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1. Situation assessment for HFAPoA

1.1 Background

“Housing for All” Mission for urban area will be implemented during 2015-2022 and this 1.1 Mission will provide central assistance to implementing agencies through States and UTs for providing houses to all eligible families/beneficiaries by 2022.

Mission will be implemented as Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) except for the component 1.2 of credit linked subsidy which will be implemented as a Central Sector Scheme.

A beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife, unmarried sons and/or unmarried daughters. The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission.

States/UTs, at their discretion, may decide a cut-off date on which beneficiaries need to be resident of that urban area for being eligible to take benefits under the scheme. Mission with all its component has become effective from the date 17.06.2015 and will be implemented upto 31.03.2022.

1.2 Approach and Methodology

The HFAPoA for Rampurhat Municipality has been prepared according to the guidelines provided by Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India. Overall approach adopted throughout the preparation of this HFAPoA has been based on three key principles, Stakeholders meeting, Involvement of the community, Co-ordination.

Methodology followed for preparation of HFAPoA is as follows-

- a) Demand survey is the first and foremost thing to for preparation of HFAPoA. So an initiative for Demand Assessment survey is being taken.
- b) For this survey work first of all an orientation programme was arranged with the Municipal elected representatives.
- c) Another orientation programme was arranged for the supervisors and enumerators.
- d) After these orientation programmes the Demand Survey was conducted.
- e) Data entry works of the filled-in survey forms was carried out.
- f) Analysis of the survey data.
- g) The given required formats were filled up.
- h) A meeting with the elected representatives about the preparation of the HFAPoA.
- i) Finalisation of HFAPoA report.

1.2.1 Stakeholders Consultative Workshop / Meetings

For the successful preparation and detail understanding of HFAPoA all of the stakeholders including Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation (MoHUPA), GoI and SUDA, GoWB organized a number of workshops at the state level as well as at the Municipal level also. A detail capacity building workshop was organized at the ULB level, and the photographs of this workshop can be seen below.

Housing Typologies

According to census 2011 the total population of Rampurhat Municipal area is 57891. From the findings of USHA survey it is noticed that a total of 6868 nos. of household lives in slum area. Out of these slum households 3964 nos. of households lives in kutcha houses whereas 744 nos. of households lives in semi-pucca houses. From the demand survey of HFA for the preparation of HFAPoA it is found that 5697 nos. of household will be cover under this project out of which 5485 houses will be constructed through “Beneficiary-led-Construction” and 212 houses will be construct through “Credit linked subsidy to individual beneficiaries”.

Water Supply

At present the Municipality draws water only from underground tube wells. The supply is intermittent having 2 times supply period in the morning from 6.0 A.M to 9.0 A.M. and in the afternoon from 4 P.M to 7.P.M. Total supply made during this six hour period is reported to be 320,000 gallons a day. Due to scarcity of water quite a few families have their own wells. The source of supply is the 9 nos of Tube wells (out of which 1 no are standby), situated at different places within Municipality and Panchyat area (at Jhanjhanania). There is only one OHR at Nischintapur Headworks site. The tube wells were sunk by the state Public Health Engg. Directorate.

Drainage and Sanitation

Socio Economic data analysis reveals that 40.85% reported that drainage system does not exist. 94.92% reported that drains are not covered. 26.77% reported that drains are not connected with major drainage channels. Frequency of cleaning of drains reported, Weekly 39.96%, Monthly 11.95%, Every 2 months 4.03%, Every 3 months 6.51% and not done 35%. Problems of drains mainly cited as Slope is not proper 11.43% and Garbage accumulation in drains 57.89%.

Socio Economic survey analysis reveals that 25.85% HHS are not having sanitation facilities at their HHs. Those 74.15% having the facility are having Pour flush pit latrine - 12.25%, Septic tank - 77.61 %, Well toilet- 8.76% and Others- 12.75%. Only 1.59% HHs use community toilet and it has been reported that 55.67% HHs are having bathing place/ bathroom with toilet. Which implies that about 40% people of Rampurhat defecates in open which is a major environmental and health concern to the municipality.

