In this connection kindly find enclosed herewith the provisional number of IHHL units to be constructed in the Urban Local Bodies of the District ULB wise as per findings of the comprehensive house to house survey for identification of insanitary latrine/no latrine facilities. However the actual number will be as per field executions. The model plan for the latrine unit as prepared by Municipal Engineering Directorate at an estimated cost of Rs. 10,990/- has been decided to be adopted in the program. A copy of plan and estimate of the model design of the latrine is enclosed herewith. The implementation of the program may be undertaken under the overall co-ordination of the District Magistrates and the respective ULBs. The work may be executed preferably through sanitary mart or such other self-help groups (as was done in the case of Nadla) or through the ULBs or otherwise as may be decided by the respective District Administration.

It is further informed that the progress of construction of IHHL starting from applications by the beneficiaries to completion of the units are required to be aploaded in the Govt. of India's portal under SBM. The uploading may be done by CSC e-Governance Services India Ltd. (a special purpose vehicle company constituted by Dept. of Information Technology, Govt. of India and entrusted to look after the CSC scheme across the country) or by the respective ULBs.

The District Administrations will also be required to identify the households where there is no suitable space for construction of IHHL. On receiving a feedback from the Districts proposals for construction of Community Toilets in close proximity of the identified households will be prepared and submitted to the MA Dept. for reference to Finance Department for the required additional State share. Simultaneously the concerned ULBs will be required to identify suitable lands for construction of Community Toilets.





- As per Scheme Guidelines, DPRs of SWM projects are required to be appraised by authorized Appraisal Agencies and thereafter placed before the State High Powered Committee (SHPC) for approval and accessing Central Funds.
- Both KMDA under the Urban Development Department and MED under Municipal Affairs
 Department have adequate technical manpower both for preparation of DPRs as well as
 extending technical support to the ULBs in implementation of projects.
- While KMDA has experience in planning and execution of projects under different programs in ULBs in KMA area, MED has been traditionally working with non-KMA ULBs.
- 5. For the purpose of taking advantage of the technical manpower in the two organizations in an optimal manner, responsibilities of preparation of DPRs and implementation of SWM projects under SBM shall be assigned between the two organizations in the following manner:
 - DPRs for SWM projects (excepting those already prepared by MED) in KMA ULBs shall be prepared by KMDA – both for standalone and cluster mode projects

- 5. For the purpose of taking advantage of the technical manpower in the two organizations in an optimal manner, responsibilities of preparation of DPRs and implementation of SWM projects under SBM shall be assigned between the two organizations in the following manner:
 - DPRs for SWM projects (excepting those already prepared by MED) in KMA ULBs shall be prepared by KMDA – both for standalone and cluster mode projects
 - For standalone projects in KMA area individual ULBs, shall be the implementing agencies with funds placed at their disposal. KMDA will extend necessary technical support to the implementing ULBs.
 - For cluster mode projects in KMA ULBs, funds shall be placed at the disposal of KMDA and implementation of the trans-municipal project will also be the responsibility of KMDA in close co-ordination with the stakeholder ULBs.
 - As regards non-KMA ULBs, MED shall prepare DPRs both for standalone and cluster mode projects either in-house subject to its available capacity or through consultants if necessary with approval of competent authority.
 - Standalone projects in non-KMA ULBs shall be implemented by individual ULBs with necessary funds placed at their disposal and MED shall extend necessary technical support.

- Cluster mode projects in non-KMA area may be implemented by MED with project funds placed at its disposal and in close co-ordination with the constituent ULBs.
- For standalone projects both in KMA and non-KMA areas the individual ULBs will have the option to get the project implemented by KMDA or MED as the case may be as deposit work.
- Kolkata Municipal Corporation will, however, adopt its own system for preparation of DPRs and implementation of SWM projects.
- 7. Other Corporation towns may prepare DPRs and implement projects through their own technical outfit or may get the DPRs prepared by and projects executed by KMDA or MED as the case may be at their own discretion.
- 8. If there are any difficulties in execution of this order in the manner as laid down in the foregoing paragraphs appropriate steps will be taken for redressing the difficulties.

