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PREFACE

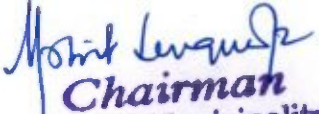
Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) aims at Providing Housing for All (HFA) by 2022 when the Nation Complete 75 years of its independence.

The urban homeless persons contribute to the economy of the cities and thus the Nation as cheap labour in the informal sector; yet they live with no shelter or social security . The urban homeless service with many challenges like no access to elementary Public Services such as health, education, food, water and sanitation. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) also aims at providing a pucca house to every family with water connection, toilet facilities, 24 X 7 electricity supply and access.

The Mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through "In Situ" Slum Redevelopment, Affordable Housing through credit linked subsidy, Affordable Housing in partnership and subsidy for beneficiary led individual house. Under the mission, beneficiaries can take advantage under one component only.

Total beneficiaries of the scheme are 15510 nos from 86 nos slum and 5 nos of Non Slum projected for the year 2015-16 .

Total cost of the project is **Rs. 4631.00 lakhs** as per relevant department & P.W.D. schedule of rates.

Introductory Note by Chairman

Raiganj Municipality is a 64 years old Municipality in Uttar Dinajpur District of West Bengal. We had got the HFA-Urban Project on last 28th Sept, 2015. In the mean time we had completed the selection of surveyors, enumerators for the Housing Demand Survey, training of that Surveyor & Supervisors, sensitisation workshop held on 22-10-2015 and for the Councillors through B.O.C meeting dated-28.9.2015. For wide circulation we had done a miking, mass awareness through Ward Committee meeting, SHG members, PA to Councillor and respective councillor in all wards of our area. The demand survey (field level) had started on last-23.10.15 and completed on-10.10.15. The data entry process had already done in the SUDA prepared software compilation package. Now we prepare the Draft HFAPoA for Raiganj Town which had gating for the approval of BOC vide meeting dated-29.10.2015. The Nodal Officer of this Mission in our ULB is the Town Project Officer under the supervision of Executive Officer. The designated SAE for this Mission is SAE-Lakhikanta Howladar will assist the every technicalities as desired by the SUDA and M.A. Department. Hope we shall successfully implement this mission by 2022 with help of ULB staff, Councillors, ward committees, SUDA, PMU & MED and department of Municipal affairs.



Raiganj is a small but an important urban centre in the North Bengal. Raiganj possesses great historical importance that was discovered time to time by the researchers. Remnants of the history can still be seen all over the place in a dilapidated condition. It is one of the oldest Municipalities in the district and is 64 years old now.

Raiganj Municipality with the active cooperation of citizen for last so many years has grown up as capable and robust institute for effective service delivery and better governance. During these years the shape and the socio-cultural atmosphere of the Municipality has changed to unimaginable extent.

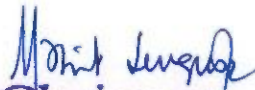

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1. Situation assessment for HFAPoA

1.1 Background

"Housing for All" Mission for urban area will be implemented during 2015-2022 and this Mission will provide central assistance to implementing agencies through States and UTs for providing houses to all eligible families/beneficiaries by 2022.

Mission will be implemented as Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) except for the component 1.2 of credit linked subsidy which will be implemented as a Central Sector Scheme.

A beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife, unmarried sons and/or unmarried daughters. 1.3 The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission.

States/UTs, at their discretion, may decide a cut-off date on which beneficiaries need to be resident 1.4 of that urban area for being eligible to take benefits under the scheme. Mission with all its component has become effective from the date 17.06.2015 and will be 1.5 implemented upto 31.03.2022.

All 4041 statutory towns as per Census 2011 with focus on 500 Class I cities would be covered in three phases as follows:

Phase I (April 2015 - March 2017) to cover 100 Cities selected from States/UTs as • per their willingness.

Phase II (April 2017 - March 2019) to cover additional 200 Cities•

Phase III (April 2019 - March 2022) to cover all other remaining Cities•

Ministry, however, will have flexibility regarding inclusion of additional cities in earlier phases in case there is a resource backed demand from States/UTs.

