

Under the above circumstances, I request you to set a new plan based on the already selected land that is Mouza-Bulbulchati, JL No-235, Ward no-25. We completed all formalities i.e. land document collection, soil testing etc. If we start to search new site for the proposed SUH building that will take a long time to complete all formalities and the land will be outside of Kharagpur town. I think constructing SUH building outside of town will not be feasible for the target group and not fulfill the objectives of SUH





- The Committee was informed about the following status on progress of SUH against the target of 109 to be operational by 2022.

- Progress of the construction work of SUH was reviewed by the Committee. The suggestions of the Committee are as follows:
 - i) Timely completion of the targeted shelter unit and operationalization thereof keeping in conformity with the year wise target already filed in affidavit by the State government before the Hon'ble Supreme Court should be ensured.
 - ii) The SMMU would develop a project specific monitoring mechanism and initiate regular monitoring involving ME Dte and ULBs.
 - iii) The SMMU would obtain action taken report on progress of shelter units from the respective ULB and ME Dte as well.
 - iv) The SMMU would prepare an action plan for SUH targeted but not yet materialised.
 - v) The SMMU in consultation with ME Dte. would explore alternative design for SUH rather than stereotyped G+3 storied building to avoid lengthy construction process in order to set up the shelters in time as planned. Prefabricated cabin may also be considered if found feasible by the departmental authorities. Idea is to provide shelter to urban homeless in the most expeditious manners in accordance with undertaking before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Agenda 4: Suggested TORs for SLMC, communicated by MoHUA, Govt. of India

TOR along its draft comments were submitted before the Committee. The Committee desired soft copy of the draft comments and TORs be sent over email to the members for further inputs from their end and final copy to be placed and considered in the next meeting.

Agenda 5: Review of Third party Urban Homeless survey report. Presentation by KMC

The Committee reviewed the report of third party survey for identification of Urban Homeless within the State as well as Kolkata Municipal Corporation area. A brief presentation was made before the committee by Manager, SW & UPA, KMC.

After a threadbare discussion the Committee unanimously resolved that:

- i) A further survey is required to be conducted for areas under KMC by such an organization who has enough experience on working with homeless as the present survey figure, conducted following NULM guidelines for homeless population within KMC areas, has drastically reduced in comparison with the homeless population counted under Census 2011. In fact even State wise comparison shown to Committee indicated the maximum reduction in figure is occurring in the State of West Bengal.
 - ii) UD & MA Dept., Govt. of West Bengal would hold a meeting with the State government departments of School Education, L. & L.R., Animal Husbandry under whose possession suitable lands have been identified at different locations under KMC areas for establishment of shelter units. Committee also advised UD&MA Department to hold similar meeting with Kolkata Port Trust authority/ Railway if no response is received from their end against the communication already made to them by the Principal Secretary, UD&MA Department. Further the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court / guidelines passed in this regard may be brought to their attention.
- 

- iii) The design of SUH should be drawn with strict compliance of clause no. 3.1 of NULM guideline. As such the proposed shelter unit with the capacity of 524 inmates under KMC need not be taken up in deviation. On that land feasibility of constructing suitable structure by using Porta Cabin for shelter with other structure for kitchens, toilets may be examined by KMC.
- iv) In order to overcome land constraints within Corporation areas KMC would prepare a map of identified land under different government departments for setting up of shelter units. KMC may utilize land of all abandoned schools within the KMC areas.


Agenda: 6. Review the disbursement of fund for operation & maintenance of shelter to the ULBs.

A detailed presentation was made before the Committee on disbursement of fund for operation & maintenance of shelter to the ULBs. The Committee appreciated the mechanism of release of fund for operation & maintenance of SUH.

Agenda 5: Miscellaneous

The Committee proposed its next meeting at 4pm on 02.04.2019 followed by a field visit at SUH under Howrah Municipal Corporation.





