


Introductory Note by Chairman





PREFACE

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) aims at Providing Housing for All (HFA) by 2022 when the Nation Complete 75 years of its independence.

The urban homeless persons contribute to the economy of the cities and thus the Nation as cheap labour in the informal sector; yet they live with no shelter or social security . The urban homeless service with many challenges like no access to elementary Public Services such as health, education, food, water and sanitation. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) also aims at providing a pucca house to every family with water connection, toilet facilities, 24 X 7 electricity supply and access.

The Mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through “In Situ” Slum Redevelopment, Affordable Housing through credit linked subsidy, Affordable Housing in partnership and subsidy for beneficiary led individual house. Under the mission, beneficiaries can take advantage under one component only.

Total beneficiaries of the scheme are 1308 Nos. from 31 Nos. Slum and 17 Nos. Ward’s Non Slum area, projected for the year 2018-19 .

Total cost of the project is **Rs. 5294.78 lakhs** as per relevant department & P.W.D. schedule of rates.

TOWN FEATURES

INTRODUCTION

Kaliyaganj is a Municipal town having 53650 population of Raiganj Sub-Division under the District of Uttar Dinajpur. Kaliyaganj has assumed the role of Municipality in the year 1987, taking with only 9 wards when the total population was 26,000. Now, it has expanded to 17 wards strengthening its body covering 53650 population at present comprising of 11 Mouzas which are stated as under :

A. BACKGROUND

Kaliyaganj though is not a big town in size; but it is one of the oldest town of undivided Bengal under erstwhile Dinajpur District. It was used as corridor in between Bihar and Dacca (now Bangladesh) through Railway connecting Coochbehar (Gitaldah) and Kolkata (Sealdah) and maintaining the balance of trade of Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Assam including East Bengal now Bangladesh. It is said that Kaliyaganj is the immediate next to Kanpur (U.P.) as business centre of Rice, Mustard oil, Jute and Wheat & Maize. After the partition of Bengal in 1947, the Dinajpur District was divided into two parts out of which one part was known as West Dinajpur and the another part was emerged with East Bengal now known as Bangladesh. Again on 1st April 1994 the West Dinajpur has been sub divided into two parts – one is known as Dakshin Dinajpur and another is known as Uttar Dinajpur under which Kaliyaganj exists. Despite so may partitions and sub-partitions, Kaliyaganj did not loose its importance and Business activities as was in long ago. Kaliyaganj is the only place in the Uttar Dinajpur District where we get the touch of ancient business culture and exchange of views on socio-economic condition, human culture and tradition.

After recognition of Uttar Dinajpur District on 1st April 1994 Kaliyaganj is known as the second big town of the district just after the district town located at Raiganj. It is an important business centre in the north eastern region. It is great pleasure that after converting the old meter gauge rail-line into a broad-gauge one the trade and commerce

of Kaliyaganj has remarkably been improved. It is hoped that after opening of Roadways with Bangladesh through Dinajpur Border (adjacent to Kaliyaganj P.S.) the trade and commerce of Kaliyaganj will play a vital role in northern India which is going to be opening shortly. The "TULAI-PANJI" rice of Uttar Dinajpur is well-known to all the Bengalees for which the major portion of cultivable land for production of this paddy is situated at Kaliyaganj. There are so many small scale Industries for processing of Mustard Oil at Kaliyaganj from where the Mustard oil is exported through out India specially in northern part of India.

BASIC OF THE TOWN

i) LOCATION :

Kaliyaganj is situated on the west side of the Bank of the river Srimati which was used as shipping route from Dacca (Now Bangladesh) to Kolkata under the British rule for trade and commerce. It played a vital role for transportation of goods under trade and commerce by which Kaliyaganj established itself as an important Business centre and hinterland. It was also well connected with northern part of India, Dacca and Kolkata with Railway. Bangladesh is only 9 km away from Kaliyaganj. Besides, Kaliyaganj is also well connected with other important places and towns by roadways.

ii) AREA :

The total area of the town is about 11.67 sq.km. The rapid growth of population is expanding the town day after day overlapping the Panchayat areas which will require to be notified as Municipal area in future by the Govt.

iii) POPULATION :

According to census report of 2011, the population of existing 17 wards was 47,639.

