



2019 STATE URBAN DEVELOPMENT AGENCY NOTE SHEET SUDA-315/2019

Sub.: Submission of Action Plan for Polluted River Stretches Priority – I, II, III, IV and V in connection with order of NGT O.A. 673/2017 and O.A. 727/2018 – Regd.

The Program Director, West Bengal State NGRBA Program Management Group (WBSPMG) & CEO, KMDA, vide his communication memorandum no. 1682-NGRBA/SPMG/AP-NGT-505/2018 dt. 15.01.2019 (placed at CP-1 to 3), had mentioned that following order dated 20.09.2018 of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, in O.A. No. 673/2018 NEWS ITEM PUBLISHED IN "THE HINDU" AUTHORED BY SHRI JACOB KOSHY Titled "More river stretches are now critically polluted: CPCB", the Government of West Bengal, vide Notification No. EN/44/3C-01/2019 dated 7th January 2019, formed the River Rejuvenation Committee, West Bengal (placed at CP-110) for preparing the action plans within two months for bringing all the polluted river stretches to be fit at least for its Designated-Best-Use Class- B, i.e. for Outdoor Bathing (Organised), where the indicators like 5-day Biochemical Oxygen Demand at 20°C should be less than 3 mg/ltrs. and Total Feacal Coliforms Organism required to be maintained below 500 Most Probable Number/100 ml.

Further upon acceptance in 2nd meeting of the Committee, Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal reconstituted the RRC, vide memorandum no. EN/ 3C-01/2019 dated 05.03.2019 (placed at CP-111), where all the departments and agencies, who are responsible for effective functioning of the Committee were included.

Now, it is to mention that the following 17 (seventeen) river stretches have been identified as polluted:



The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench New Delhi, was pleased to pass an order dated 20.09.2018 in O.A. no.673/2018 NEWS ITEM PUBLISHED IN "THE HINDU" AUTHORED BY SHRI JACOB KOSHY Titled "More river stretches are now critically polluted: CPCB" directing all the States and Union Territories to prepare action plans within two months for bringing all the polluted river stretches to be fit at least for bathing purposes (i.e BOD < 3 mg/L and FC < 500 MPN/100 ml) within six months from the date of finalisation of the action plans.

The action plans to be prepared by four-member Committee comprising, Director, Environment, Director, Urban Development., Director, Industries., Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board of the concerned State. This Committee will also be the Monitoring Committee for execution of the action plan. The Committee may be called "River Rejuvenation Committee" (RRC). Constitution of the Committee was notified vide memo no: EN/44/3C-01/2019 dated 07th January,2019. In the 2nd meeting, it was unanimously accepted that a proposal will be sent to the Chief Secretary to reconstitute the RRC so that all the departments and agencies who are responsible for effective functioning of the committee be included..

In terms of the proposal of the aforesaid committee, the Governor is pleased reconstitute the River Rejuvenation Committee, West Bengal comprising of the following members-