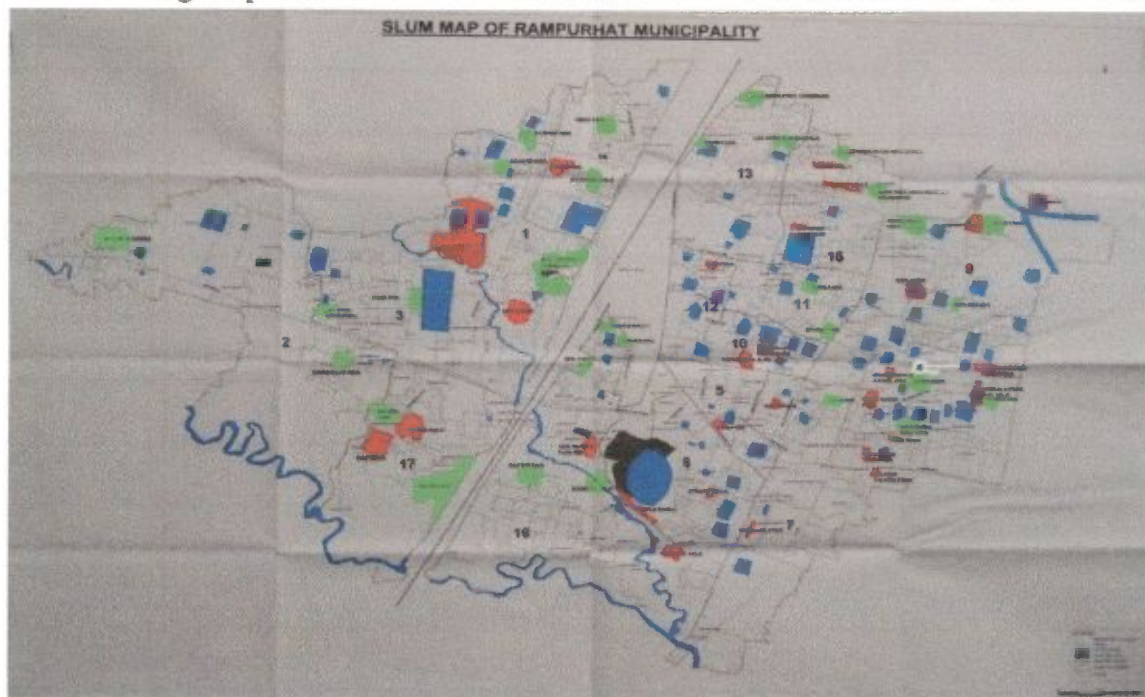
Solid Waste Management

As an inevitable consequence of growing population and urban lifestyle, use of disposable items, a large portion of which is non-biodegradable, is increasing. Thus management of solid waste to keep out city clean and at the same time to make ourselves able to live a healthy life has become a serious problem and Rampurhat municipal area is not an exception to that. As per standard, generation of solid waste in urban areas is 0.3-0.5 kg/capita/day and thus considering total population strength of 50,613 persons (2001 census), the total quantity of solid waste should be 25,306 kgs i.e., 25.306 ton/day. According to municipal records, solid waste generated in Rampurhat municipal area is 1200 cft (48 MT)- 1300 (52 MT) cft.

1.5. Assessment of Present Status of Slums

Rampurhat Municipality has a total of 57 slums spread across all the 18 wards (till 2014 it was 17 wards, from 2015 it is now 18 wards) of the municipality. The population of Rampurhat is 57891(census 2011) of which number of population residing in slums are 21508. According to USHA survey total slum household is 7354. Out of these slum households 3964 nos. of households lives in kutchha houses whereas 744 nos. of households lives in semi-pucca houses.

Town Features

Rampurhat Municipality established on 11th May 1950, is a Sub-Divisional Town in the North-East corner of District Birbhum. This town has bifurcated by the Burdwan-Sahebgang Loop line under Eastern Railway. The Birbhum district lies between 23° 32'30"N and 24° 35'WN latitude and 88° 01'40"E and 87° 05'25" longitudes and the Rampurhat lies on 24.2 °N latitude and 88.1°E longitude. Rampurhat at about 275 km. From state capital 'KOLKATA' is situated on the important National High way connecting both N.H-2 (Kolkata-Delhi Road) and N.H-31 (Delhi-Assam Road) on the Eastern Railway (Calcutta –Assam main line). Adjacent state of Rampurhat is Jharkhand and districts are Burdwan, Murshidabad. It is 175 km far from district head quarter of Burdwan and 100 km. From district head quarter of Murshidabad. The nearest important districts are Burdwan (175km), Durgapur (135 km, a famous industrial belt in India) , Asansol (175 km, a coal mine, Eastern-Coldfield) area. Murshidabad, a famous place for battle between Nabab Sirajodaula and British Soldiers, Dumka, the hq. Of Dumka district of Jharkhand State and Bolpur-Shanteniketan enriched with Visva-Bharati University created by Kabiguru R.N.Tagore.. At present the area of this town is 16.23 sq. Km and Municipal area is divided into 18 (Previously it was 17 wards and from 2015 after delimitation it is now 18 wards) municipal wards for administrative purposes.

ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARIES

The Town is bounded by Rampurhat in West, Sainthia in East, Dumka of Jharkhand in South and –in North.

Linkages of Rail, Road:

The town is well connected with its hinterland by Roads. It is situated on a National Highway connecting two National Highway i.e. NH-2 & NH-31 .The Bar-howrah loop line and Howrah-Assam main line of the Eastern and North Frontier Railway passes through this district and Rampurhat is an important railway station. The principal means of communication of the town and motor tracks, buses, taxies, two-wheeler, cycle and rickshaws etc. Of late a network of bus services has opened a new horizon. Rampurhat is connected with different Major District Roads and Village Roads of total length of about 400 km within the District.

Places of interest

Rampurhat is enriched in cultural heritage. The tourist attraction for Tarapith which contain an important hindu temple and famous for the great devotee 'Bamakhepa'. It is also recognised as 'Shaktipith' as per Hindu belief. The river Dwarka flows by this side. Another attraction for Hindu devotees 'Nalateswari Mandir' situated at Nalhati, 15 K.M. away from the town. It is tribal

inhabitant area famous for Dokra Art and docra industries. Tourists come to visit the forest some important old temples. It is also allied tourists spot of Bolpur-Shantiniketan.

Housing and Physical Infrastructure profile

Housing profile

The individual houses in the slum pockets are temporary in nature, without having a permanent roof structure. Proper sanitary facilities are absent which not only endangers the individual health, but also the environmental conditions of the slum and consequently the town area in general. To upgrade the standard of life of slum dwellers, proper housing with sanitation facility is the crying needs of the present days a total of 603 Nos. houses have been proposed for construction under IHSDP Programme.

Land Use

Rampurhat Municipality basically is a residential town with some agricultural activity and small industries activities are practiced within and around the municipal boundary. Rampurhat Municipality is a residential area since it occupies 57. 65% of land cover, this zone is followed by agriculture and water bodies zone which cover 27. 09% of cover, remaining land cover 10.74% is occupied by the transport network which includes road and railways, 0.02% is covered by industrial area, 1.46% is occupied by public and semi public utility area and 1.29% is occupied by commercial area.

HFAPoA and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Housing for All)

To give pucca house for every family is currently on the global agenda. One of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) is to 'achieve significant improvement in the lives of slum dwellers, by 2022'. Similar goals are set forth by Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana within year 2022, to create pucca house for every family.