iv) CLIMATIC CONDITION & RAINFALL :

The climate condition of Kaliyaganj is of tropical nature. Mainly three types of seasons are visible here. These are Summer, rainy and Winter. The summer season persistently lasts for seven months from 15th of march to 15th of October. Under the supremacy of summer, the Rainy season starts from 15th of June and continues upto 15th of October which lasts upto four months. These two brothers, Summer and Rainy season jointly use to take the major period of the climatic

cycle. The rest five months from 15th of October to 15th of March remain for winter. During summer the day temperature raises maximum of 40^o C and minimum 28^o C. The rainfall is considerably satisfactory. Total yearly rainfall remains between 450 mm to 550 mm. During winter the minimum temperature at night stands at about 7^o C.

v) URBAN CLIMATE :

The rapid growth and the increasing needs of population of urban areas are making the vacant lands filled up, deforestation and filling up of ponds and tanks by multistoried buildings and Industries to live in resulting pollution in every day life in every step. To control this pollution modern technology is required to be adopted for which fund is essential.

vi) SOIL :

Usually the land of Kaliyaganj Municipality is alluvial in nature and suitable for agriculture. Mainly the plains and water land are seen here.

vii) ADMINISTRATIVE SETUP :

Kaliyaganj Municipality is the neighboring town of the District town Raiganj of Uttar Dinajpur District which is only 15 KM away. The town achieved its Municipal status in the year 1987 and is running with its Board of Councillors with Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Leader of Opposition since 1994.

OCCUPATIONAL PATTERN AND ECONOMICAL BASE

i) AGRICULTURAL :

The people are mainly dependent on various types of agriculture and the main cash crops are Paddy, Wheat, Jute, Mustered-Seeds Maize and cereals. At present three-times Paddy in a year are grown here.

ii) FORESTY :

There is no any forest area under Kaliyaganj Municipality. But social forestry has been started to control the land contamination and erosion of land of combat with pollution.

iii) INDUSTRIES ;

The unemployment problem is an alarming problem of this town. Depending upon the socio-economic condition of the people small scale industries and cottage industries have been established by the unemployed youth to fight with unemployment. Most of these Industries are Mustard Oil Mills, Mini Rice Mills, Flour Mills and Processing Units etc. The progress in the field of Industries is lacking behind due to non-cooperation of financial Institutions. No large Industries either by joint venture or by private sector has yet been established here though the location and other infrastructures are quite favorable. About 19,724 of the total population is still identified as slum population who find their livelihood by pulling Rickshaws, Driving trucks and Private Buses, cow-carts and daily labours. The female populations find their livelihood in making cow dung cakes, processing rice and puffed rice and by working as maid servants. Attempts are being taken for poverty alleviation by formation of more and more SHG's. Some of the people are engaged in Govt. services, commercial and other services activities.

iv) COMMUNICATION :

There is a state Highway from Raiganj (Uttar Dinajpur) to Balurghat (Dakshin Dinajpur) which has been gone through the heart of Kaliyaganj town and the Kaliyaganj town is only 25 km away on the North east side of Raiganj. As the N.H. 34 crossed over the State Highway 10A at District town Raiganj from South to North direction, Kaliyaganj town is well connected with northern part of the India like, Siliguri, Jalpaigur, Coochbehar, Assam and other north eastern states. On the southern side, it is well connected with Kolkata and other neighbouring districts. Apart from Roadways, this town is also well connected with railways. The important roads within the town are mostly of bituminous, cement concrete road and brick solling. At present 42.62 km bituminous road, 28.60 km cement concrete road and 42.90 km brick solling road are existing in the town. At least 50 to 60 buses including Mini buses are playing regularly over Kaliyaganj town. The Railway station is situated in the heart of the town.

SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

i) HEALTH CARE FACILITY :

Kaliyaganj State General hospita is situated in the Kaliyaganj town . Apart from this Kaliyaganj State General hospita the Municipality has been included under the scheme of Community Base Primary Health Care Service and is functioning like Pulse Polio, T.B., Leprosy and other diseases.

ii) EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES :

There are 24 nos. of Primary Schools, 6 nos. of H.S. schools, 2nos junior high school ,1 no. of Jr. Technical school, 1 no.I.T.I. College. There is also a Co-education college. We need immediately a Girls' College also. There are also 10 nos. of Sishu Sikshya Kendras under the Municipality.

iii) POST AND TELEGRAPH :

Kaliyaganj town has one main sub-post office and 2 nos. of branch post offices. There are numbers of Courier Services almost in all the areas of the town.

iv) BANKING FACILITIES :

There are two nos. of SBI Branches out of which one SBI branch is meant for Agricultural Development Branch. Besides, there is one no. of UBI branch, one no. of Raiganj Central Cooperative Bank branch and one no. of Bangiya Gramin Vikash Bank branch. ,One no of Central Bank Of India branch , one no of Bank of India branch,one Bank of Canara Bank of India branch and one no of HDFC bank branch.

v) TOURIST FACILITIES

There is no any tourist facilities at present. We are considering to select some of the oldest Historical Places to give effect on the pages of the history for the interested tourists. There is a famous Baira Kali Temple on the Bank of the river Srimati wherein hundred of devotee tourists use to come to visit MAA BAIRA KALI to get the blessings of MAA KALI.

vi) RECREATION

There is 2 (two) nos. of Cinema Halls and 2 (two) nos. of Children Parks . We are in burning need of recreation facilities and children parks in each and every ward of the town.

PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

i) ROAD SYSTEM

At present there are 42.62 Km of metallic Road, 28.60 Km cement concrete Road, 42.90 Km of brick soling Road and 62.89 Km of Kachcha Road in our Municipality. Most of the roads of the town require improvement as per need of the days like widening. Provision of drain and conversion from non-metalled to metalled.

ii) DRAINAGE SYSTEM

The town has no underground drainage system at present. We are dependable only on insufficient surface drainage system without having out let system. As a result, all the areas of the town more or less face water logging during Rainy season every year. There is burning need of improvement of the existing drainage system by excavating new drains including conversion of existing Kachacha drains into Pukka drains with outlet system of logging water. At present 5.47 km. of Pukka drain and 6.90 km of kachcha drain in the town.

iii) COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

There is one Municipal daily Market and one private daily market in the town which is run by Kaliyaganj Byabasayee Samity. There are another two Market complexes also namely Indira Market Complex consisting of 26 nos. of stalls and Vivekananda Market Complex consisting of 32 nos. of stalls run by Kaliyaganj Municipality. The Municipal Daily Market is consisting of 27 nos. of stalls already lent out to the Businessmen by which the Municipality has been able to increase its source of income. A portion of 1st floor (1200 sft. Approx.) of Indira Market has been completed and has already been lent out to the W.B. State Electricity Board. The rest will be completed as and when fund will be available and will be lent out to create permanent source of income.

iv) POURA UTSAB BHABAN

There are 3 nos. Private Dharmasala have been used as guest houses and other ceremonial purposes which are beyond reach to the Middle class and upper middle class people. Considering the need for more Guest Houses in comparison to the increasing number of people, the Municipality has arranged for building a Poura Utsab Bhaban on a donated land of eight Kathas donated by Hon'ble Sri Debabrata Ghosh annexed to the Municipal Office Building. The area of the said Vivekananda Poura Utsab Bhaban is of 4760 sft. in which the ground floor is being used for ceremonial purposes and the 1st and 2nd floor are to be used for the purpose of guest houses specially for middle class and upper middle class people by a reasonable rate of amount from which the Municipality has been able to create a permanent source of income.

v) CONSERVANCY

There is one dumping ground of the Municipality located at near by Panchayat area. The Municipality has four nos. of Tractors with Tailors for clearance of garbages everyday. Garbage are mainly brought and accumulated in some selected Dustbins by Push-trolley wheel barrows and then finally disposed off by tractors. Proper scientific and hygienic system of Dustbins / Vats is required to be introduced considering the rapid growth of habitation and also clearance of the garbage of the town on day to day basis.

vi) ELECTRICITY FACILITES

The electric energy is controlled and maintained by the WBSEB. The Municipality only maintains the street-light arrangements. There are about 1200 nos. of Electric lights with 2693 nos. of electric poles.

vii) LAND USE PATTERN

The Municipality has an old land use map. It should be more scientific. With the introduction and preparation of DDP, the municipality has started preparation of land use map under G.I.S.