Comments on Special Mention raised by Sri Hussain Dalwai, Hon'ble M.P. regarding Demand to address problems of Solid Waste Management under Swachh Bharat Mission in Metro cities

- The Special mention of Hon'ble M.P. points out to occurrence of a devastating fire in Deonar Dumping Ground near Mumbai and the condition of the waste dump reaching as high as 15 meters. The Hon'ble MP's mention also includes the condition of rag pickers working in the dump for their livelihood.
- ➤ As per norms of Solid Waste Management the Municipal Solid Waste should be segregated at source with 100% door to door collection. The biodegradable component should be treated in appropriate treatment system for production of gas and compost. Dumping of unsegregated waste should be phased out.
- ➤ The non biodegradable component of the Municipal waste should be carried to disposal grounds suitably located and dumped. The construction and demolition (C&D) waste may be separately taken out and used for road building works after crushing to appropriate size.
- ➤ Till such time the dumping of unsegregated Municipal Waste is eliminated, the dumping process should be carried out scientifically with use of leachate to prevent soil pollution. The height of the dump should normally be limited to 4-6 meters.
- ➤ In all Metro cities rag pickers in the Municipal Waste dumping grounds is an important social issue. The rag pickers work in the dump to pick up materials from the waste including papers, metals, plastic, glass and such other items which have resale value in the market. As they earn their livelihood from working in the dumps, it may be considered instead of throwing them out of their livelihood the concerned Municipal Corporation may provide some safety gears like masks, gloves, shoes so that they are not exposed to the harmful and hazardous elements in the waste.

Solid Waste Management in North 24 Parganas

Of the 27 ULBs in North 24 Parganas, till date 20 ULBs have obtained Authorisation from the WBPCB for setting up of solid waste treatment and disposal facilities after submission of Detailed Project Reports. Of these, the following 10 ULBs developed the facilities. The status of these facilities are also provided below:-

SLF- Sanitary Landfill

Of the 27 ULBs, 11 are Ganga front towns (Baranagar, Barrackpore, Bhatpara, Garulia, Halisahar Municipality, Kamarhati, Kanchrapara, Khardah, Naihati, Panihati, Titagarh Municipality) and therefore have now been identified by the Govt. of India as priority areas for solid waste management. These ULBs have been served notices by the Central Pollution Control Board directly for submission of Action Plans for solid waste management.

Compliance with the Rules

The abovementioned facilities had been developed in compliance with the Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2000. These rules have been recently replaced with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 notified on 8th April, 2016 by the Govt. of India.

The Rules apply to every local authority including Corporations, municipalities, census towns, notified areas, SEZ, industrial townships and areas under control of Defence, Airport, Railways, Port, etc. The earlier rules were applicable only to municipal authorities.

These local authorities are responsible for collection treatment and disposal of solid wastes in their respective jurisdiction. As per the rules, all local authorities as described above (not only municipalities) are required to set up solid waste treatment and disposal facilities either individually or as regional clusters.



Action required

The present status of compliance is very poor and the matter is required to be addressed early. The towns along the Ganga may be given priority. The major hurdles like identification of land, development of the facilities and ensuring proper operation and maintenance of the facilities have been addressed in the rules and specific responsibilities for addressing these have been assigned. A brief is provided below and the detailed list of responsibilities of the various authorities is provided in Annexure II).

Land for development of Solid Waste Treatment & Disposal Facilities

The responsibility of identification and allocation of land has been assigned to the Urban Development Department (or the Panchayat& Rural Development Department for areas coming under its jurisdiction) and the District Magistrate.

Development of Regional facilities and Management of Facilities

The Urban Development Department is responsible for facilitating the establishment of common regional sanitary land fill for a group of cities and towns falling within a distance of 50 km (or more) from the regional facility on a cost sharing basis and ensuring professional management of such sanitary landfills;

Capacity Building of Local Authorities

The Urban Development Department is responsible for arrange for capacity building of local bodies in managing solid waste, segregation and transportation or processing of such waste at source

The same responsibilities rest with the Panchayat and Rural Development Department in areas that come under its jurisdiction.


In addition to the above, the Urban Development Department is required to prepare a **State Policy** and **Solid Waste Management Strategy.** This is a priority.