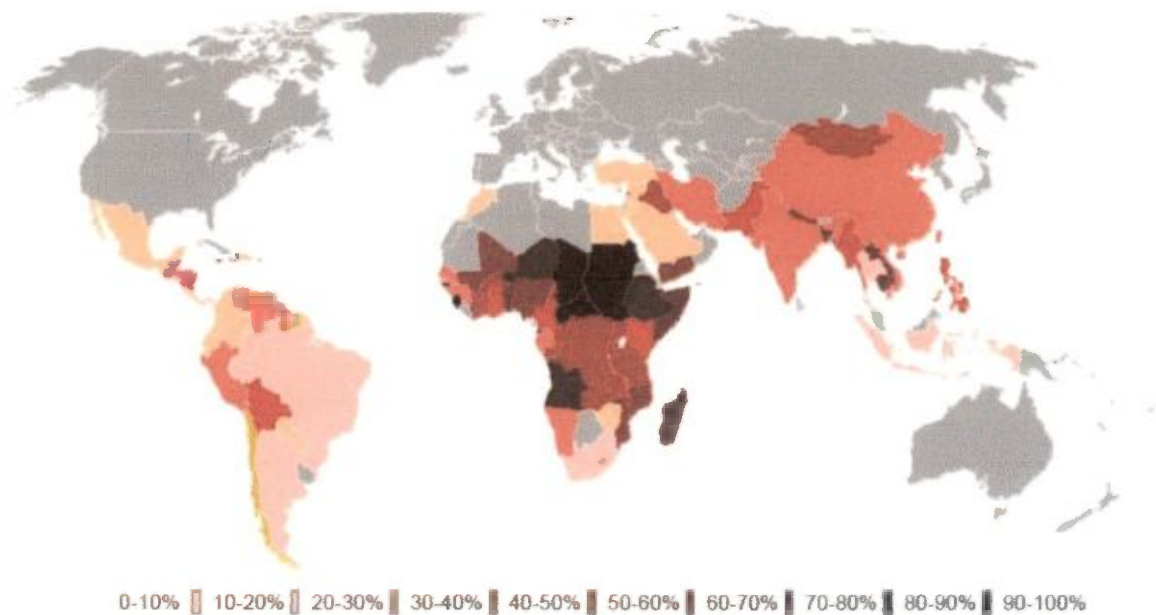
ULB undertake a demand survey through suitable means for assessing the actual demand of housing. While validating demand survey, Cities consider possible temporary migration from rural areas to the city just to take advantage of housing scheme and exclude such migrants from list of beneficiaries. On the basis of demand survey and other available data, cities prepare Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA). HFAPoA contain the demand of housing by eligible beneficiaries in the city along with the interventions selected out of four verticals. The information regarding beneficiaries is collected by ULB in suitable. While preparing HFAPoA, ULB and Implementing Agencies also consider the affordable housing stock already available in the city as Census data suggests that large number of houses are vacant.

Bank account number and Aadhaar number/Voter ID card/any other unique identification details of intended beneficiaries or a certificate of house ownership from Revenue Authority of beneficiary's native district integrate in the data base of HFAPoA for avoiding duplication of benefit to one individual family. Beneficiaries is validated by ULBs thereby ensuring their eligibility at the time of preparation of the projects and approval of projects.

On the basis of HFAPoA, States/Cities subsequently prepare the Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) dividing the task upto 2022 in view of the availability of resources and priority. For larger cities, HFAPoA and AIPs is prepared at sub-city (ward/zone etc.) level with the approval of concerned State/UT Government. The result of demand survey, draft HFAPoA and draft AIP is discussed with the local representatives including MLAs and MPs of that area so that their views are adequately factored in while finalising the plans and beneficiary list.

Cities which have already prepared Slum Free City Plan of Action (SFCPoA) or any other housing plan with data on housing, utilise the existing plan and data for preparing "Housing for All Plan of Action" (HFAPoA). Houses constructed under various schemes should be accounted for while preparing HFAPoA.

Urban Population Living in Slums and the Indian Scenario (source: UN-HABITAT)



The preparation of HFAPoA broadly involve Slum Development/Rehabilitation Plans based on

- a. Survey of all slums – notified and non-notified;
- b. Mapping of slums using the state-of-art technology;
- c. Integration of geo-spatial and socio-economic data; and
- d. Identification of development model proposed for each slum.

1. Base maps to an appropriate scale would be a pre-requisite for the preparation of Slum Development Plan/Slum-free City Plan. States/UTs may need to proceed in the following steps for the preparation of Slum-free City Plans.
2. Securing CARTOSAT II/latest satellite images from NRSC/ISRO and preparation of base maps for the whole city and its fringes using the images;
3. Identification and inventory of all slum clusters of all descriptions in the urban agglomeration with the help of satellite image and other available data;
4. Inventory of all possible vacant lands in each zone of the urban agglomeration that could be
used for slum development/ rehabilitation development purposes;
5. Development of Slum Map of every slum within the city and its fringes using GIS with CARTOSAT II images, ground level spatial data collected through total station survey, collating spatial information with respect to plot boundaries, network of basic infrastructure like roads, sewerage, storm drainage and water lines, etc and superimposing this on the satellite image and importing them into GIS platform as the first step towards the preparation of Slum Development Plans and Slum Free City Plan.
6. This may be undertaken with the help of technical partners of NRSC/ ISRO/other technical institutions.
7. Identification and engagement of Lead NGO/CBO to guide and anchor community mobilization for the purpose of slum survey, (May be more than one NGO/CBO in different slum zones) of the city. These Lead NGOs/CBOs should also be associated in slum survey operations and dialogues for preparation of slum level development plans;
8. Conduct of Slum Survey based on the detailed formats (with or without changes)

prepared by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation with the help of National Buildings Organization (NBO) - after due training of trainers, training of survey personnel /canvassers and canvassing. It would be helpful for community mobilization to pick as many canvassers from the sourced slum or nearby slum pockets;