HFAPoA and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Housing for All)

To give pucca house for every family is currently on the global agenda. One of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) is to 'achieve significant improvement in the lives of slum dwellers, by 2022'. Similar goals are set forth by Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana within year 2022, to create pucca house for every family.


ULB undertake a demand survey through suitable means for assessing the actual demand of housing. While validating demand survey, Cities consider possible temporary migration from rural areas to the city just to take advantage of housing scheme and exclude such migrants from list of beneficiaries. On the basis of demand survey and other available data, cities prepare Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA). HFAPoA contain the demand of housing by eligible beneficiaries in the city along with the interventions selected out of four verticals. The information regarding beneficiaries is collected by ULB in suitable. While preparing HFAPoA, ULB and Implementing Agencies also consider the affordable housing stock already available in the city as Census data suggests that large number of houses are vacant.

Bank account number and Aadhaar number/Voter ID card/any other unique identification details of intended beneficiaries or a certificate of house ownership from Revenue Authority of beneficiary's native district integrate in the data base of HFAPoA for avoiding duplication of benefit to one individual family. Beneficiaries is validated by ULBs thereby ensuring their eligibility at the time of preparation of the projects and approval of projects.

On the basis of HFAPoA, States/Cities subsequently prepare the Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) dividing the task upto 2022 in view of the availability of resources and priority. For larger cities, HFAPoA and AIPs is prepared at sub-city (ward/zone etc.) level with the approval of concerned State/UT Government. The result of demand survey, draft HFAPoA and draft AIP is discussed with the local representatives including MLAs and MPs of that area so that their views are adequately factored in while finalising the plans and beneficiary list.

Cities which have already prepared Slum Free City Plan of Action (SFCPoA) or any other housing plan with data on housing, utilise the existing plan and data for preparing "Housing for All Plan of Action" (HFAPoA). Houses constructed under various schemes should be accounted for while preparing HFAPoA

The preparation of HFAPoA broadly involve Slum Development/Rehabilitation Plans based on

- a. Survey of all slums – notified and non-notified;
 - b. Mapping of slums using the state-of-art technology;
 - c. Integration of geo-spatial and socio-economic data; and
 - d. Identification of development model proposed for each slum.
-
1. Base maps to an appropriate scale would be a pre-requisite for the preparation of Slum Development Plan/Slum-free City Plan. States/UTs may need to proceed in the following steps for the preparation of Slum-free City Plans.
 2. Securing CARTOSAT II/latest satellite images from NRSC/ISRO and preparation of base maps for the whole city and its fringes using the images;
 3. Identification and inventory of all slum clusters of all descriptions in the urban agglomeration with the help of satellite image and other available data;
 4. Inventory of all possible vacant lands in each zone of the urban agglomeration that could be used for slum development/ rehabilitation development purposes;
 5. Development of Slum Map of every slum within the city and its fringes using GIS with CARTOSAT II images, ground level spatial data collected through total station survey, collating spatial information with respect to plot boundaries, network of basic infrastructure like roads, sewerage, storm drainage and water lines, etc and superimposing this on the satellite image and importing them into GIS platform as the first step towards the preparation of Slum Development Plans and Slum Free City Plan.
 6. This may be undertaken with the help of technical partners of NRSC/ ISRO/other technical institutions.
 7. Identification and engagement of Lead NGO/CBO to guide and anchor community mobilization for the purpose of slum survey, (May be more than one NGO/CBO in different slum zones) of the city. These Lead NGOs/CBOs should also be associated in slum survey operations and dialogues for preparation of slum level development plans;
 8. Conduct of Slum Survey based on the detailed formats (with or without changes)

prepared by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation with the help of National Buildings Organization (NBO) - after due training of trainers, training of survey personnel /canvassers and canvassing. It would be helpful for community mobilization to pick as many canvassers from the sourced slum or nearby slum pockets;

9. Collection of bio-metric identification data of slum dwellers based on the above survey (subject to guidelines issued by Unique Identity Authority of India (UIDAI));