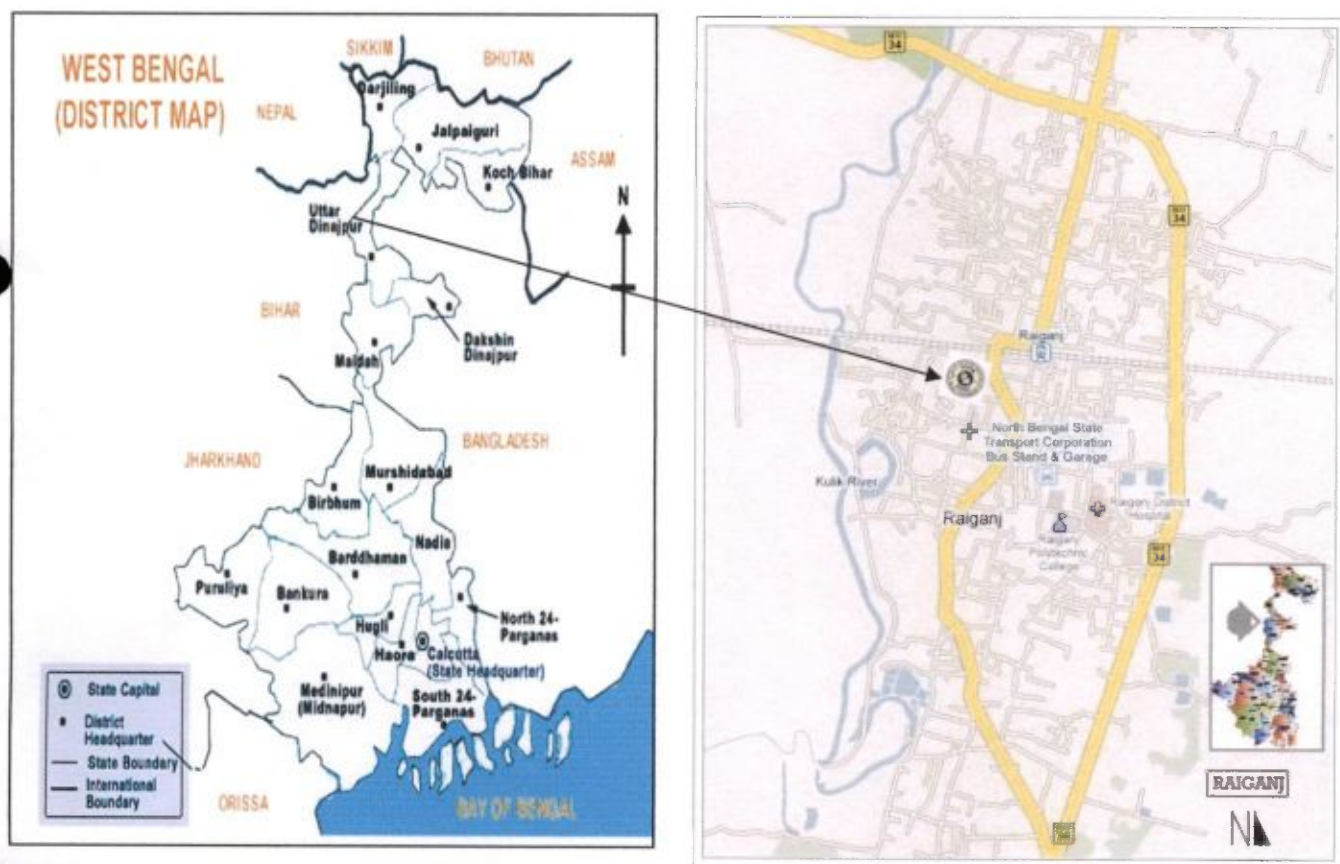
As per the guideline of HFA Mission, Raiganj ULB is also entitled for this Mission. We had attended the state level workshop as organized by SUDA on last 13.9.2015 after that we had started the HFAPoA preparation process in our ULB. As per 2011 CENSUS among the total 183682 population the slum population is 75696 and the BPL population is 75696 in Raiganj Municipal area. As per SECC the no. of kuccha/semi kuccha household is 15892 & as per USHA survey (2011) the no. Of kuccha /semi kuccha household in slums are 9776. Under IHSDP total 2000 households had provided the dwelling units in 1st phase up-to-2015. Till date total 178 no.s dwelling units had provided under HUP phase-I & II project (state project) and 190 dwelling unit under Gitanjali project (state project). Due to increasing migrant population in slum and non-slum areas the demand for dwelling units among the LIG is also raising in our area. Increasing housing demand is also caused due to the rapid urbanisation in the fringe area of the town like, ward-, 5, 14, 15, 16, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 etc. HFA Mission gives us the opportunity to bridge the

gap in between supply and demand of the LIG housing to those, who have no pucca dwelling units for their family under this municipal jurisdiction area.