9. Collection of bio-metric identification data of slum dwellers based on the above survey (subject to guidelines issued by Unique Identity Authority of India (UIDAI));

10. Entry of data from Slum Surveys in the web-enabled MIS application (to be provided by Ministry of HUPA), compilation and collation of data, preparation of Slum-wise, City and State Slum Survey Database and Baseline Reports. The MIS will assist in developing a robust Slum and Slum Households Information System. (Guidelines and software for development of the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

11. Integration of Slum MIS with GIS Maps to enable the preparation of GIS-enabled

Slum Information System that is to be used for the preparation of meaningful Slum Development Plans and Slum-free City Plan using a city-wide/zone-based approach. (Guidelines and software for development of GIS platform and its integration with the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

Introduction to Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), a path breaking scheme for the slum dwellers and urban poor envisages a 'Pucca house to every family' through encouraging States to tackle the problem of slums in a holistic manner. It calls for a multi-pronged approach focusing on:

- ☐ Bringing existing slums within the formal system and enabling them to avail of the same level of basic amenities as the rest of the town.
- ☐ Redressing the failures of the formal system that lie behind the creation of slums.
- ☐ Tackling the shortages of urban land and housing that keep shelter out of reach of the urban poor and force them to resort to extra-legal solutions in a bid to retain their sources of livelihood and employment.

- Enactment of a set of reforms at the state and city level related to inclusive planning, regulation and financing, which would ensure that adequate fresh housing stock and services get created on an ongoing basis to address both current and future needs of cities.
- An integrated approach covering shelter, services and livelihoods for poor slum communities.

The duration of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana [PMAY]

2015 TO 2022

Eligible Components of the PMAY:

Allotment of Houses

Allotment of dwelling units will be in the name of the female member of the . Alternatively, it can be allotted in the name of husband and wife jointly. Ownership of land required for every Beneficiary.

A EWS beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife and unmarried children. The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house (an all weather dwelling unit) either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission. EWS households are defined as households having an annual income up to Rs.3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakhs). States/UTs shall have the flexibility to redefine the annual income criteria as per local conditions in consultation with the Centre.

Following infrastructure will be considered for support under PMAY:

1. Water connection
2. Toilet facilities
3. 24 x 7 Electric facilities
4. Roads

Need for Projects

This development project models will give benefits in the city . One of the key objectives of developing the Projects is to incentivize innovation and encourage new approaches and solutions that can demonstrably improve the quality and quantity of shelter and services for the poor.

Such innovation could encompass:

- ☐ Projects with strong community participation i.e. Slum upgradation/ redevelopment projects initiated/spearheaded by the community; or with their demonstrable involvement and participation in design, planning and implementation
- ☐ New models of public-private partnerships whereby the private sector can be encouraged to take up affordable housing for the EWS/LIG.
- ☐ Innovations in planning, demonstrating integrated livelihoods, shelter and services; or convergence.
- ☐ Innovative or cost effective and green building design and technologies.
- ☐ Financial innovations in delivering the city/state wide programme.

Aims and Objectives

Vision

The mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through following programme verticals:

- Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource
- Promotion of Affordable Housing for weaker section through credit linked subsidy
- Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors
- Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction

Objectives

The project has been designed keeping in mind the following objectives.

- Integrated development of all existing slums, notified or non-notified, i.e., development of infrastructure and housing in the slums/rehabilitation colonies for the slum dwellers/urban poor, including rental housing.
- Development/improvement/maintenance of basic services to the urban poor, including water supply, sewerage, drainage, solid waste management, approach and internal road, street lighting.
- The Creation of affordable housing stock, including rental housing with the provision of civic infrastructure and services, on ownership.