Considering the degree of urbanisation and the high population density in North 24 Parganas, building solid waste treatment and disposal facilities separately for each town is not feasible. Regional facilities covering an area of at least 50 km radius may be considered. Therefore, state or district level planning is required.

The problem of fire at dumping grounds isn't new but this is a recurring problem which hasn't found a permanent solution yet. The Deonar dumping yard is almost 90 years old and has over shot its capacity. The waste dumped at this yard ranging from construction to household waste to even bio-medical waste stands as tall as 15 metres. The yard is surrounded by a densely-populated suburb of Mumbai, including slums and high-end residential areas. And yet, no efforts have been made to close the yard despite strict instructions from the Bombay High Court. No serious efforts have been made to dispose of the waste in a scientific manner or utilise it for production of energy.

The condition of rag pickers who make their living out of this waste is another cause of concern. They do not have any safety gears like masks or gloves and are exposed to harmful gases from the waste but are able to earn nothing more than Rs. 200-300 per day.

I would urge the Government to take urgent steps within the Swachh Bharat Mission to address the problem of solid waste management in metropolitan cities like Mumbai which are generating a huge quantity of waste.

DEMAND FOR EXEMPTING TAMIL NADU STATE POLICE FROM PAYMENT OF SPECTRUM CHARGES

SHRI S. MUTHUKARUPPAN (TAMIL NADU): Sir, the Tamil Nadu Police have different networks of communication which use different frequencies of the spectrum, including High Frequency communication network during the monsoon and natural calamities. Usually, State Police Departments were paying a nominal License Fee of Rs.100 per set. From 1st June, 2004, Spectrum Charges which include Licence fees for each communication set and royalty charges for the use of frequency by wireless sets are being levied even on the Police Departments. The Spectrum Charges were revised again and increased almost threefold from 1.4.2012. The annual Spectrum Charges payable by Tamil Nadu now amount to Rs. 13 crores, and in December, 2015, outstanding dues with late fees were Rs.73.10 crores. Policing is an essential sovereign function of the State and charging such exorbitant amounts for the use of Radio Frequency is completely unjustified. The Police Radio Network is also used extensively in cases of natural calamities and for the maintenance of

- it appears from Action Plan submitted by SUDA, the State Level Nodal Agency for implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission in urban areas to the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India vide Memo. 

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

Hon'ble Minister-in-charge, Backward Classes Welfare Department initiated the discussion on the agenda of the meeting. He stressed the need for effective implementation of the provisions of the MS Act, 2013 in the state.

A brief report on the status of implementation of the Act in this state was thereafter placed before the house.

- i) Fresh survey of identification of insanitary latrines in Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) has been initiated by the Municipal Affairs Department. Final list of insanitary latrine/no latrine facilities in ULBs is likely to be published shortly.
 - ii) Verification of the data of insanitary latrines in rural areas of the state as per census, 2011 is in progress under Panchayat & Rural Development Department.
 - iii) Requirement of community sanitary latrines will be finalised after the ongoing survey in urban areas.
 - Skill Development Training for 98 manual scavengers is complete. They have been provided stipend. Disbursement of fund and subsidy for their rehabilitation has been completed.
 - v) Verification of the existence of 2526 nos. of Manual Scavengers in the rural areas of the state as shown in the Socio-economic & Caste Census, 2011 is in progress under the P. & R.D. Department.
 - vi) Notifications under the provisions of sections 4,7,18,20,24,26 & 36 of the MS Act, 2013 have been issued.
 - vii) Pending issues are:
 - a) Finalisation of the report of Survey of insanitary latrines in ULBs;
 - b) Demolition/ conversion of insanitary latrines in ULBs;
 - c) Construction of community sanitary latrines in urban areas;
 - Specific schemes for conversion of insanitary latrines in urban areas;
 - e) Finalisation of the list of manual scavengers in rural areas;
 - f) Finalisation of the list of insanitary latrines in rural areas;
 - g) Conferment of powers of Judicial Magistrates on Executive Magistrates;
 - h) Designating State Commission/Statutory Body;
 - Finalisation of the report on sewerage deaths (manholes, septic tanks) since 1993 to comply with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;

Director, SUDA stated that Survey is completed in all 118 ULBs covered under Comprehensive House to House Survey for identification of Insanitary Latrine/No Latrine facility. Presently, instruction has already been issued to all ULBs mentioning specific timeline for publication of Draft List and Finalisation of List inviting claims and objections. Finalisation of List will be completed by February, 2016.