Guidelines for Establishment of Model Shelters

1. Introduction:

Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) is under implementation since 2014. Scheme for Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) is one of its components. At the time of bringing out these guidelines, more than 1000 shelters are operational across the country. It requires no emphasis that the urban homeless survive under numerous challenges like no access to public services such as health, education, food, water and sanitation.

In 2017, the Justice (Retd) Kailash Gambhir Committee, constituted as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, had visited shelters in 13 States/UTs and made certain observations, *inter-alia*, on the quality of shelters. Further, the lack of availability of necessary facilities and absence of basic infrastructure has also been flagged on many occasions by the National Mission Managers and Mission Director during their field visits from time to time.

In order to ensure quality shelters, the Ministry has advised the States/UTs, implementing SUH, to develop two model shelters, one in the capital city and another in a big city. These shelters will act as "*proofs of concept*" showcasing the mandated facilities for urban homeless. Subsequently, the State/UTs will be expected to replicate the same in other shelters.

The word "*proof of concept*" in the previous para does not refer to the physical infrastructure. It has been used more for the quality of care and services to the urban homeless which the shelter for urban homeless component intends to give. The present prevalent practice majority of states to select Shelter Management Agencies based on least cost tendering does not appear to do justice with this object and the same has been noted by the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court which visited shelters across the country.

Therefore, extreme care should be taken while selecting the SMA to ensure that the agency has good past track record and is technically capable of providing intended quality of care to the urban homeless. The nature of human resource available on the roll of agency, the function and technical soundness should be given adequate weightage while selecting the agency as detailed out in the later part of the document.

2. Identification of ULBs:

- States/UTs should identify one or two ULBs as per their size, preferably the state capital and a million plus/big city.

- The ULB (s) identified, must have at least 50 identified urban homeless.
- Names of identified ULBs and the place chosen to establish the shelters need to be communicated to the Ministry.
- After receipt of intimation, the Ministry may depute its representative to visit the same before the establishment of shelter is finalized.
- Work for establishment of model shelter will start after receipt of confirmation from the Ministry.

3. Survey & Identification of Urban Homeless:

Completion of third party survey to identify the homeless and identification of the places of their congregation will be a pre-requisite for selection of a ULB/city. The survey data must also be accepted by the appropriate authority in State/UT. As far as possible, site of the model shelters should provide maximum convenience to the homeless identified.

4. Establishment of Shelter:

- A model shelter can be newly built or refurbished old building.
- If re-furbished building is being used, it must have necessary certification from the concerned agency on its fitness.
- The structure should preferably have environmentally friendly design, rain water harvesting, solar heating/ lighting facilities etc.
- States/UTs may adopt innovative & affordable building designs for construction of model shelters.
- State may draw upon the expertise of the agencies like HUDCO & HPL for design of model shelters and also use pre-fabricated structure for speedy construction of shelters.
- Location should be close to the places of congregation of homeless and their places of livelihoods as far as practicable.
- The shelters should be geo-tagged on city maps so that their location is available on city maps, travel guide maps, online maps, etc. published by various agencies for easy access.
- The addresses of shelter must be displayed on a sign board on the bus stands/ railway stations to guide the homeless persons.

5. Facilities in a Model Shelter:

The SUH guidelines prescribe the list of facilities which are to be made available at every model shelter so as to enable the homeless persons to live with dignity. Model Shelters will incorporate/add facilities from time to time as amended in the guidelines/orders of the Courts for improving their standard of living. The facilities to be ensured are:

- Well ventilated rooms.

- Water arrangement (Regular potable drinking water and other needs) and sanitation.
- Adequate bathing & toilet facilities-if there are women residents, then separate facilities must be provided.
- Standard lighting for shelter.
- Adequate fire protection measure, as per the norms.
- First-aid kit.
- Pest and vector (mosquito) control arrangements.
- At least monthly cleaning of blankets, mattresses and sheets, and maintenance of other services.
- Common kitchen/cooking space, necessary utensils for cooking and serving, cooking gas connections etc. The deficiency in the utensils must be replenished on regular basis.
- Child care facilities for children by linking the shelter to the nearest Anganwadi Center.
- Facilitation for convergence with other services/entitlements.
- Personal lockers for personal storage space
- Common recreation space
- The shelter must be disabled friendly as per the relevant guidelines.
- Arrangement of CCTV camera (s).
- Free food to 10% of residents (old, infirm and those who cannot pay for it) out of O&M cost.
- Provision of computers to capture the details of inmates.