Definition of Slum for Housing

Different definitions of a slum exist in different statutes and in urban poverty literature. For the purpose of HOUSING SCHEME, it is proposed to adopt the definition given in the 2001 Census, which is as follows:

- a. All areas notified as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration under any Act;
- b. All areas recognized as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration, which have not been formally notified as slum under any Act;

'Slum' or 'Slum Area' – is a compact settlement of at least 20 households (For NE & Special Category States it is 10-15 households) with a collection of poorly built tenements, mostly of temporary nature, crowded together usually with inadequate sanitary and drinking water facilities in unhygienic conditions.

Situation Appraisal

The people living in the slums mostly have kutchha (10) and semi-pucca (186) housing. In certain cases where pucca housing is available, they are usually in dilapidated condition. The kutchha houses are in very poor condition and require extensive repairs. Most of the houses have tiles on roof. While during the survey some of the houses have been noted to be in average condition, the quality of these houses is also speedily deteriorating.

Proposed Intervention

In line with the vision to '**housing for all**', an integrated housing programme is proposed to be implemented. The target will be all the slum /Non Slum dwellers in the pocket.

Building Plan

The buildings are proposed to cover an area of approximate 32 Sq.mt along with provision of 2 rooms, kitchen and sanitation facility. The layout, size and type design of housing dwelling units depends on the local conditions and the preferences of the beneficiary. The houses, has been designed in accordance with the desire of the beneficiaries, keeping in view the climatic conditions and the need to provide ample space, kitchen, ventilation, sanitary facilities, etc. and the community perceptions, preferences and cultural attitudes.

In line with the scheme, carpet area of the house will be not less than 25 sq. mts and preferably two room accommodation plus kitchen and toilet should be constructed.

Compliance with Municipal Bye laws

All designs & drawings are created keeping in line with the municipal bye laws.