10. Entry of data from Slum Surveys in the web-enabled MIS application (to be provided by Ministry of HUPA), compilation and collation of data, preparation of Slum-wise, City and State Slum Survey Database and Baseline Reports. The MIS will assist in developing a robust Slum and Slum Households Information System. (Guidelines and software for development of the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

11. Integration of Slum MIS with GIS Maps to enable the preparation of GIS-enabled

Slum Information System that is to be used for the preparation of meaningful Slum Development Plans and Slum-free City Plan using a city-wide/zone-based approach. (Guidelines and software for development of GIS platform and its integration with the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

Introduction to Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), a path breaking scheme for the slum dwellers and urban poor envisages a 'Pucca house to every family' through encouraging States to tackle the problem of slums in a holistic manner. It calls for a multi-pronged approach focusing on:

- Bringing existing slums within the formal system and enabling them to avail of the same level of basic amenities as the rest of the town.
- Redressing the failures of the formal system that lie behind the creation of slums.

- Tackling the shortages of urban land and housing that keep shelter out of reach of the urban poor and force them to resort to extra-legal solutions in a bid to retain their sources of livelihood and employment.

- Enactment of a set of reforms at the state and city level related to inclusive planning, regulation and financing, which would ensure that adequate fresh housing stock and services get created on an ongoing basis to address both current and future needs of cities.
- An integrated approach covering shelter, services and livelihoods for poor slum communities.

The duration of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana [PMAY]

2015 TO 2022

Eligible Components of the PMAY:

Allotment of Houses

Allotment of dwelling units will be in the name of the female member of the . Alternatively, it can be allotted in the name of husband and wife jointly. Ownership of land required for every Beneficiary.

A EWS beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife and unmarried children. The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house (an all weather dwelling unit) either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission. EWS households are defined as households having an annual income up to Rs.3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakhs). States/UTs shall have the flexibility to redefine the annual income criteria as per local conditions in consultation with the Centre.

Following infrastructure will be considered for support under PMAY:

1. Water connection
2. Toilet facilities
3. 24 x 7 Electric facilities
4. Roads

Need for Projects

This development project models will give benefits in the city . One of the key objectives of developing the Projects is to incentivize innovation and encourage new approaches and solutions that can demonstrably improve the quality and quantity of shelter and services for the poor.

Such innovation could encompass:

- Projects with strong community participation i.e. Slum upgradation/ redevelopment projects initiated/spearheaded by the community; or with their demonstrable involvement and participation in design, planning and implementation
- New models of public-private partnerships whereby the private sector can be encouraged to take up affordable housing for the EWS/LIG.
- Innovations in planning, demonstrating integrated livelihoods, shelter and services; or convergence.
- Innovative or cost effective and green building design and technologies.
- Financial innovations in delivering the city/state wide programme.

Aims and Objectives

Vision

The mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through following programme verticals:

- Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource
- Promotion of Affordable Housing for weaker section through credit linked subsidy
- Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors
- Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction

Objectives

The project has been designed keeping in mind the following objectives.

- Integrated development of all existing slums, notified or non-notified, i.e., development of infrastructure and housing in the slums/rehabilitation colonies for the slum dwellers/urban poor, including rental housing.
- Development/improvement/maintenance of basic services to the urban poor, including water supply, sewerage, drainage, solid waste management, approach and internal road, street lighting.
- The Creation of affordable housing stock, including rental housing with the provision of civic infrastructure and services, on ownership.
- Encouraging Public Private Partnership by having pay and use toilets and educate the slum dwellers for keeping the environment clean and hygienic.

State PMAY Mission Director

The Nodal Ministry and National Mission Directorate is Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India.

The Nodal Department for West Bengal is Municipal Affairs Dept. (M.A. Department), Government of West Bengal. The state level Nodal Agency is State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) under M.A. Department. State Urban Development Agency was set up in 1991 with a view to ensuring proper implementation and monitoring of the centrally assisted programmes for generating employment opportunities and alleviation of poverty throughout the State. SUDA is a Society registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961.