Requirement of Community Latrines can be finalised only after completion of final outcome of the Survey in urban areas as contemplated.



Pilot Survey has already been completed in 10 ULBs under Nadia District. Instructions have been issued to all ULBs. Total 12,220 Individual Household latrines have already been constructed.

District wise target has already been communicated from SUDA to construct Individual Household Latrine for the Districts of North 24 Parganas, Hooghly and East Midnapur . Provisional Targets for construction of Individual Household Latrine fixed on the basis of Provisional Household Data on Insanitary latrine/No latrine facilities, captured through comprehensive house to house survey and communicated to respective DM's for implementation are as follows:

- a) Target for District North 24 Parganas: 97,184
- b) Target for District Hooghly: 33,902
- c) Target for District Purba Medinipur: 7,470

These Three Districts have been prioritised for declaration as "Open Defecation Free (ODF)" District

Commissioner in the Deptt. of P.& R.D. stated that Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), known as Mission NIrmal Bangla in West Bengal has been able to make much headway during the last three years. A Baseline survey of households was conducted in 2012. Based on the survey figures, West Bengal identified 151 crore rural households out of which 67.77 lakh households were identified as not having toilet facilities. With focused intervention, the State could cover a little over 26 lakh households with individual household toilets since April 2013. In the current year alone more than 11 lakh IHHL could be constructed in the state. Present coverage percentage of households with IHHL is 72 percent in West Bengal.

It was pointed out that in the rural areas, there is no existence of insanitary toilets. It is either sanitary toilets, especially the twin pit toilets with provision of leaching or open defecation only. The list of census blocks identified by the Census as having insanitary latrines was shared with the districts. Although complete reports are yet to come from the districts, the work undertaken so far has not identified any insanitary latrine on the ground. So far as existence of manual scavengers is concerned, after a detailed process, 17 out of 20 districts certified that no manual scavenger could be identified in respective district (in the rural areas). Reports from the remaining 3 districts are awaited.

Hon'ble MIC, BCW Deptt. enquired about the introduction of mechanical devices, safety gears etc. for cleaning of sewers and septic tanks in ULBs and the Railways.

Representative of Kolkata Municipal Corporation stated that the K.M.C. have already introduced mechanical devices, safety gears etc. for cleaning of sewers and septic tanks. Representative of Eastern Railway also stated that such safety measures have also been taken by the Railways.

Representative of Safai Karmachari Andolan did not agree with that statement made by the K.M.C. official and intimated that the practice of cleaning of sewers and septic tanks without safety gears is continuing in Rash Behari, Hazra area of K.M.C.

Hon'ble M.I.C. requested the KMC official to enquire into the matter and take appropriate steps in this regard.

The issues relating to payment of compensation to the families of those persons who died in sewerage works was taken up by the House.

Director, SUDA intimated that the list of sewerage death furnished by the Safai Karmachari Andolan are being enquired. Commissioner in the Deptt. of P. & R.D. stated that all reported cases of people dying while cleaning of sceptic tanks, etc. have been inquired into and appropriate action is being taken where the deaths could be linked to sewerage cleaning work.



The House noted that the Sub-Committee constituted for looking into the matter of constitution of a new Commission for the Safai Karmacharis at the State level or designating an existing State Commission/Statutory Body which may be assigned the task under the provisions fo the MS Act, 2013 could not submit its report for want of required data from the two departments on insanitary latrines and Manual Scavengers.

However, after detailed discussion, following action points were arrived at:

- 1. Municipal Affairs Department should complete the survey of insanitary latrines at the earliest.
- 2. Municipal Affairs department should also assess the no. of community sanitary latrines to be constructed in urban areas immediately after the survey.
- Municipal Affairs Department should take up the matter relating to conversion/construction of sanitary latrines as may be required under the provision of MS Act, 2013 following the survey findings.
- Municipal Affairs Department and the Railways should take appropriate steps immediately for introduction of mechanical devices, safety gears etc. for cleaning of sewerage and septic tanks in all ULBs and Railways respectively.
- 5. P. & R. D. Department should complete the verification process on the existence of insanitary latrines in the rural areas.
- 6. P. & R. D. Deptt should finalise the list of Manual Scavengers immediately.
- 7. The aforesaid Sub-Committee may be reconstituted after the receipt of required data from the two departments for having its recommendation on the issue.
- 8. M. A. Deptt.and P.& R.D. Deptt. should take appropriate steps immediately for payment of compensation where required in respect of sewerage deaths to comply with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

There being no other point for discussion, the meeting ended with thanks to and from the chair .