6. Funding :

Funding of all the proposals of model shelters (*newly built, refurbishment, O&M*) should be approved by Project Sanctioning Committee. The State/UTs may also dovetail CSR funds/donations, wherever available.

7. Shelter Management:

- It has been observed that states are resorting to least cost tendering which results in poor quality of care and services. Therefore, selection of shelter management agency (SMA) should be done in a transparent manner following the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) system. The prime objective should be how best a shelter can be managed without compromising the standards set out under the SUH guidelines. Care should be taken to engage reputed agencies with past experience in providing care to the vulnerable sections of the society.
- The records and registers, mentioned in the operational guidelines of SUH, should be maintained neatly. These must be checked (*with appendage of signatures*) by the SMC at least once a month.
- The Shelter Management Agency must ensure deployment of mandatory staff for management of shelters. Mandatory staff for shelter management beside general staff, as provided in the guideline, should also include -

- Trained Psychologist-cum-counsellors and Livelihoods expert (full or part time as per the need).
- If there are women residents in the shelter, at least one women staff must be deployed by the SMA.
- Multi-language facilitators should be enlisted/empaneled to communicate with the residents having language issues.
- Hospitals/Doctors/Health worker on roll for weekly visits and during emergency. The shelter must also maintain a verifiable record of such visits.
- The efforts made to reunite the homeless residents with their families, wherever applicable, must be duly recorded by the SMA.

8. Monitoring:

- The Executive Committee (EC) of the ULB must be constituted and operational in the ULB, selected for establishment of model shelter.
- Shelter Management Committee (SMC) with local ward member should be in place to supervise the day-to-day functioning. It must meet regularly; at least once a fortnight.
- Model shelter must have an effective grievance redressal mechanism in a time bound manner.
- The shelter should be linked with nearby college/university, so that the students can engage with the residents, ensure quality of the shelters, and learn community service. This will help develop empathy in the young generation towards the vulnerable population. The report submitted by the students must be examined by the SMC referred to the EC for resolution, if required. A copy of these guidelines must be shared with the Principal of the colleges (linked) to sensitize the student volunteers.
- The Shelter may also be linked with nearby medical college, if available, for regular visit by the students/interns for health check up and educating inmates regarding health and hygiene aspects.
- SMC must ensure that entry for homeless in the shelters is not discouraged, for those not possessing any ID card etc. Rather, the SMA must facilitate preparation of ID/Aadhar for the residents, not possessing these documents.
- The State/ULB must conduct an independent third party quality evaluation of the shelter on a quarterly basis. This should evaluate the functioning of the SMA also.
- A social audit of the shelter must be conducted once a year. A reputed educational institution or similar organization may be entrusted with this.

9. Convergence:

- Model Shelters will be a space for convergence and provisions of various entitlements of social security, food, education and health care systems. SMA will keep a record in respect of each and every resident in this regard. These include:
 - Identity proof, EPIC;
 - Old age, widows and disability pensions;

- Aayushman Bharat scheme
 - BPL cards, PDS ration cards etc.
 - Financial inclusion
 - ICDS services
 - Admission of children to government schools
 - Insurance schemes, whichever applicable
 - Admission to public hospitals for health care
 - Linkage to PMAY
 - Free legal aid, wherever applicable
-
- Model Shelters will provide space and scope for livelihood opportunities for its inmates for their living.
 - The homeless persons in shelters should be given priority under various schemes, and government programmes. This include convergence with PMAY for allotment of houses; skill training under DAY-NULM or PMKVY and convergence with the state schemes.



