3. Additionally, please arrange to conduct:


- exposure visits of RWAs to other well-performing and proactive RWAs in your the city to learn about their SBM-related initiatives

Sub: Implementation of Slum Rehabilitation component of Prime Minister's Awas Yojana by participation of private developers

Respected Sir,

Slum Rehabilitation is an important component of Prime Minister's Awas Yojana (PAY), especially in the context of Kolkata, where prime land parcels are comprised in slums. This component calls for participation of private developers in implementation. We would like to reiterate that our members would be happy to be associated with this component of the scheme. However, we shall need certain clarification/confirmation from the State Government on issues arising out of the HFA Guideline to facilitate participation of our members. In this context, we submit the following:

- (i) The State Government may please identify slums for intervention under the Slum Rehabilitation (SR) component of PAY within 2015-16, without the Housing For All Plan of Action (HFAPoA) in place
- (ii) As HUPA in the Government of India would require the Housing For All Plan of Action (HFAPoA) report prepared as a pre-condition for entertaining any such scheme beyond March 2016, the State Government should initiate preparation of HFAPoA immediately so as to be able to participate in the scheme beyond March 2016.
- (iii) The State Government needs to prepare a guideline defining 'free sale component' under a SR scheme, specifying *inter alia* the quantum of free sale component, the permissible usages of free sale component, keeping in mind the need for cross-subsidizing the project cost on account of slum rehabilitation. This would also help the selected private developer to work out the project economics. In Maharashtra, for instance, the 'free sale' component is 1.33 times the FAR required for rehabilitation, subject to a maximum of 4. If the resultant FAR exceeds 4, the excess is given as TDR.
- (iv) The State Government needs to define the modality and usage of 'surplus land', if any, under a SR scheme that would be handed over to the selected private developer, keeping in mind the need for cross-subsidizing the project cost on account of slum rehabilitation.
- (v) The State Government shall need to decide when and how the Government of India grant of Rs.1 lac for each slum dwelling unit shall be passed on to the selected private developer.

There are certain other related issues that may need to be addressed to facilitate implementation of the Slum Rehabilitation component, particularly in the context of Kolkata slums:

- (vi) There are many slums at prime locations in the city of Kolkata, notified under the Kolkata Thika Tenancy (Acquisition & Regulation) Act 1981. Despite enormous scope for redevelopment of such slums, nothing can be done as either the recorded Thika Tenants don't have the right to part with right and title of the property or the legitimacy of Thika tenancy itself is in the process of being determined. But any redevelopment of such properties would not only provide better living environment to the Thika Tenants and other occupiers called Bharatiyas, but also add revenues to the State Government in different forms as additional built space can be generated out of such redevelopment. It is suggested that the State Government grant absolute right of Thika properties to the recorded Thika Tenants / restore absolute right of the other Thika properties to original owners, as the case may be, to pave the way for redevelopment. The Thika Tenants / Bharatiyas would continue to enjoy all rights under the Premises Tenancy Act.
- (vii) In order to incentivize developers to undertake slum redevelopment, it is suggested that additional FAR be granted, such that viable business model can be worked out. In case of Maharashtra that has the highest incidence of slums, additional FAR for slum rehabilitation is granted subject to a maximum FAR of 4.
- (viii) There may be cases where redevelopment of properties comprised in slums wouldn't be able to rehabilitate all the existing dwellers at the redeveloped site given the viability of the project and in such cases the State Government should permit suitable rehabilitation of them at a different site within a radius of 5 km from the existing site.
- (ix) In case of any slum redevelopment, consent of slum dwellers to proposed redevelopment and to temporary or permanent relocation of all or part of slum households may be called for. We suggest that the State Government should evolve a policy by which consent of majority of slum households can be addressed. Both Maharashtra and Gujarat have done away with the hitherto provision of requiring 75% and 70% slum dwellers' consent respectively.

Appropriate resolution of the above issues would help formulate viable business models in the current socio-economic perspective and would facilitate participation of the private developers in the scheme.

We are open to discussing the above points in further details and for that we would seek an appointment with you.

Sir,

It may be recalled that in terms of a decision in the State Govt. to provide garbage compactors to the ULBs of the State e-Tenders were earlier invited for 22 nos. Stationary Compactors (with 18 nos. Hook Loaders) and 186 nos. Movable Compactors for 123 ULBs of the State. The e-Tenders have since been finalized and Work Orders for both Stationary and Movable Compactors have been issued.

It may also be recalled that Rs. 15.00 Crore and Rs. 3.09 Crore was earlier released to KMC and HMC respectively for procurement of Compactors.