Funding Pattern of PMAY

Funding pattern for PMAY(Housing for all)

- Central share 1.5 LAKHS of total cost of dwelling unit
- Beneficiary share 0.25 LAKHS of total cost of dwelling unit
- State share rest of total cost of dwelling unit
- State + ULB bear the cost of infrastructure
- State share for infrastructure to be minimum 5%
- ULB share for infrastructure to be minimum 5%
- Cost of infrastructure 10 % of sum total cost of dwelling unit

Approvals & Release of Funds

- Releases and approvals to be on the basis of DPRs which need to be submitted with approval of State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee
- Innovative projects to be considered for sanction even in the preparatory stage.
- Central Funds to be released in three installments to the State Governments/SLNA; central assistance under different components will be released to the state / UTs after the approval of CSMC and with concurrence of the integrated Financial Division of the Ministry. Central share would be released in three installment of 40%,40% and 20% each.

- RCC M-20 for substructure & superstructure (Column, Beam, Slab)
- HYSD Steel
- 1st Class Brick Masonry
- 1:6 (Cement: Sand) plaster – 10 mm on soffit of beam & slab, 15 mm on internal walls & 20 mm on external walls
- IPS flooring

Definition of Slum for Housing

Different definitions of a slum exist in different statutes and in urban poverty literature. For the purpose of HOUSING SCHEME, it is proposed to adopt the definition given in the 2001 Census, which is as follows:

- a. All areas notified as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration under any Act;
- b. All areas recognized as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration, which have not been formally notified as slum under any Act;

'Slum' or 'Slum Area'– is a compact settlement of at least 20 households (For NE & Special Category States it is 10-15 households) with a collection of poorly built tenements, mostly of temporary nature, crowded together usually with inadequate sanitary and drinking water facilities in unhygienic conditions.

Situation Appraisal

The people living in the slums mostly have kutcha (10) and semi-pucca (186) housing. In certain cases where pucca housing is available, they are usually in dilapidated condition. The kutcha houses are in very poor condition and require extensive repairs. Most of the houses have tiles on roof. While during the survey some of the houses have been noted to be in average condition, the quality of these houses is also speedily deteriorating.

Proposed Intervention

In line with the vision to **'housing for all'**, an integrated housing programme is proposed to be implemented. The target will be all the slum /Non Slum dwellers in the pocket.

Building Plan

The buildings are proposed to cover an area of approximate 32 Sq.mt along with provision of 2 rooms, kitchen and sanitation facility. The layout, size and type design of housing dwelling units depends on the local conditions and the preferences of the beneficiary. The houses, has been designed in accordance with the desire of the beneficiaries, keeping in view the climatic conditions and the need to provide ample space, kitchen, ventilation, sanitary facilities, etc. and the community perceptions, preferences and cultural attitudes.

In line with the scheme, carpet area of the house will be not less than 25 sq. mts and preferably two room accommodation plus kitchen and toilet should be constructed.

Compliance with Municipal Bye laws

All designs & drawings are created keeping in line with the municipal bye laws.

Building material

- PCC (1:3:6) for foundation
- RCC M-20 for substructure & superstructure (Column, Beam, Slab)
- HYSD Steel
- 1st class Brick Masonry
- 1:6 (Cement: Sand) plaster – 10 mm on soffit of beam & slab, 15 mm on internal walls & 20 mm on external walls
- IPS flooring

Structural Design

- Following are the general considerations in the analysis/design.
- For all structural elements, M20 grade concrete and Fe 415 grade of steel is used.
- Plinth beams passing through columns are provided as tie beams.
- Pedestals are proposed up to ground level.
- Beam Centre-line dimensions are followed for analysis and design.
- For all the building, walls of 250 mm and 125mm thick with 20 mm External plaster and 12 mm thick internal plaster are considered.
- Seismic loads are considered acting in the horizontal direction along either of the two principal directions.

- Live load: 2.0 kN/m² at typical floor
- 1.5 kN/m² on terrace (With Access) : 0.75 kN/m² on terrace (without Access)
- Floor finish 50mm (0.05*24) = : 1.2 kN/m²
- Ceiling plaster 12mm (0.012*20.8) : 0.25 kN/m²
- Partition walls (Wherever Necessary) : 1.0 kN/m²
- Terrace finish: 1.5 kN/m²
- Earthquake load: As per IS-1893 (Part 1) - 2002
- Depth of foundation below ground: ,0.7 m
- Walls: 250 mm thick brick masonry walls at external and 125mm walls internal.