Special Health Check up cum screening test camp for the inmates of shelters under the scheme Shelter for Urban Homeless in convergence with Urban Primary Health Centre under NUHM in different ULBs in West Bengal

A Special Health Check up cum screening test camp for the inmates of shelters under the scheme Shelter for Urban Homeless in convergence with Urban Primary Health Centre under NUHM was arranged in different ULBs on 17.08.2018 in West Bengal. West Bengal State Urban Livelihoods Mission decided to conduct this free health check up cum 'screen test camp as per suggestion of State Level Monitoring Committee of SUH. In urban area different Urban Primary Health Centers are providing the basic health services to the urban people. Considering the guidelines of SUH it has been decided to converge both the programme in ULB level to provide better health check up services to inmates of SUH. Such health camps will be organized on regular basis.

Medical officers from the UPHC provided the health check up services in this camp. Free medicines were provided to the inmates of SUH. Special attention was given for the persons who are old, infirm or sick. Female inmates and their dependent children were also covered under this health check up camp. ULB wise report in details is given below:

SUH at Durgapur Corporation: Special health check up cum screening test camp has been arranged on the above specified date at 'ABHAYASRAM', Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) at Durgapur. Total 23 inmates of SUH have been covered under this special health check up camp. Medical Officer & concerned staff of Urban Primary Health Centre and staff of City Mission Management Unit, NULM jointly conducted this camp. Specified tests (i.e. Hemoglobin, LP, Blood Sugar, Renal Profile, Blood group test, ECG) have been done in this camp for the inmates of SUH. Dear Shri Gupta,

The Shelter for Urban Homeless as a component of DAY-NULM has been under implementation since September 2013. Substantial progress has been made towards establishment of shelters but lot still remains to be done. The particulars of all the operational shelters are available in public domain on DAY-NULM website. The quality aspect of shelters, i.e. establishment of shelters as per operational guidelines, therefore, needs to be addressed.

2. In this connection, I would like to draw your attention to the previous references, from the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, dated 21st October 2016, 22nd December 2016 and 9th March 2017 for development of model shelters. We have, however, not got any feedback from your State/UT in the matter.

3. In view of the above, you are it is advised to develop two model shelters in your State/UT, preferably in state capital and a million plus city. These model shelters should be strictly in spirit of the SUH operational guidelines and also incorporating directions given by Hon'ble Supreme Court from time to time. You will appreciate that these model shelters will provide opportunity to the persons dealing with shelters, whether officials or shelter management staff, to replicate the same at other places.

4. For developing the model shelters you may ensure that third party survey of urban homeless is completed in the ULB to identify the number of urban homeless and planning of shelters in that area. The ULB must, inter-alia, constitute an Executive Committee, Shelter Management Committee consisting of specified representatives. The capacity building initiatives for Shelter Management Committee must be in place along with mechanism for linkage with entitlements, convergence with other government schemes and corporate/civil society initiatives and conducting of social audit of shelters.

5. I am looking forward for an urgent response from you in this regard, latest by 24th September, 2018.

Agenda: Present progress of ongoing work of SUH & Tentative date of completion of ongoing project.

Deputy Director, SUDA reviewed the progress of SUH ULB wise and discussed about the progress with ULB representatives. A detail deliberation was made in the meeting regarding the civil construction work, Electrification work & procurement of furniture & utensils. Each ULB informed about their status of work & tentative time line of completion of work as fixed by the ULBs.

Howrah Municipal Corporation: It was informed by the Executive Engineer, HMC that, due to repeated tender for Electrical Work, it was not started till now. Now 4th call of Tender & it will be opened on 23.07.2018 and after finalization of L1 bidder it will be started. It was also informed by him a tentative date is finalized by the Corporation for inauguration of completed SUH. Deputy Director, SUDA suggested to complete the work within the due time & also asked about the progress of another SUH. It was informed by the CMM that alternative land was identified & feasibility report preparation is under process. Further four lands were identified by the Corporation for SUH and it is under consideration of Corporation.