As per Scheme Guidelines of Govt. of India, the admissible Central share and Matching State share shall be @ 20% and @ 6.66 % of the project cost respectively. The remaining amount shall have to be made available to SUDA as Additional State share.

It may be seen from the statement enclosed (Annexure-I) that the total involvement for procurement and amounts paid to KMC and HMC as well as cost of compactor stations comes to Rs. 12,636.10 Lakh out of which the admissible Central share and Matching State share comes to Rs. 2527.22 Lakh and Rs. 842.40 Lakh respectively aggregating to Rs. 3369.62 Lakh. This amount will be available with SUDA against funds released by Govt. of India along with Matching State share.

In view of this the MA Department is requested to move the Finance Department for allotment and sanction of an Additional State share of Rs. 9266.48 Lakh (Rs. 12636.10 Lakh – Rs 2527.22 Lakh - Rs. 842.40 Lakh) and to place the same at the disposal of SUDA at an early date.

As the successful Bidders will start supply of compactors by middle of February, 2016, SUDA should release appropriate funds to the ULBs well in advance preferably by end of January, 2016. As such the matter may be considered with appropriate priority.

However, achieving the objectives of Mission Nirmal Bangla requires efforts at the level of several Departments having major stake in achieving the Mission objectives. Accordingly, for a holistic and coordinated approach for reaching the objective of 100% household sanitation coverage (both in rural and urban areas), 100% institutional toilet coverage and for adoption of adequate measures for environmental cleanliness along with ensuring interventions for appropriate solid and liquid waste management towards accomplishing the Mission, proper co-ordination among all the related departments is felt necessary. For this purpose an Apex Committee at the State level with the name and style of 'Apex Committee on Mission Nirmal Bangla' is formed with the Following Members:-





Sub: Clarifications on the observations of Finance Department regarding unit rate of Individual Household Latrine (IHHL) adopted in Nadia District ULBs (Rs. 13,000/-) and that proposed elsewhere in the State (Rs. 20,000/-) under Swachh Bharat Mission

Sir,

A proposal for sanction and release of State share and Additional State share for Individual House Hold Latrines (IHHL) under Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) during the Mission period and 2015-16 was moved to the Finance Department sometime ago. Finance Department during examination of the proposal has observed as follows:

“Administrative Department may clarify as to why for Nadia District, the estimated unit cost of an IHHL has been taken to be Rs. 13,000/- only (out of which Rs 2000/- and Rs 1000/- respectively are being borne by the ULB and the beneficiary) whereas for other ULBs, the estimated unit cost of an individual household latrine has been taken to Rs 20,000/- only per unit (out of which beneficiary and ULB will bear Rs 2000/- each), for which Rs. 63 Crore more will have to be borne by the State”.

Now, as the unit rate of Rs 13,000/- in Nadia was earlier vetted by MED and the estimate of Rs 20,700/- as per PWD SOR -2014 was also prepared by MED, it would be helpful if necessary materials for a reply to the clarifications of the Finance Department could be sent to this Office at an early date for submitting the same to the Finance Department through Municipal Affairs Department. It may be mentioned in this connection that the IHHL units in Nadia were constructed by Sanitary Marts (self-help group). Also there may be some difference in the specifications of the two designs.

In view of urgency, an early reply is requested.

Sir,

It may kindly be recalled that following a base line survey 12,220 nos. of individual house hold latrines are under construction in the ten ULBs in Nadia District. It has been decided in this connection that the amount required for construction of the aforesaid number of latrines beyond the amount admissible under Swachh Bharat Mission (Central & matching State Shares) will be provided by the State Government from an appropriate head under the State Plan Budget and will be released to District Magistrate, Nadia direct from the M.A.Department.

Now, the unit cost of a latrine under construction is reported to be Rs.13,000/- out of which Rs.2000/- & Rs.1000/- respectively are being borne by the ULB and the beneficiary as their Shares leaving a balance of Rs.10,000/- to be mobilised. As per Government of India guidelines a sum of Rs. 4,000/- & Rs.1333/- respectively shall be admissible as Central Share & regular State Share aggregating to Rs. 5333/-. Therefore, the remaining amount of Rs.4667/- will be required to be provided by the State Government beyond Swachh Bharat Mission provision.

At the rate of Rs.4667/- the aggregate amount required for 12,220 units works out to Rs.5,70,30,740/-. The M.A. Department is now requested to release the aforesaid amount direct to the District Magistrate , Nadia from a suitable head under the State Plan Budget under intimation to this office.