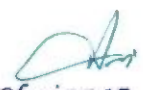

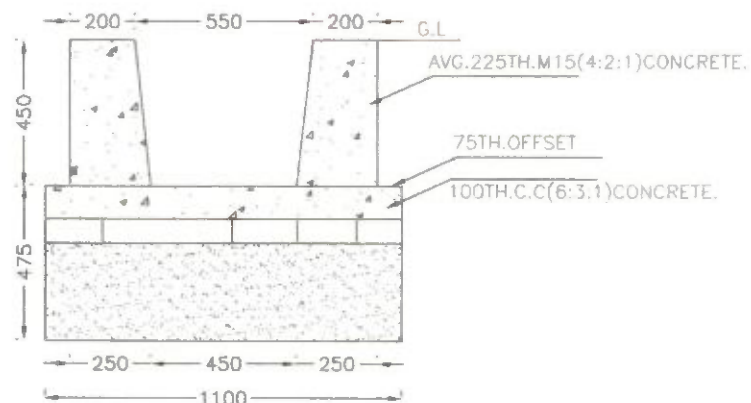

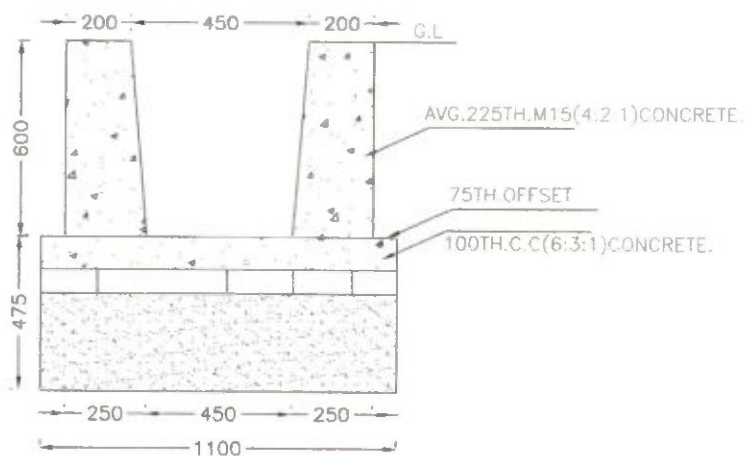
DRAWING(TYPICAL CROSS SECTION)FOR PROPOSED SURFACE DRAIN

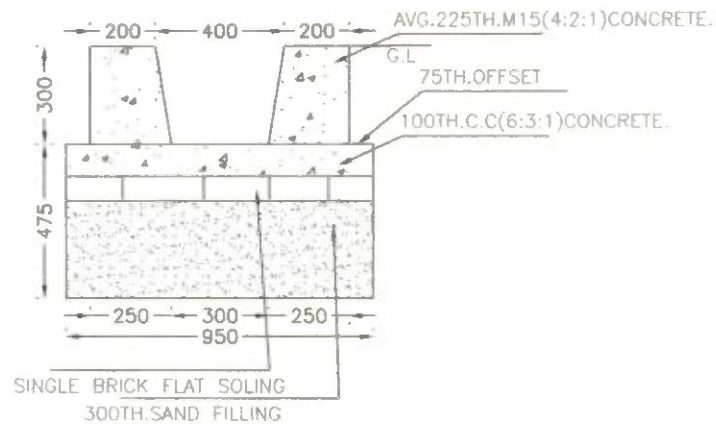
TYPICAL CROSS SECTION OF SURFACE DRAIN

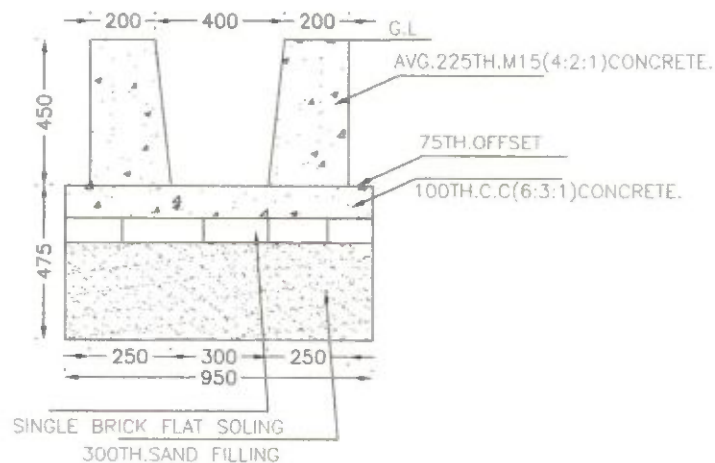
DRAWING(TYPICAL CROSS SECTION)FOR PROPOSED SURFACE DRAIN

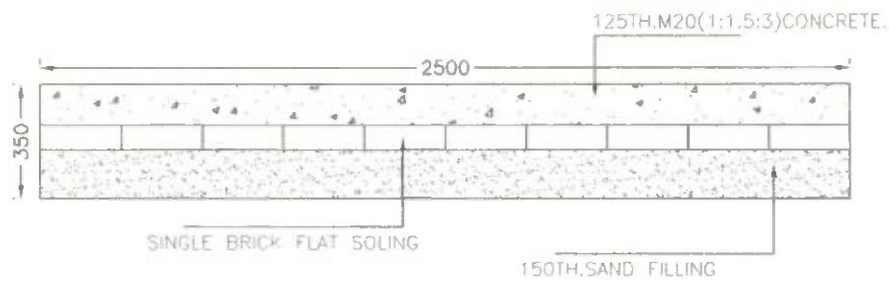

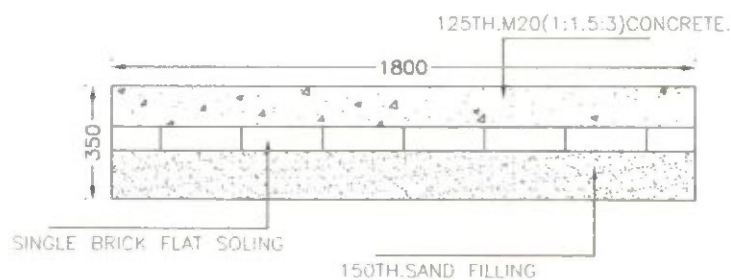
DRAWING(TYPICAL CROSS SECTION)FOR PROPOSED CEMENT CONCRETE ROAD

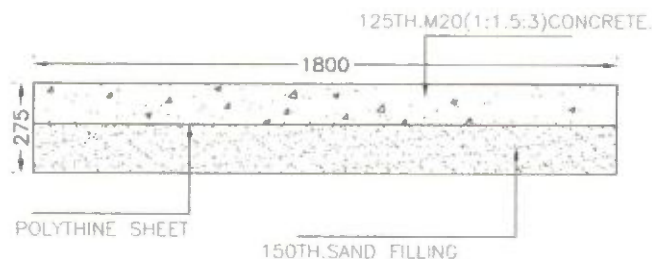