Berhampore Municipality: It was informed by the ULB that, the construction work of SUH is in progress and electrical work Tender will be floated soon after vetting from KMDA. It was also informed that UC will be submitted by the ULB by 20.07.2018

Barrackpore Municipality: It appears in the meeting that no representative is present from the ULB. Executive Engineer MED informed about the progress of the work at Barrackpore. It was also informed that the progress of work 50% and it will be made operational by January 2019.

Chandernagar Corporation: It was informed by the representative of ULB that Tender process of Electrical work will be completed soon and tentative date of completion of SUH was fixed by the Corporation is August, 2018. Already review meeting was done at ULB level for monitoring of progress of work.

Halisahar Municipality: It was informed by the representative of municipality that the civil work is under process and electrical work tender will be initiated soon. It is expected that the construction work will be completed by March, 2019 and it will be made operational.

Asansol Corporation: It appears in the meeting no representative is present from the ULB. Executive Engineer MED informed about the progress of the work at Asansol. It was also informed that progress of work at Jamuria is 75%, at Raniganj 30% and at Kultidue to selection of alternative land work was started behind the schedule and 10 % in progress. It was suggested by the Deputy Director to emphasise the work and to submit the updated UC. Deputy Director, SUDA directed to communicate with the Corporation to know about the absence of representatives from the concerned ULB.

Bhatpara Municipality: It was informed by the ULB that work order issued on May, 2018 due to poor site condition work was not started till now and recently site was developed by sand filling and work will be started by this week. It is expected that the work will be completed by March, 2019. It was suggested by the Deputy Director, SUDA to initiate the work as early as possible as the project was sanctioned on 2017.

Bankura Municipality: It was informed by the representative of ULB and Executive Engineer, MED that due to repeated change of site condition and detailed design & drawing work is delayed, now 15 % work has been done. Now piling work is completed. It was also informed that it is expected the work will be completed by March, 2019.

Habra Municipality: It was informed by the representative of municipality that the civil work is under process (50%) and electrical work tender will be initiated soon. It is expected that the construction work completed by December, 2018 and it will be made operational.

Uttarpara- kotrang Municipality: It was informed by the ULB official due to some local problem progress of work is very slow and it is expected it will be resolved shortly. Now the progress of the work is 30%.

Titagarh: It was informed by the ULB official that Tender was floated but due to non availability of eligible bidder and it was cancelled. Now it is 2 nd call of Tender and Technical Bid opened. Deputy Director, SUDA requested to expedite the work.

Rajpur- Sonarpur: It was informed by the ULB official that construction work is in under progress and it is expected that it will be completed by December, 2018. Deputy Director, SUDA requested to submit the part UC of SUH.

Mahestala: It was informed by the ULB official that construction work is in under progress and it is expected that it will be completed by December, 2018.

Tamralipta: It was informed by the ULB official that the construction work now is at plinth level and it is under process. Deputy Director, SUDA requested to expedite the work and to complete the work on scheduled time.

Arambag: It was informed by the ULB official that finishing work is going on and it is expected that the work will be completed on Aug, 2018. The shelter unit will be made functional by Oct, 2018.

North Dum Dum: It was informed by the ULB official that Tender was floated but due to Technical reason and further 2 calls were cancelled due to insufficient number of eligible bidder. On 21.07.2018 Technical bid will be opened.

Barasat: It was informed by the ULB official due to some local problem the work is not started till now and it is expected that the work will be started soon. Deputy Director, SUDA suggested to resolve the issue at the earliest as the shelter unit was sanctioned one year ago.

Santipur: It was informed by the ULB official due to poor bearing capacity of soil, identified land of SUH has been changed. New land has been identified and soil test report with relevant documents will be sent to the Director, SUDA at the earliest.

Jiaganj-Ajimganj: It appears in the meeting no representative is present from the ULB. Executive Engineer MED informed about the progress of the work. Now progress of the work is 30%.

Balurghat: It was informed by the ULB official that construction work is going on (50%) and it is expected that the work will be completed on Dec, 2018.