As you are aware, the Prime Minister gave a clarion call for "Swachh Bharat" as a mass movement to realize Gandhiji's dream of a clean India by the for "Swachh 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi in 2019. He has desired once again on the eve of the first year of the Mission that a nation-wide campaign be organized with the participation of all sections of the society to rekindle mass awareness to ensure lasting behavioural change to achieve the goal. In this context, it has been proposed that an intensive National Cleanliness Campaign be undertaken beginning from the birth anniversary of Late Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay on 25th September 2015 and ending with the birth anniversary of Shri Jaya Prakash Narayan on 11th October 2015.

- 2. For a campaign of this nature to be successful, there is a need for creating massive public awareness for participation and action for cleaning homes, government offices, schools, hospitals, work places, streets, roads and markets, railway stations and bus terminals, statues, monuments, rivers, lakes, ponds, parks and other public places. It is important to involve government and public sector officials at every level, non-government organizations, education and health institutions, wards, urban local bodies, self-help groups, youth organisations, resident and market associations as well as business and industrial chambers and associations in the cleanliness and awareness drives.
- 3. We aim to organise the anniversary celebrations with two themes. - This is a proposal of State Urban Development Agency regarding construction of Individual Household latrine for Implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission in 2015-16.
- 2. It appears from Action Plan submitted by SUDA, the State Level Nodal Agency for implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission in urban areas to the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India vide Memo. No. SUDA-23/2015 (Pt.)/1443 dated 16.10.2015, it has been proposed that 2,67,600 nos. of Individual Household Toilets will be taken up for construction during the current financial year i.e. 2015-16.
- 3. In this respect all the municipal towns of three districts 24-Parganas (North), Hooghly and Purba Medinipur have been prioritized for the purpose of construction of IHHL, so that these three districts may be declared as Open Defecation Free (ODF) in convergence with Mission "Nirmal Bangla" which takes care of Sanitation in the Rural Areas. District Magistrates of the aforesaid three districts had discussions in different occasions with the Principal Secretary, Municipal Affairs Department where it was agreed that all the municipal towns of these districts may be covered with the construction of IHHL simultaneously on priority basis.
- 4. The numbers of units to be covered in the three prioritized districts based on the findings of the survey of insanitary latrine and computed as per norms prescribed in Swachh Bharat Mission Guidelines are as follows:

North 24-Parganas - 97,184

Hooghly - 33,902


Purba Medinipur - 7,470

Total - 1,38,556

- 5. Against the target for construction of 2,67,600 nos. of sanitary latrines for the Current Financial Year, 2015-16, 1,38,556 nos. will be taken up for construction in the 46 Urban Local Bodies of the three prioritized districts stated above. Apart from that, other AMRUT towns and Smart City ULBs (Bidhannagar and, Durgapur) will also be covered to meet the target for 2015-16.
- 6. IHHL Model in order to construct IHHL in an uniform manner throughout the urban areas of the State, Municipal Engineering Directorate has developed a Model design of Two pit cost effective latrine for which the estimated cost comes to Rs.10,990/- per unit. It is proposed that the model design and estimate prepared by Municipal Engineering Directorate may be used in the ULBs henceforth for implementation of IHHL component under SBM. The copies of design and estimates of the model, prepared by Municipal Engineering Directorate is placed (cp/127 & 128).
- 7. Fund Sharing The issue of fund sharing has also been discussed at length and accordingly following fund sharing pattern for individual toilet unit is proposed:

1. Govt. of India : Rs. 4,000/2. Matching State Share (Mandatory ¹/₃) : Rs. 1,333/3. ULB Contribution : Rs. 2,000/4. Beneficiary's Contribution : Rs. 1,000/5. Additional State Share : Rs. 2,657/
Total : Rs.10,990/-