1.3. City Profile and Overview

Raiganj is a prominent urban local body in the district of Uttar Dinajpur – Uttar Dinajpur being one of the Northern districts of West Bengal. Presently the Municipality consists of 25 wards covering an area of 10.76 Sq. K.Ms with a population of 183682 persons (as per CENSUS-2011).

The town is situated at a distance of 400 km from the state capital Kolkata and is connected by means of National Highway 34 and B.G line by rail.

The town Raiganj is located in the lower part of North Bengal. Raiganj on the bank of the River Kulik serve as the District Headquarter of Uttar Dinajpur where the second largest bird sanctuary in Asia is situated. The town is located on the National Highway No.34 and is about 75 km to the North of Malda and about 215 km south of Siliguri. To the East the town is linked with another important town Kaliaganj, located adjacent to Bangladesh at a distance of 20 km. The western part of the town is linked with Kathiwar in Bihar, by a Broad Gauge line and also capital Kolkata.

History

The town of Raiganj situated in the narrow strip which joins the Northern and Southern portion of the state of West Bengal, has come up in prominence as a result of partition of India. This town in pre-partition was a small village dependent upon the larger urban centres. The partition of Bengal has suddenly left this town on its own. Other such villages have either shifted their dependence to other town in the state of West Bengal or have started growing themselves. The town of Raiganj belongs to other category. It was merely a mouja under Dinajpur Maharaja Administration and was Bandar meaning a river based held post of merchantile commodities from far and near village. In pre-independence days this was rather a neglected area. In 1951 immediately after independence the town barely had a population of 17000 persons. Since then this town has grown up faster.



Kulik Bird Sanctuary: Raiganj is the District town of Uttar Dinajpur District of West Bengal. Raiganj(Kulik) Bird Sanctuary is the second largest bird sanctuary in Asia. Several types of migratory birds arrives here each year from South Asian countries and coastal regions. The forest, water bodies and the river attract the migratory birds like Open Bill Stork, Night heron, cormorant, little cormorant & Egrets. Local birds like dove, bulbul, sparrow, king fisher, woodpeckers, owl, duck & cuckoo, can also be seen in large numbers. The migratory birds arrive from end of May to 1st week of July and depart from mid December to end of January. The nesting time is from July to August & egg laying from August to September. The flying training to the young ones is the best time to observe the birds, around October to November. No. of Migratory Birds : year 2004=76,208, year 2003=81,384, year 2002=77,012 2001=76,548, year 2000=59388. The vast and beautiful swamp land on the bank of a small river named Kulik is added attraction. Very few people knows about this place. But from last few years number of tourist is increasing and becoming famous. The tourists who are visiting Darjeeling should come here for once.