Tarakeswar: It was informed by the ULB official that construction work is going on (40%) and it is expected that the work will be completed on Dec, 2018. Deputy Director, SUDA requested to submit the subsequent UC of SUH.

Madhyamgram: It was informed by the ULB official that construction work is going on (40%) as the SUH building is converged with a market complex on ground floor therefore after completion of work at ground floor rest part of the building will be constructed and it is expected that it will be completed by March, 2019.

Dum Dum: It was informed by the ULB official that detailed design drawing is prepared and estimate preparation is under process and Tender will be floated after approval of the same. Deputy Director, SUDA requested to complete the same & to float the Tender at the earliest to the ULB officials.

Naihati: It was informed by the ULB official that detailed design drawing was approved by SE, MED and Tender will be floated soon.

Beldanga: It was informed by the ULB official that soil test has been done and report will be submitted soon to EE, MED for preparation of detailed design & drawing. Deputy Director, SUDA suggested to expedite the process for early completion.

Kaliyaganj: It was informed by the ULB official that soil test has been done and report will be submitted soon to EE, MED for preparation of detailed design & drawing. Deputy Director, SUDA suggested to expedite the process for early completion.



The Court : The petitioner in this WP under art.226 of the Constitution of India dated February 7, 2013 is seeking the following principal relief:-

"a) A writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents and their men and agents and his offices to show cause as to why they shall not be directed to give permission to 18 hawkers as mentioned in paragraph 6 to this petition forthwith."

Producing the policy decisions of the State Government and the Central Government, advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the authority concerned of the Corporation ought to have considered the petitioner's request for permission to carry on the occupation of a hawker from the place particulars whereof have been given in the WP.

Mr Government Pleader appearing for the Corporation has submitted as follows. Particulars of all the hawkers were collected from the place wherefrom the petitioner wants to carry on the occupation of a hawker. Since the authority did not find the petitioner carrying on the

occupation of a hawker from the place, his request for permission was not considered. But then, keeping in mind the question of the petitioner's livelihood and the Court's observations made over the course of hearing, the authority concerned of the Corporation will make an inquiry for ascertaining whether the petitioner is entitled to permission to carry on the occupation of a hawker from the place in question.

In view of the above-noted situation, I dispose of the WP ordering as follows. The authority concerned of the Corporation shall make an inquiry for ascertaining whether the petitioner can be permitted to carry on the occupation of a hawker from the place particulars whereof have been given in the WP, and after making inquiry he shall give a decision after hearing the petitioner. Compliance within six weeks from the date this order is served. No costs. Certified xerox.

of 2013 was presented had been unilaterally altered and the names of 3 persons. Mahesh Singh, Madheb Bera and Rabindra Bera were included therein as hawkers in place of Amarnath Mahato, Somnath Bera and Surinder Singh. Although the said Zainul Haque Khan claimed that no stall had been allotted to him, the order records allotment of stall no.55 to him which he had suppressed before the Court. It was further found that although it was the policy of the Corporation to allot stall to only one member of a family, the said Zainul Haque Khan had claimed allotment in favour of 3 of his sons, namely Aftab Alam, Mehtab Alam and Mumtaz Alam. The order also records that in the hearing, the said Zainul Haque Khan verbally asked the Corporation officers to empower him for re-allotment of the 75 stalls in his own manner to avoid any further problem.

On the basis of the aforesaid findings, the deputy chief engineer recorded that the said Zainul Haque Khan had steered the entire matter in his personal interest and ill motive and that he had made an attempt to take control of the hawkers of the entire beautified stretch by the side of ^{the river} Hooghly from Princep Ghat to Bajekadamtala Ghat as well as to introduce certain persons as hawkers, who are not genuine hawkers, in an unauthorized way. Ultimately, it was held that the persons who were staking claim for allotment of stalls were not eligible hawkers and, therefore, not entitled to be allotted any such stall.

Having heard Mr. Maity, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Mukherjee, learned advocate appearing for the Corporation and regard being had to the nature of the order impugned, this Bench is of the considered view that the writ