- 9. Finance Department of this Department vide their U.O. No. 2167 dated 24.11.2015 have agreed for earmarking 25% of the ULB-wise allocation of 1st instalment of 14th Finance Commission Grant in favour of 54 AMRUT Towns as ULBs contribution for those particular projects to be sanctioned under AMRUT [The extracts of concurrence for which is placed at CP/132 and ULB-wise allocation (25%) of 1st instalment of 14th Finance Commission Grant is placed at CP/133]. Now, in similar manner Finance department may also requested to kindly consider to accord necessary concurrence so that 25% fund for Non AMRUT 71 ULBs may also be earmarked as ULB contribution for implementation of SBM (U) (in those cases where projects will be sanctioned under SBM (U) for IHHL and for Solid Waste Management). - 2. It appears from the proposal that a Model design and estimate for individual household latrine for Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) was prepared by the Municipal Engineering Directorate earlier with GCI sheet on three sides of the structure with an estimated cost of Rs.10,990/- per unit. The said model design and estimate was circulated to the three prioritized districts viz. 24-Parganas (North), Hooghly and Purba Medinipur for adoption in construction of IHHL. The earlier model design and estimate is placed at cp/128/Flag-'A'.
- 3. Based on this proposed model design and estimate, a proposal on fund sharing pattern for individual IHHL toilet units to be adopted and also for release of 50% additional State Share i.e. Rs.36.81 crore required for construction of 1,38,556 nos. of IHHL units in the above 3 (three) prioritized districts against the target of 2,67,000 units for 2015-16 were moved to the Finance Department for their consideration and concurrence which may kindly be seen at nsp 16 to 17 prepage. The concurrence of Finance Department may also kindly be seen at nsp/19.
- 4. However, in various subsequent meetings and discussions, Chairpersons & representatives of the Urban Local Bodies pointed out that super-structures with brick walls on three sides would be preferred option.
- 5. Accordingly, as requested by the State Urban Development Agency, Chief Engineer, Municipal Engineering Directorate has now prepared and forwarded an alternative Model Plan and estimate with brick walls on three sides under the cover of his Memo. dated 18.04.2016 which is placed at cp/147/ Flag 'B'. The estimated cost of alternative Model Plan and estimate having 75 mm. thick brick wall and GCI sheet roof and floor comes to Rs.13,958/-. But the differential cost and saving patter of the alternative model have not been indicated in the proposal by MED / SUDA.
- 6. Now, since model design and estimate is being preferred by the Urban Local Bodies, the Director, State Urban Development Agency has come up with a proposal for consideration of the Department whether the alternative model design and estimate may be circulated to the concerned 3 (three) districts and also to other Urban Local bodies for adoption, if they like, provided the differential costs is borne by the beneficiaries / Urban Local Bodies.

Sir,

It may kindly be recalled that in the Action Plan for 2015-16 submitted to Govt. of India vide this Office Memo No. SUDA-23/2015(Pt.)/1443 dated 16.10.2015 (copy enclosed for ready reference) it has been proposed that 2,67,600 nos. of individual household toilets (backlog of 2014-15 78,000 nos. plus target fixed up by Govt. of India for 2015-16 1,89,600 nos.) will be taken up for construction during the current Financial Year. In this connection it may also be mentioned that the Districts of 24 Parganas (North), Hooghly and Purba Medinipur have been prioritized for the purpose of construction of IHHL in all the municipal towns so that the Districts may be declared Open Defecation Free (ODF) in convergence with Mission 'Nirmal Bangla' which takes care of sanitation in the rural areas.

It may further be mentioned that District Magistrates of the aforesaid three districts had discussions in different occasions with the Principal Secretary, MA Department where it was agreed that all the municipal towns in the districts may be covered with construction of IHHL simultaneously on priority basis.

It may further be mentioned that ME Directorate has developed a model plan and estimate for a cost effective latrine for which the estimated cost comes to Rs. 10,990/-. It is proposed to use the model developed by MED in the ULBs of the prioritized districts for the sake of uniformity. Copies of plans and estimates of the model developed by Chief Engineer, MED are enclosed herewith.