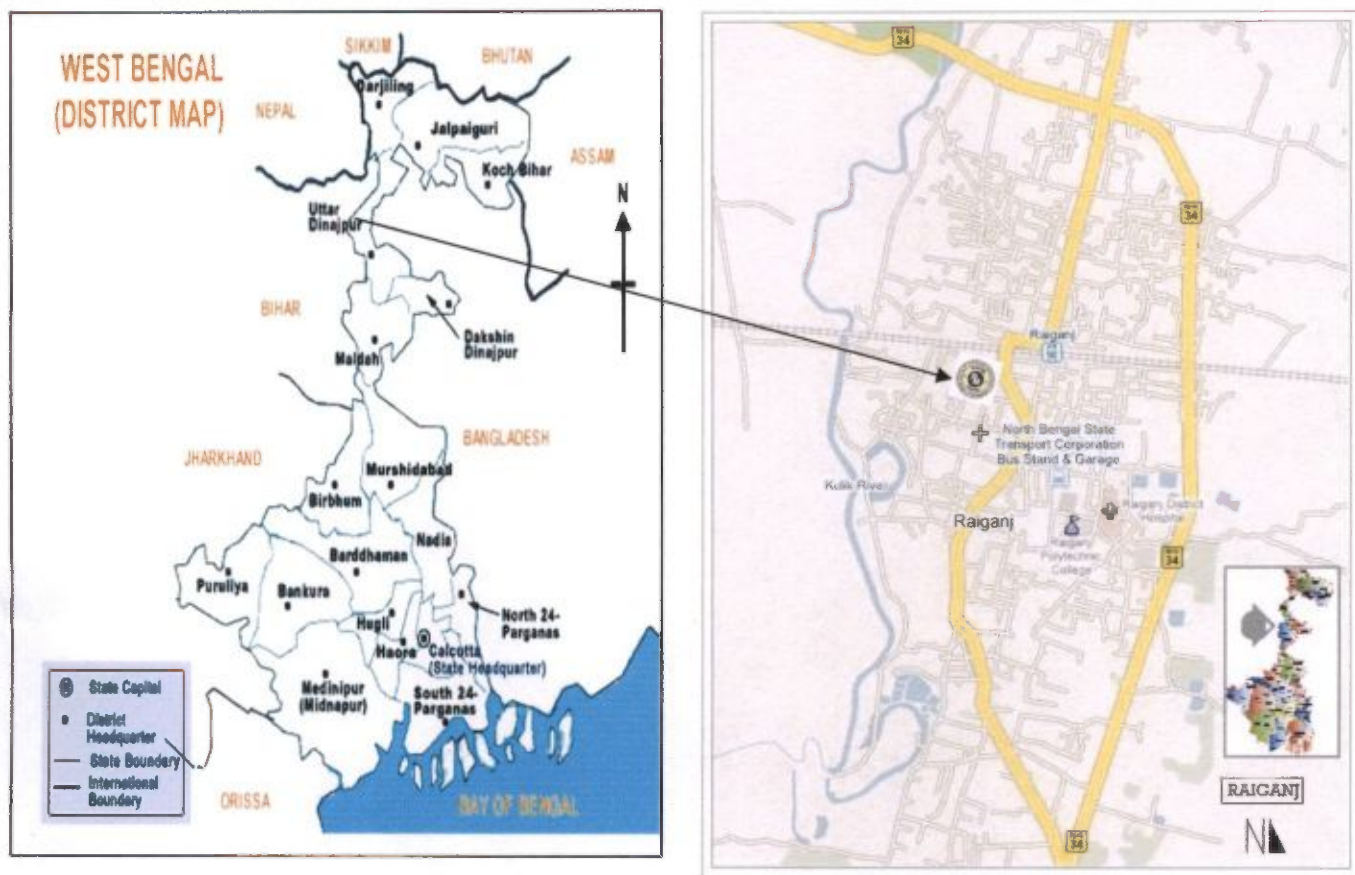

ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

Though agriculture was once a major economic activity, Raiganj today is totally service sector oriented economy along with business as an unorganized informal sector. People living in Raiganj Municipal area, work in the neighboring areas and in Kolkata. Industries are almost nonexistent except a few small-scale industries mainly plastic factories. Once Raiganj was a center of jute industry but due to the change in the course of river it lost all its glory and importance. In the Raiganj municipality small businesses are growing at a fast pace within the municipal area and constitutes a major economic base of the municipality. Population is rising at a very high speed resulting in higher and higher density of population. Existence of only seven small-scale industries implies that the municipality has to be run on taxes collected from the middle class residents, most of whom are service persons. Very little taxes are collected from the slums and poor colonies. So, it is very difficult to improve this municipal area only on the basis of municipal taxes. Raiganj Municipality now comprehends the situation and plans to supplement this revenue through other sources.

Housing and Physical Infrastructure profile

Housing profile

Every four in hundred households do not have a shelter to sleep at night in the district of Uttar Dinajpur and a further 50% of the households live in a house/hut with only one room. In context of Raiganj, 45% of households live in pucca or partially pucca houses¹. Housing condition in its slums is not in good shape as 80% houses are either Katcha or semi-pucca. Considering the above, municipality has already initiated construction of affordable houses in 101 slums spread over 25 wards on a piecemeal basis leveraging IHSDP scheme in a phased manner. In the First phase (2007-2012) total 2000 houses were constructed in 86 no of slums spread over 25 no of wards. Infrastructure projects like Road, Drain and pipeline work were also targeted in some of the slums.

The following table gives Municipality wise construction of urban poor houses planned during 2007-08 till date under IHSDP, Gitanjali and HUP.
